### Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE Collected \$49.0 million for the month of July, averaging \$12.2 million per week. Total calendar year to date collections (Jan-Jul) have reached \$390.7m which is a 1.79% decrease over the same period in 2023. Paternity Establishment Percentage (PEP) remains high reaching 81.51% and Support Establishment Percentage (SEP) remains stable at 75.64%. Cases with a collection in the month (which includes actively charging and arrears only cases) remains steady at 42%, but if we consider only actively charging cases with an ongoing obligation, 60% received a payment.
