The Flushing Line Improvements Project will rehabilitate sections of the New York City Transit Flushing Line between 48th Street and 72nd Street, including upgrades to the 61st Street-Woodside and 74th Street-Broadway stations.

Construction Activities at 61st Street-Woodside Station

Beginning on Monday, September 30, 2024

The escalator that provides access to the **1** line at 61st Street-Woodside Station will be will be closed through 2025 while a new escalator is installed.

Temporary barricades will be set up around the escalator shed on the SE corner of 61st Street and Roosevelt Avenue. Pedestrian and business access will be maintained for the duration of the construction. The barricades currently located on the north side of the street will be relocated to the south side of the street, adjacent to the escalator shed. There will be no impacts to MTA or LIRR service or ADA accessibility. The station's elevator and staircases will remain open. Please refer to wayfinding signage throughout the station for continued updates.
