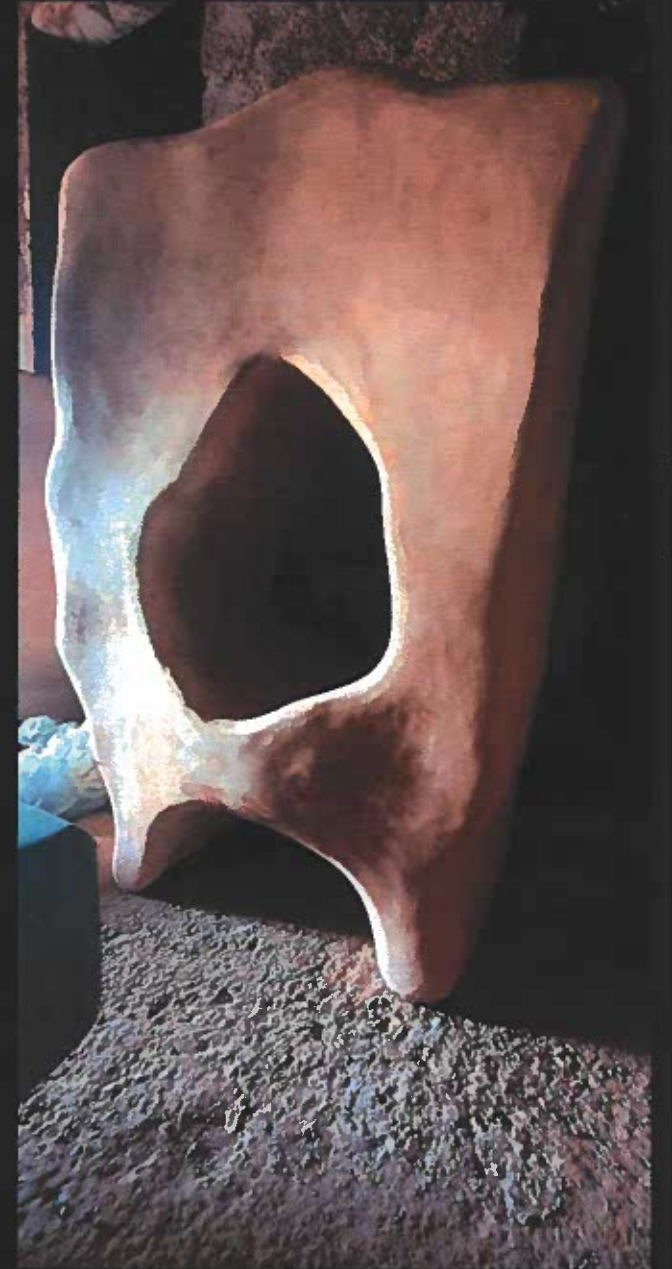

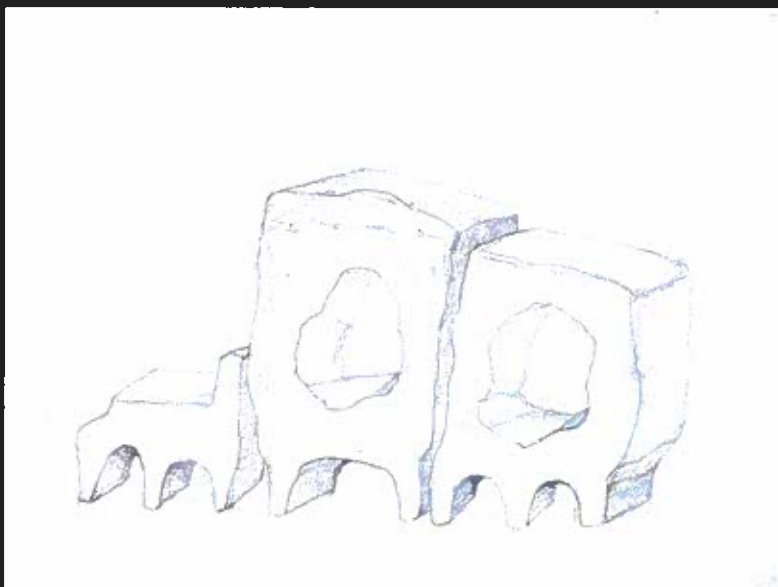


Artist Concept and Artwork Information

Jumana Manna: Break, Take, Erase, Tally

On View at MoMA PS1: September 22, 2022 – April 17, 2023

This exhibition highlights Manna's ongoing investigation into land and its rhythms, alongside ways of life that have undergone duress while also resisting, evading, and transforming hegemonic power structures.



