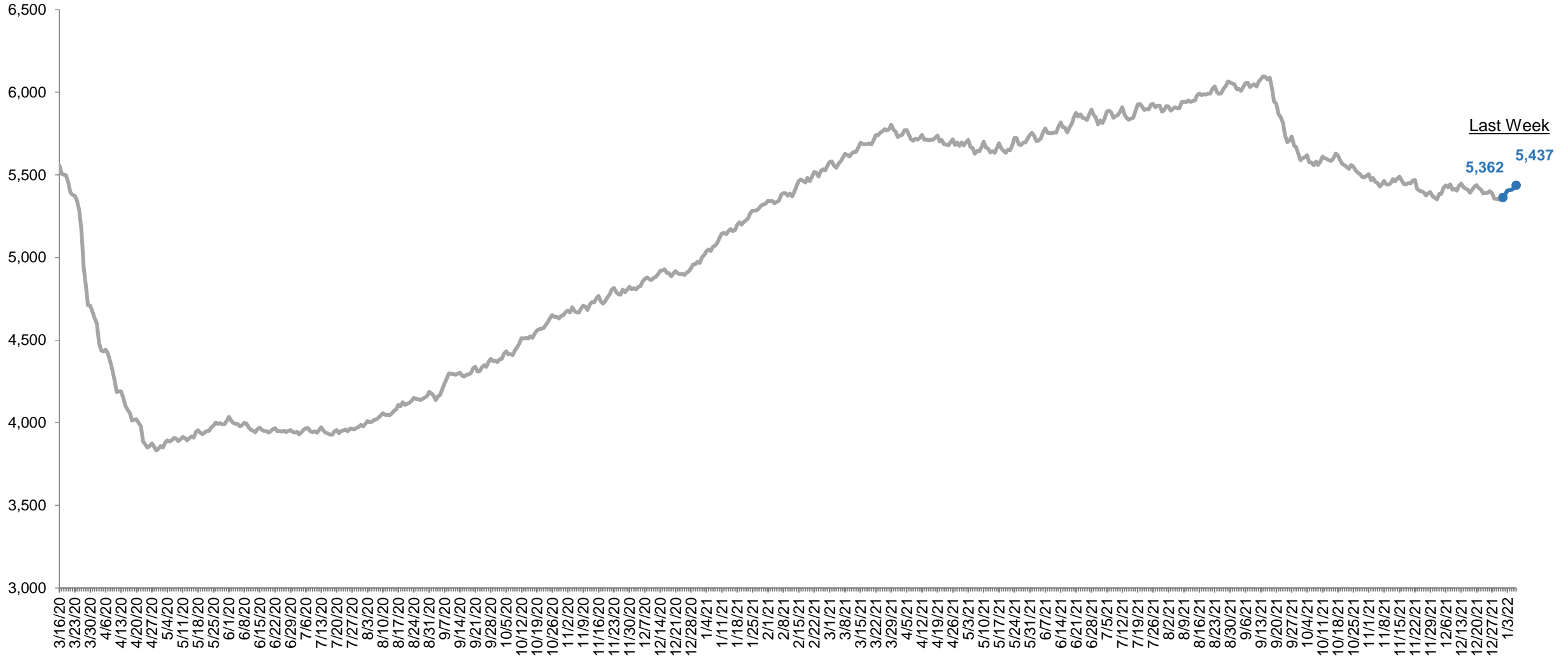

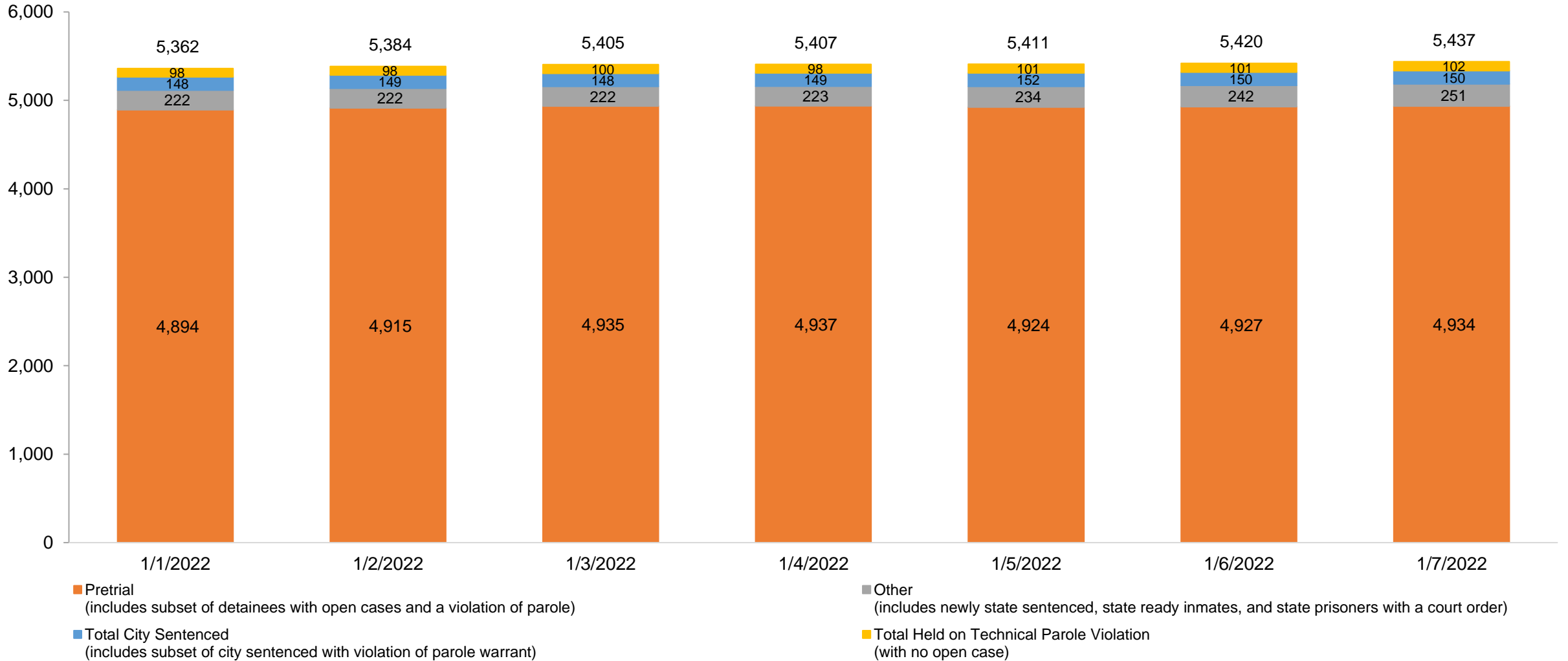

