





Dear Mr. Roberts:

Community Board 3 has no objection to the Wine, Beer, and Cider application for 133 Group Inc located at 133 Chrystie Street, d/b/a/ Potluck Club, if the signed and notarized stipulations attached are included in the license agreement:

- 1) it will operate a restaurant,
- 2) its kitchen will be open and serving food during all hours of operation,
- 3) its hours of operation will be 10 A.M. to 12 A.M. Monday-Friday, and 9 A.M. to 12 A.M. Saturday-Sunday,
- 4) it will not use outdoor space for commercial use,
- it will close any front or rear façade doors and windows at 10:00 p.m. every night or when amplified sound is playing, including but not limited to DJs, live music and live nonmusical performances,
- 6) it will not install soundproofing,
- 7) it will play ambient, recorded background music only and will not have DJs, live music, promoted events, scheduled performances or any event at which a cover fee is charged,
- 8) it will not apply for an alteration of its method of operation or for any physical alterations of any
- 9) nature without first appearing before CB 3,
- 10) it will not seek a change in class to a full on-premise liquor license without first obtaining approval from CB 3.
- 11) it will not host pub crawls or party buses,
- 12) it will not have unlimited drink specials with food, including boozy brunches,
- 13) it will have happy hour and will end by 8 P.M.,
- 14) it will insure that there are no wait lines outside,
- 15) it will conspicuously post this stipulation form beside its liquor license within its business, and
- 16) it will provide a telephone number for residents to call with complaints and immediately address any resident complaints.
