1. Opening of Meeting and Reading of Minutes

She also spoke about all the events that the board participated in, thanking those members who attended and offered their help. Chair Algredo gave a special thanks to DM McClelland for his involvement and dedication.

DM McClelland wished Happy Birthday to Carmela Isabella, Jarnail Singh, Matthew Singh and Mohinder Singh. He reported on the following:

Budget consultations are completed. Reminded the Board Members to submit their Capital/Expense project ideas for the next Fiscal Year 2026 by November 1st as the vote on Capital and Expense priory list will be taken during the November 12th board meeting.

5. Land Use & Housing Committee Report - Sylvia Hack & Andrew Taranto, Co-Chairs

BSA Application No. 700-85-BZ – 97-38 99th Street

An amendment to BSA's condition of term to re-instate a previously approved Variance (§72-21) which permitted contractor's establishment including storage and handling of building materials, office and storage of one truck with accessory parking for five cars which expired January 20, 2002, in R5 zoning district.

6. NYPD 102nd Pct. Briefing

DM McClelland thanked the officers of the 102nd Pct. for their help. They arrested individuals who were selling illegal cannabis products from their van parked on the street.

Police Officer Nick Salamone, 102nd Pct. reported on the crime stats stating that overall crime is down for the last 28 days. Robberies are down 18%; there is a slight spike in burglaries. Crime Prevention Officer is conveying surveys after every burglary constantly educating the owners on crime prevention technics.

PO Salamone reported on a homicide incident that occurred at 125th Street and 101st Avenue.

He thanked Chair Algredo and DM McClelland for sending a request for a street co-naming of Baseball Field 1 in Forest Park after Det. Brian Simonsen.
