<u>47-25 34th Street (HUB) – ULURP Project 2020Q0275 – DOT Site Selection and Acquisition for</u> 47-25 34th Street.

Dorrit Blakeslee introduced her colleagues and provided a presentation, copy attached (Attachment #1).

The applicant was invited to attend the February 1, 2024, Community Board 2 Meeting.

Kenny Greenberg made a motion, and it was seconded by Diana Kichler to support the ULURP Application for the DOT site selection and acquisition for 47-25 34th Street with the stipulation that they add street trees. The vote was all in favor of the motion, none (0) opposed and no (0) abstentions.

#6 Use Terms – The Committee voted to table.

#7 Urban Agriculture – The Committee voted unanimously to support.

#8 Life Sciences – The Committee voted unanimously to support.

#9 Nightlife -

• The Committee voted to unanimously support with the stipulation that all current regualtions regardingnoise and property damage be strictly enforced.

#10 Amusement -

• The Committee voted to support with Seven (7) in favor; two (2) opposed and no (0) abstentions.

#11 Home Occupations -

• The Committee voted to support with Five (5) in favor; four (4) opposed and no abstentions.

#12 Streetscape -

• The Committee voted unanimously in favor; with none (0) opposed and no (0) abstentions.

#13 Auto Repair -

• The Committee voted unanimously in favor with none (0) opposed and no (0) abstentions.

#14 Micro-distribution – The Committee voted to oppose, with One (1) in favor, and Eight (8) opposed.

#15 Campus Commercial –

• The Committed voted to support with the stipulation that a mechanism for approval by Campus residents be added. The vote was Six (6) in favor; Three (3) opposed and no (0) abstentions.

#16 Corner Stores – The Committee voted to table.

#17 Better Waiver Process -

The Committee voted to table need to better understand the process.

#18 New Loft-Style District -

The Committee voted to support with six (6) in favor; four (3) opposed and no (0) abstentions.
