(March 13, 1986)

MAYOR'S COMMITTEE ON APPOINTMENTS


By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Prior Order Amended. Section 4(a) of prior Executive Order No. 90, dated March 13, 1986, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. Committee Membership.

(a) The Committee shall consist of five members including a chair, each residing or having a principal place of business in the City of New York, appointed by the Mayor. Such members may, in their discretion, designate adjunct members who shall function under section two as voting members with regard to appointments and reappointments to specific commissions, boards or other public bodies. Adjunct members, if so designated, will be professionals or knowledgeable persons of high standing with expertise appropriate for enabling the Committee to make a reasoned, informed and impartial evaluation of candidates for the offices referred to in section one. If so designated, there shall be between two and four adjunct members for each commission, board or other public body for which candidates are evaluated, according to the determination of the members."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
