Request for a Feasibility Study for Safety Improvements and Traffic Calming Measures on 39th RE:

Avenue between Woodside Avenue to 58th Street

Dear Commissioner Garcia:

At the September 6, 2022, meeting of the Transportation Committee, a motion was made and seconded to request a feasibility study for safety improvements and traffic calming measures on 39th Avenue between Woodside Avenue to 58th Street and each of the crossings in between these streets. All were in favor of the motion by a show of hands with none opposed and no abstentions.

Members of the Transportation Committee discussed this location as being a dangerous crossing for school children that attend the local school in the area. As there are narrow sidewalks, it is increasingly difficult for pedestrians to navigate crossing the street due to motorists speeding through the area and not obeying traffic rules.

Community Board 2 respectfully requests, and strongly urges, the NYC Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility study on 39th Avenue between Woodside Avenue to 58th Street and the crossings in between these streets for safety improvements and traffic calming measures to ensure the overall safety of the public, especially our school children.
