NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements on the Vision Zero Priority Corridor of Queens Blvd. between Skillman Ave. and Roosevelt Ave.:

- Install protected bike lanes on Queens Blvd. from Skillman Ave. to Roosevelt Ave.
- Install painted pedestrian islands at crosswalks across Queens Blvd.
- Remove rush hour regulations on Queens Blvd.
- Provide new loading zones for deliveries on Queens Blvd.
- Increase dedicated pedestrian walk time for crossing Queens Blvd.

Implementation begins September 2024
