Clinton St. between South St. and Cherry St.

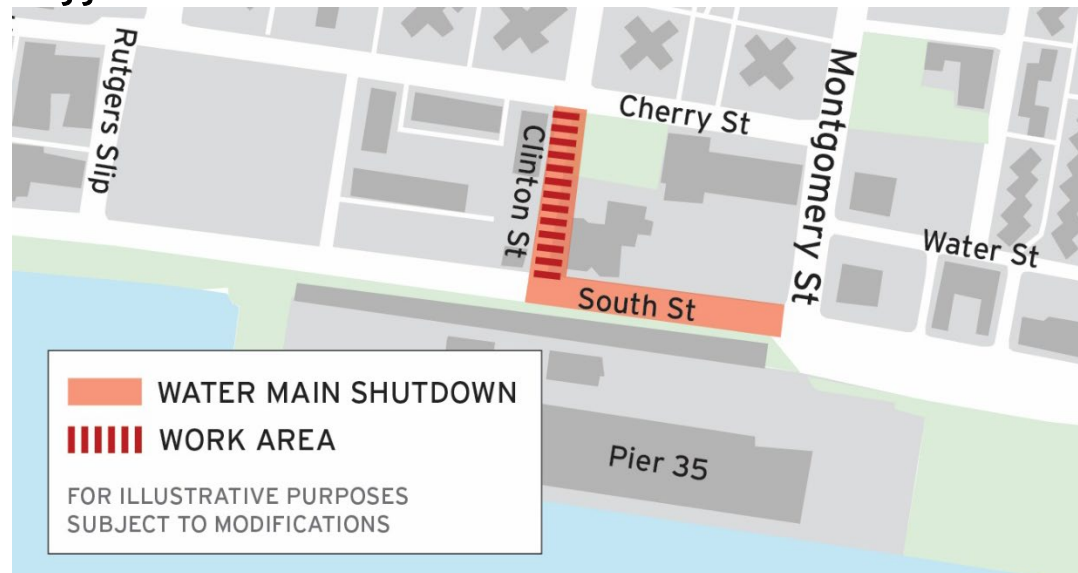
Requiring a water shutdown on:

To safely install a new fire hydrant on Clinton St, the water mains on both South St and Clinton St need to be shutdown. Official DEP notices with instructions will be provided before any service interruptions. For your safety, please follow on-site signage and flaggers.