Manna's ongoing series of ceramic sculptures explores a tension between preservation and ruination. Their forms draw from the *khabya*, a once-common structure for grain storage in rural houses across the Levant. Built into homes, the *khabya*—which means “the thing that hides” in Arabic—would preserve the annual grain harvest for family and communal consumption. With the advent of refrigeration and state-centralized grain silos, the *khabya* became obsolete and now can occasionally be found in the remnants of abandoned village structures.

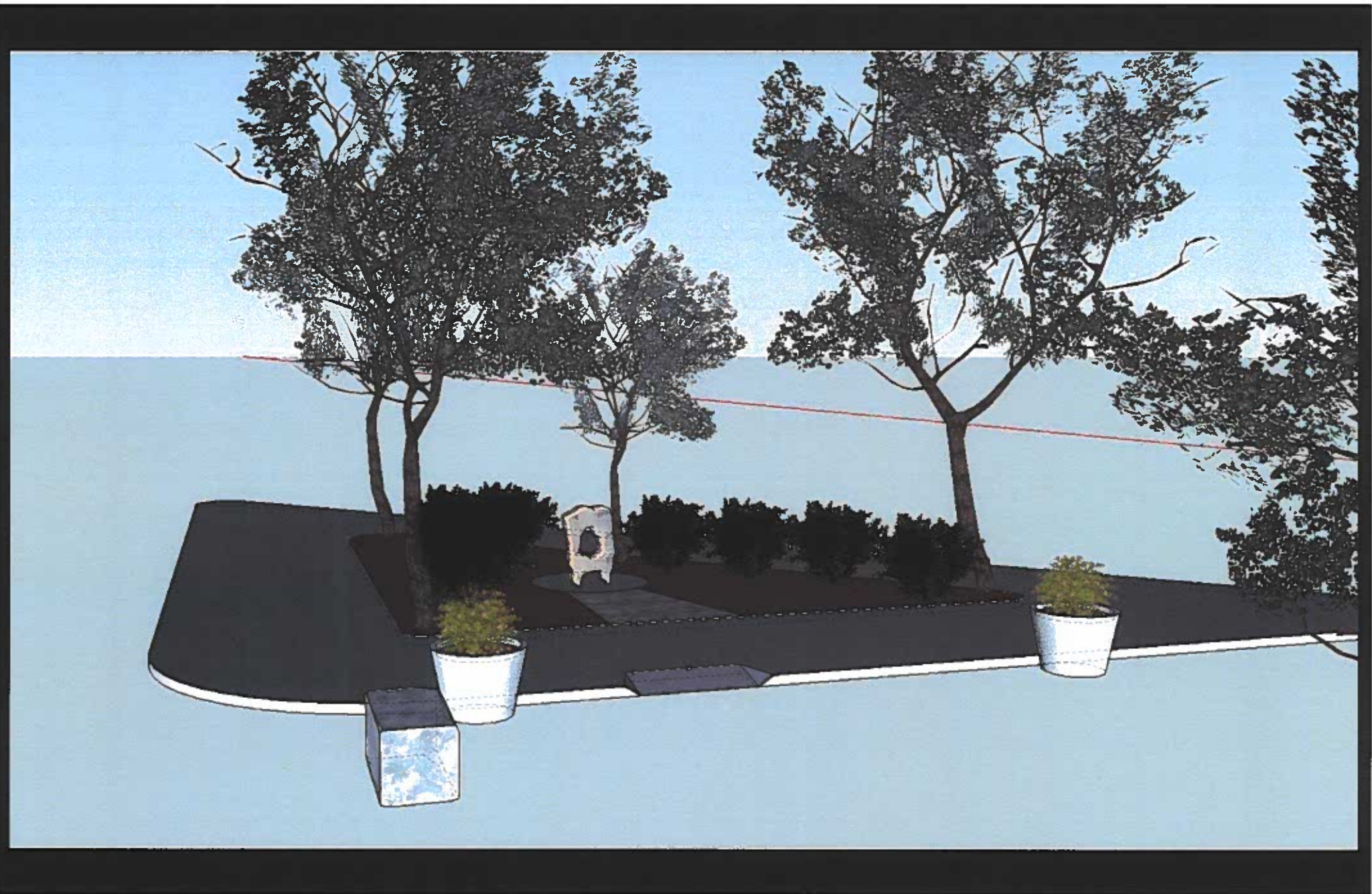
