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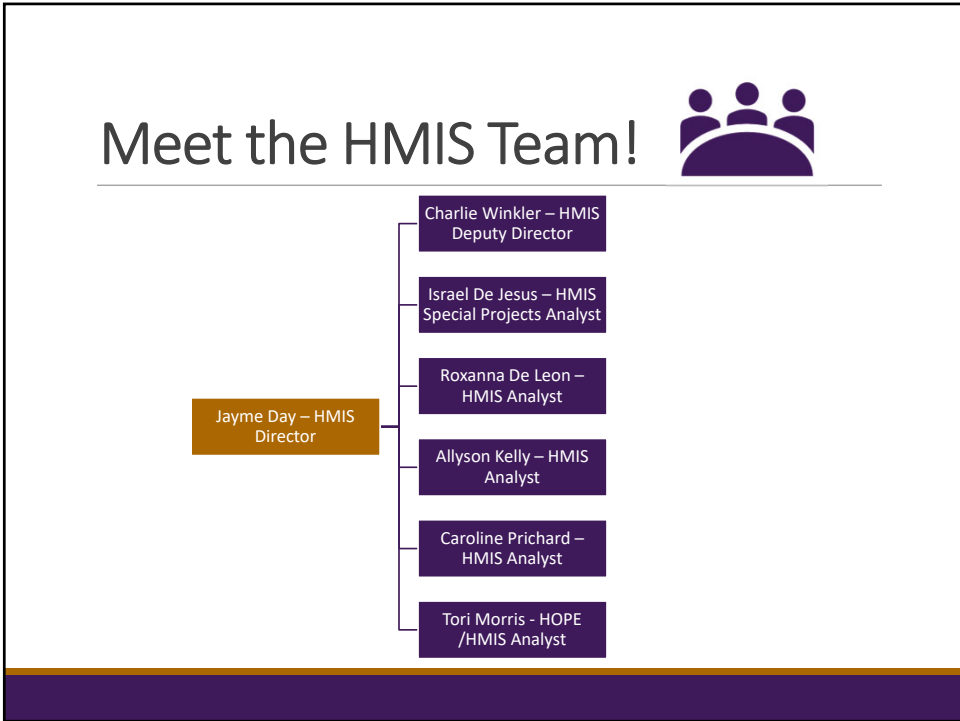

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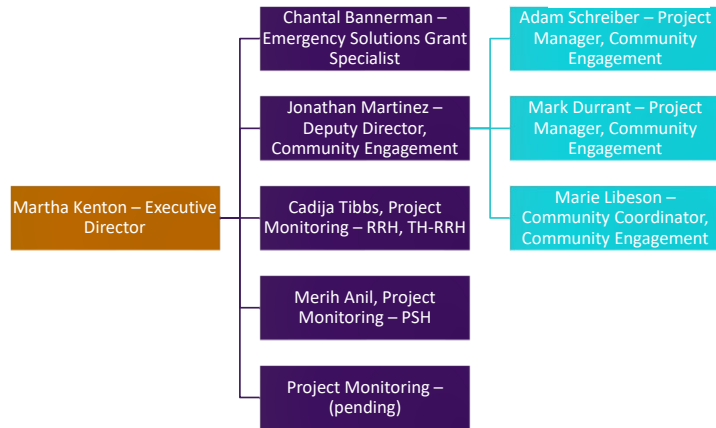

Local Competition

- May 1st – Local Competition starts
- May 7th and May 14th – Information sessions
- June 12th – Final submission deadline
- July 15th – Applicants notified of conditional approval

Grant Inventory Worksheet (GIW) - ARD (Est.): \$172,042,471

- June 26th – GIW Released
- July 17th – GIW due to SNAPs Office
- August 1st – Final GIW Released

2024 NOFO Competition

- July 31st – 2024 NOFO released
- August 9th – NYC CoC 2024 Kickoff
- September 6th – All new and renewal projects due in e-snaps
- **October 15th – All accepted, rejected, and reduced projects notified outside of e-snaps**
- **October 28th – NYC CoC Consolidated Application posted**
- **October 30th – NYC CoC Consolidated Application submitted in e-snaps**

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2024 NOFO



What's new?

- Two-year NOFO
- Budget lines for supportive services and HMIS will be increased by a cost-of-living adjustment
- Tier 1 is 90% of Final Pro Rata Need (93% last year)
- CoC Bonus is 12% Final Pro Rata Need (7% last year)

YHDP Projects

- All YHDP grants will be renewed non-competitively.

Grants previously awarded under DV Bonus or YHDP must continue to serve survivors or youth, respectively, and cannot reallocate to serve different populations.

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CoC Builds NOFO



Funding Opportunity Title: Continuum of Care (CoC) Builds

Opening Date: July 19, 2024

Local Comp. Start Date: September 11, 2024

Local Com. End Date: October 4th

Deadline to Submit to HUD: November 21, 2024

Purpose: development of new PSH units through new construction, acquisition, or rehabilitation

Details:

- NYC CoC eligible to submit **one application for a maximum of \$10m**
- Majority of funding must be for capital costs
 - Up to 20% can be used on operations, services, project-based rental assistance
 - Up to 10% can be used on admin
