Amendment of Executive Order No. 50  
(April 25, 1980)

BUREAU OF LABOR SERVICES

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York,  
it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Prior Order Amended.

a. Section 6(a) of Executive Order No. 50, dated  
April 25, 1980, is amended to read as follows:

"Submission Requirements. No contracting  
agency shall enter into a contract with any  
contractor unless such contractor's  
employment report is first submitted to the  
Bureau for its review. Unless otherwise  
required by law, an employment report shall  
not be required for the following:

(i) a construction contract in the  
amount of less than \$1 million; a  
construction subcontract in the amount of  
less than \$750,000; or a supply and service  
contract in the amount of \$50,000 or less  
or of more than \$50,000 in which the  
contractor employs fewer than 50 employees  
at the facility or facilities involved in  
the contract;

(ii) an emergency contract or other  
exempt contract except as the Bureau may  
direct by regulation; and

(iii) a contract with a contractor who has  
received a certificate of compliance with  
the equal employment opportunity  
requirements of applicable law from the  
Bureau within the preceding twenty-four  
months, or an appropriate agency of the  
State of New York or of the United States  
within the preceding twelve months, except  
as the Bureau may direct by regulation."

b. Section 7(c) of such Order is amended to read as  
follows:

"On-the-job training of economically  
disadvantaged persons shall be required on  
all construction contracts covered by the  
submission requirements of this Order."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect  
immediately, but shall have no retrospective effect with respect  
to the two (2) year approval period provided for in Section 1(a)  
of this Order, amending Section 6(a) (iii) of Executive Order  
No. 50, dated April 25, 1980.
