### Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE Collected \$52.5 million for the month of June, averaging \$13.1 million per week. Total calendar year to date collections (Jan-Jun) have reached \$341.8m which is a 1.75% decrease over the same period in 2023. Paternity Establishment Percentage (PEP) remains high reaching 81.83% and Support Establishment Percentage (SEP) remains stable at 75.85%. Cases with a collection in the month (which includes actively charging and arrears only cases) remains steady at 43%, but if we consider only actively charging cases with an ongoing obligation, 60% received a payment.
