







Vanderbilt & Clinton Avenues between Gates and DeKalb, 1915 Bromley Atlas



Nos.373-375 were designed as a pair of two-story brick carriage houses (now combined into one building) built in a modified Romanesque Revival style. Each had a vehicular entrance; an elliptically-arched one with drip moldings and keystone at No. 373, and an enclosed rectangular one with a flat linted at No. 375. Between these entrances, an original round-arched pedestrian entrance remains. At the second floor, projecting brick piers with recessed vertical panels separate four pairs of narrow double windows, each of which has a flat splayed lintel. The piers support a raised corbeled cornice and pediment at the center of the pair.








