EXPIRATION OF FEDERAL PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

Date: July 15, 2020	Subtopic(s): COVID-19, Budgeting
<p>See PB #20-26-ELI for information on the FPUC supplement.</p>	<p>The purpose of this policy bulletin is to inform all Job Center, Non-Cash Assistance (NCA) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Center, and HIV/AIDS (HASA) staff that the Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) supplement of \$600 per week to an individual’s regular unemployment benefits will expire on July 31, 2020 unless an Act of Congress extends the payments.</p> <p>As a result of the expiration of the FPUC supplements on July 31, 2020, all budgets for Cash Assistance (CA) and/or SNAP that are authorized for the 8/A/20 cycle or later are not to include the FPUC supplement of \$600 per week.</p> <p><i>Effective Immediately</i></p> <p>Reference:</p> <p>20 TA/DC035</p> <p>Related Item:</p> <p>PB #20-26-ELI Treatment of Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation for Cash Assistance, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program and Home Energy Assistance Program</p>
