NYC DOT will install corridor safety improvements on the Vision Zero Priority Corridor of White Plains Rd. from Burke Ave. to Pelham Pkwy.:

- Add a Protected Bike Lane on White Plains Rd. from Burke Ave. to Pelham Pkwy.
- Add painted pedestrian space on White Plains Rd. to create shorter, safer crossings and encourage slower, safer turns
- Organize the roadway and parking on White Plains Rd. to improve roadway safety

Implementation begins September 2024
