Improve Safety

NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements on 6th Ave. between Lispenard St. and W. 13th St:

- Install protected bike lane on east curb between Lispenard St. and Houston St.
- Install protected bike lane on west curb between Houston St. and W. 8th St.
- Construct bus boarding islands between Lispenard St. and King St.
- Widen the protected bike lane between W. 8th St. and W. 13th St.

Implementation begins September 2024
