Washington Street Safe Haven Good Neighbor Policy

Our residents deserve to live in a neighborhood as nice as the Financial District, and our neighbors have welcomed CUCS into the community. We are committed to being good neighbors and ensuring that the community remains supportive of our safe haven. At the Washington Street Safe Haven, we emphasize respect for the rights of our neighbors, both within the residence and in the surrounding community.

Your behavior reflects on yourself, the program, and each other. Everyone must be respectful in the community and while visiting local businesses. To respect our community's personal space and property, **the following actions are NOT permitted:**

- Solicitation of any kind in the neighborhood
 - (ex: panhandling for cigarettes or money)
- Loitering in front of the building or in the neighborhood. Refrain from smoking in the front of the building. Please utilize the open spaces on the 6th floor and 2nd floor.
- Spitting, littering or inappropriate behavior in the community
- Verbal or physical violence of any kind; including any type of threatening behavior
- Loud music, disruptive behavior or yelling and foul language in the neighborhood
- Substance use
- Any criminal behavior

If the above rules are violated, you will be issued a warning or be required to meet with Washington Street Haven staff. Multiple violations can result in a conference with DHS's Program Analyst and/or an immediate transfer. Immediate transfers for illegal or threatening behavior will be at the discretion of CUCS and DHS.
