NYC DOT will implement upgrades to the curbside protected bike lanes on 38th St. and 39th St. between 8th Ave. and Madison Ave.:

- Widen and refurbish protected bike lane on 38th St., and 39th St. between 8th Ave. and Madison Ave.
- Formalize one travel lane and curbside parking lane on 38th St. between 9th Ave. and Madison Ave. with new markings and 39th St. between 8th Ave. and Madison Ave. to accommodate loading
- Establish new no standing zones for curbside access and emergencies
- Provide new bike corrals at intersections to meet cycling growth and demand

Implementation begins mid-August
