

IR Camera User Guide

1 Setting up the IR Light

- 1.1 Secure the IR light to the moveable arm fixture.
- 1.2 Plug the cable that connects the IR light to the computer/tablet (See tablet instructions in section 1.4) into the top of the light. Plug the power cable into the right side of the IR light. See photo below.



- 1.3 Set the dial on the light to "".
- 1.4 Microsoft Surface Pro 9 Tablet
- 1.5 The tablet has an external USB port with 4 slots. One port each for the mouse (wireless/wired), keyboard (wireless/wired), IR camera chord connector and an empty slot for a USB flash drive if needed.
 - 1.5.1 The tablet is a touchscreen, but to avoid contaminating the screen, a mouse will be used.
 - Left click on the mouse to wake up or turn on the tablet. If a "Sign in" screen pops up just click on the "Sign in" button (no password necessary).

1.5.3 Click the shortcut icon to the Crim-Lite Cam Software

2 Using the Crime-Lite Cam Software

2.1 In the main window of the software, make sure the "Device Settings" are as follows:

Device: Crime-Lite 82S Light Source: IR ML Filter: None

Camera Filter: IR Only IIII

- 2.2 Set the Exposure setting on the top panel in the software to "Auto".
- 2.3 To focus the camera:
 - 2.3.1 Click "Options" on the top panel in the software.
 - 2.3.2 A new panel of settings will appear. Click "Full Screen".
 - 2.3.3 Two settings will appear on the left side of the screen: "Grab Image" and "Auto".
 - 2.3.4 "Grab Image" will take a photo of what is in the camera's field of view. This photo will appear in the bottom panel of the software, but it does not save anywhere on the computer.
 - 2.3.5 Click "Auto" to focus the camera.
 - 2.3.6 Deselect "Full Screen" to return to the main window of the software.
- 2.4 Refer to the Evidence Examination manual for how to examine evidence using the IR light.
