What happens if I do not comply with child support?

If you do not comply you may have your benefits reduced as follows:

- Your Cash Assistance benefit may be reduced by at least 25%;
- You may lose Medicaid for yourself;
- You may become ineligible for some rental assistance programs or have your rental supplement reduced;
- You won't receive up to \$200 per month in child support payments in addition to your Cash Assistance benefit and more once you no longer need Cash Assistance.
