## A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK CITY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY, CAREER PATHWAYS: ONE CITY WORKING TOGETHER
