# **Get Help That's Confidential** and Fair

Free or low-cost mediation programs across New York City will work with you and your child's other parent to find a positive way forward.

Mediators are trained to listen, to be fair, and to keep the conversation safe and productive.

#### **Talk About What's Important**

Mediators help parents come to agreements about such issues as:

- Past-due child support payments
- Future child support payments
- Custody visitation or child rearing
- Communication or other types of conflicts

#### **Take Control of the Process**

You and the other parent control the mediation process. You decide whether you want to participate. You decide if you want to accept the final agreement.

Here's how the process works:

- Both parents meet with a trained, neutral mediator
- The mediator leads a conversation about the parents' needs and differences to come to a realistic agreement
- The parents make the decisions, not the mediator
