# 2.1 ACTING FIRE COMMISSIONER

# 2.2 ANNUAL NOZZLE TEST

All hand-held controlling hose nozzles shall be tested annually during the month of August and whenever deemed necessary. Tests will be conducted in accordance with schedules established by Divisions.

### 2.3 HOSE TESTING

Division Commanders shall schedule the Annual Hose Test to begin and continue until all hose assigned to their command is tested. The hose testing kit assigned to all Divisions shall be utilized, and at completion, a report shall be forwarded by the Company Commander listing the date of the test, and the diameter and serial number of defective hose. Defective hose shall be rolled, tied, and properly marked. Officers shall forward defective hose to Division of Technical Services. Division Commands shall collate all reports and forward them to Bureau of Support Services via Bureau of Operations.
