




















# Front Façade Window Replacement

Block 386, Lot 26 Zoning: R6-B Boerum Hill Historic District

174 Bergen Street is a three-story plus basement, 2-family modified late Italiante brick with brownstone basement townhouse constructed in 1873-1874. Located on the south side of Bergen Street mid-block between Hoyt and Bond Streets.


Proposed work is the replacement of the post 1940 6-over-6 and 9-over-9 wood double hung windows and aluminum storms at the front façade with new 2-over-2 aluminum windows with a wood brick mold.
