EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9

MANHATTAN CABLE FRANCHISE RENEWALS

WHEREAS, by letter to the Conflicts of Interest Board, dated February 21, 1990, I requested the opinion of that body as to whether Chapter 68 of the New York City Charter requires that I be restricted in any way in performing my duties as Mayor and as a member of the Board of Estimate with respect to cable television issues involving the Manhattan franchises; and

WHEREAS, the Conflicts of Interest Board has, by Opinion 90-5, dated April 16, 1990, advised me to recuse myself from matters pending before the Board of Estimate involving the renewal of the Manhattan cable television franchises, and to delegate my powers and duties respecting these matters to the extent permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel has advised me by Opinion, dated April 18, 1990, that the New York City Charter authorizes me to delegate my authority with respect to the Manhattan
