### **BACKGROUND**

### 188<sup>th</sup> St, Horace Harding Exwy to 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave

- Multiple community requests for pedestrian safety improvements on 188<sup>th</sup> St at 64<sup>th</sup> Ave and 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave
- Assemblywoman Rozic provided funding for NYC DOT to conduct study of the area and install safety improvements
- In February 2016, Assemblywoman Rozic, Council Member Grodenchik, CB8, and NYC DOT conducted a community walk-through along 188<sup>th</sup> St
- The 64<sup>th</sup> Ave circle is a busy commercial area



### **BACKGROUND - SAFETY DATA**

188<sup>th</sup> St from the Horace Harding Expressway to 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave is a high crash corridor with 3 KSI



Existing midblock uncontrolled crosswalk between 64th Ave and Horace Harding Expressway

~100 pedestrians in the peak hour at uncontrolled crossings




Missing crosswalks at pedestrian desire lines







# **EXISTING CONDITIONS – CONGESTION/CONFUSION**

Bus often blocks right turning traffic onto 64<sup>th</sup> Ave








Lack of clear lane designation within circle to guide drivers



### **EXISTING CONDITIONS – PARKING**

64<sup>th</sup> Ave has large channelized No Standing Anytime areas along the center median between 188<sup>th</sup> St and Oak Grove Park








### **EXISTING CONDITIONS – DRIVEWAY EXIT**

Pedestrian fatality occurred in 2011 when vehicle made left turn from parking lot onto northbound 188<sup>th</sup> St



Parking lot exit is close to intersection of 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave which complicates parking lot exiting



### **EXISTING CONDITIONS – INTERSECTION CONGESTION**


- 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave and 188<sup>th</sup> St both have high traffic volumes
- Left turning cars waiting for gaps from 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave onto 188<sup>th</sup> St block the moving lane for through traffic on 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave
- Intersection is too narrow to add dedicated left turn bays on 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave








- Signalize the north, east, and west legs of circle
- Relocate midblock uncontrolled crosswalk south to new signal
- Expand north and east median tips in paint and build out in concrete scheduled for 2019
- Construct concrete pedestrian safety island scheduled for 2019
- Install two standard lanes inside the circle and two standard lanes on 188<sup>th</sup> St approaching the circle
- Shift bus stop back 35' on northbound 188th St to allow space for right turning vehicles onto 64th Ave (maintaining existing bus shelter)






### 64<sup>TH</sup> AVE – METERED PARKING

## PROPOSAL- 64TH AVE PARKING


Add **23** non-metered parking spaces on 64<sup>th</sup> Ave between 188<sup>th</sup> St and Oak Grove Park



# 3 PROPOSAL- 73RD AVE

- 100' of No Standing Anytime on 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave ahead of 188<sup>th</sup> in both directions to provide extra space when left turning vehicles block the through and right turning movements
- Qwick Kurb to restrict left turn out of parking lot and soften southbound left turn onto 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave
- Dedicated left turn lane on 188<sup>th</sup> St north of 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave





### **SUMMARY**

Signalize north, west, east legs, and crosswalks of 64th Ave Circle

Install two standard lanes inside the 64th Ave Circle

Expand median tips and install a pedestrian safety island at the 64<sup>th</sup> Ave Circle

Shift back the bus stop on 188<sup>th</sup> St south of 64<sup>th</sup> Ave to increase space for right turning vehicles onto 64<sup>th</sup> Ave

- Add 23 non-metered parking spaces on 64<sup>th</sup> Ave between 188<sup>th</sup> St and Oak Grove Park for a net gain of 15 spaces
- Add southbound left turn bay on 188<sup>th</sup> St at 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave and Qwick Kurb to restrict left hand turn out of parking lot

Create 100' of No Standing Anytime ahead of 188<sup>th</sup> St on 73<sup>rd</sup> Ave in both directions







