**NYC DOT will implement pedestrian safety improvements at the intersection of Narrows Rd. North and Fingerboard Rd.:**

- Install two new pedestrian refuge islands on Narrows Rd. North and Fingerboard Rd. to provide safer conditions for crossing pedestrians
- Reduce vehicle lanes from two to one on Narrows Rd. North East of Fingerboard Rd. to calm traffic movements
- Add new lane designation markings to clarify traffic movements
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps to improve accessibility
