**Remember:** Each vendor has a single PASS*Port* Vault which means that any actions in the Vault are visible to all contacts at your organization.

# Subcontracting is Now in PASSPort

Starting today, subcontractor approvals and modifications are now processed in PASSPort (subcontractors can no longer be submitted in PIP), streamlining your workflow and ensuring greater transparency.

Prime vendors will now record **subcontractor payment info** in PASSPort, and subcontractors can confirm receipt, improving accountability for all parties involved.
