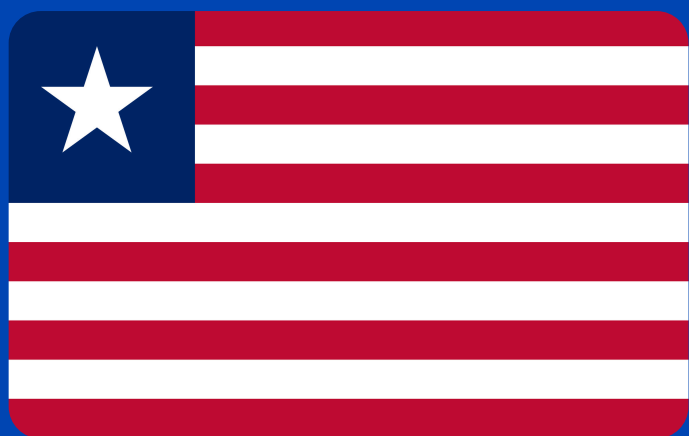
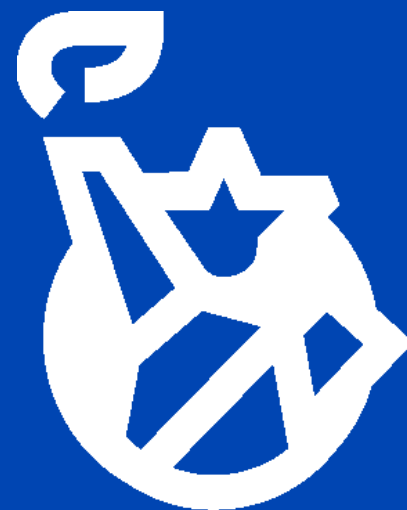


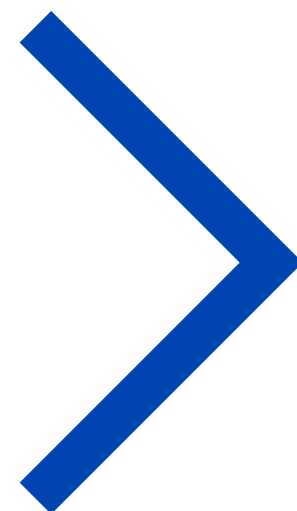

New Announcement for Liberian People

On June 28, 2024, the main government add the time up for the **Deferred Enforced Departure for Liberian people.**





It mean that **in 24 month time, they will not send qualify Liberian people back to their country** and they will still be able to work in America.

You can qualify if you:

- **Been living in America from May 20, 2017,**

OR

- **you putting in for green card or you finish putting in for green card through the Liberian Refugee Immigration Fairness (LRIF) program.**

Putting in for Work Paper



The American Government adding the time up now-now for Category A-11 work paper and the finishing time will be 2020-2024. This work paper dem already in use until June 30, 2026.



You can continue to work without putting in for new work paper.



You can only put in for new work paper if you want get new card.



We encourage you to talk thing dem about immigration only to lawyer that get paper or somebody from DOJ that qualify.

BE CAREFUL ABOUT LEGAL IMMIGRATION LIES AND CROOKY PEOPLE

Remember:

- Only lawyer that get paper or somebody from DOJ that qualify can put in for paper for you.
- Government worker who can signed legal paper but they not lawyer that get paper will not be qualify to fill the form dem or put in for them for you. And also, they not able to control you to do it.



Immigration law full of plenty thing. Be careful about legal immigration lies and crooky worker dem who will fool you and lie to you about things like:

- How to get work paper or visa quick-quick
- Telling you that everything will **be alright and nothing bad will happen.**
- Telling you that **they friendly with big-big people** inside the immigration.
