

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK CITY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD
WORKFORCE POLICY COMMITTEE APPROVING
THE SUPPORTIVE SERVICES POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 §134(c)(2) provides Local Workforce Investment Boards the authority and flexibility to develop policies related to the provision of supportive services and needs related payments,

WHEREAS, supportive services includes transportation, child care, dependent care, housing, and needs related payments that are necessary to enable an individual to participate in activities authorized under WIA title I,

WHEREAS, the New York City Local Workforce Investment Board, Workforce Policy Committee, supports the Workforce1 Career Center's current practice of referring jobseekers to supportive services offered by partner organizations through the Community Partners Network, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Policy Committee as follows:

The Workforce Policy Committee hereby approves the supportive services practice currently in effect for the New York City Local Workforce Investment Area.

This policy shall take effect immediately.
