NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements on the Vision Zero Priority Corridor of Main St. between 71st Rd. and 75th Ave.:

- Install painted curb extensions on Main St. at 71st Rd., 72nd Dr., and 73rd Ave.
- Install median tip extensions on Main St. at 72nd Ave., 73rd Ave., and 75th Ave.
- Construct an ADA-compliant bus stop median on Main St. at 72nd Ave.
- Add new crosswalks on Main St. at Vleigh Pl.

Implementation begins August 2024