January 1, 2022 – January 7, 2022**

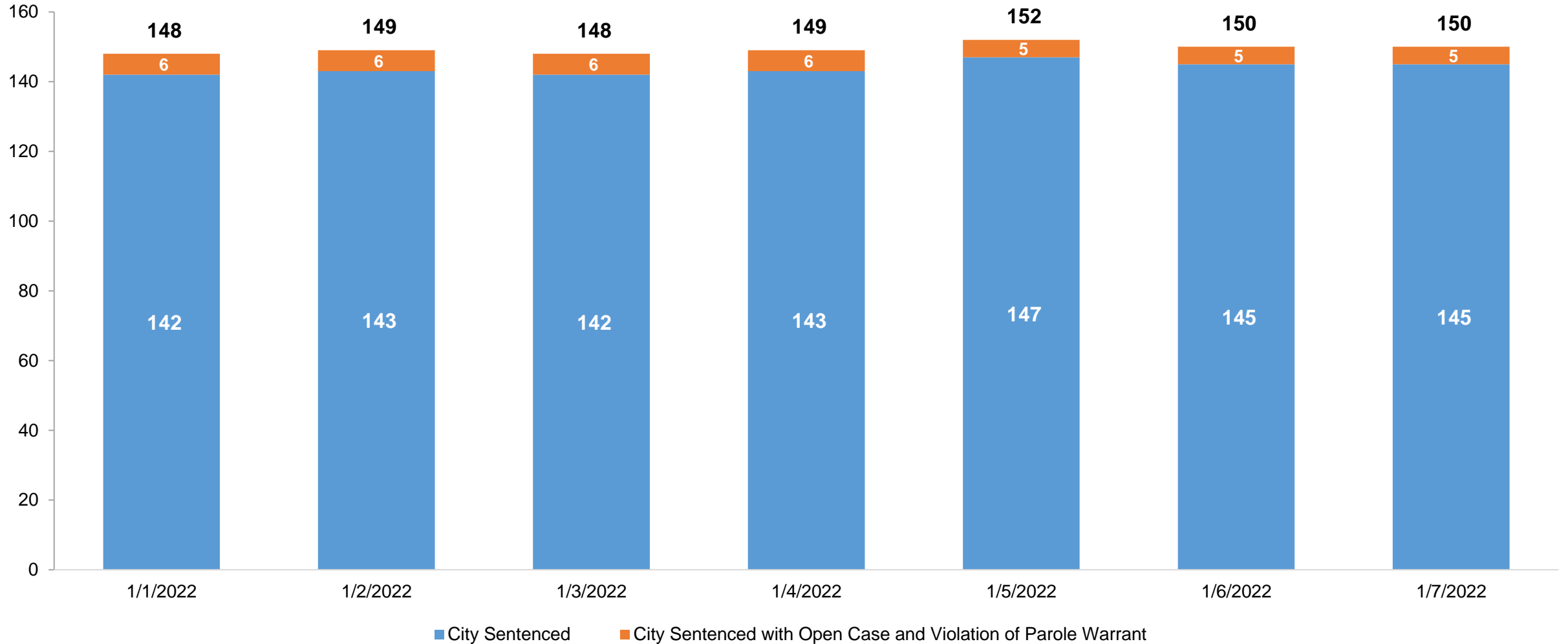

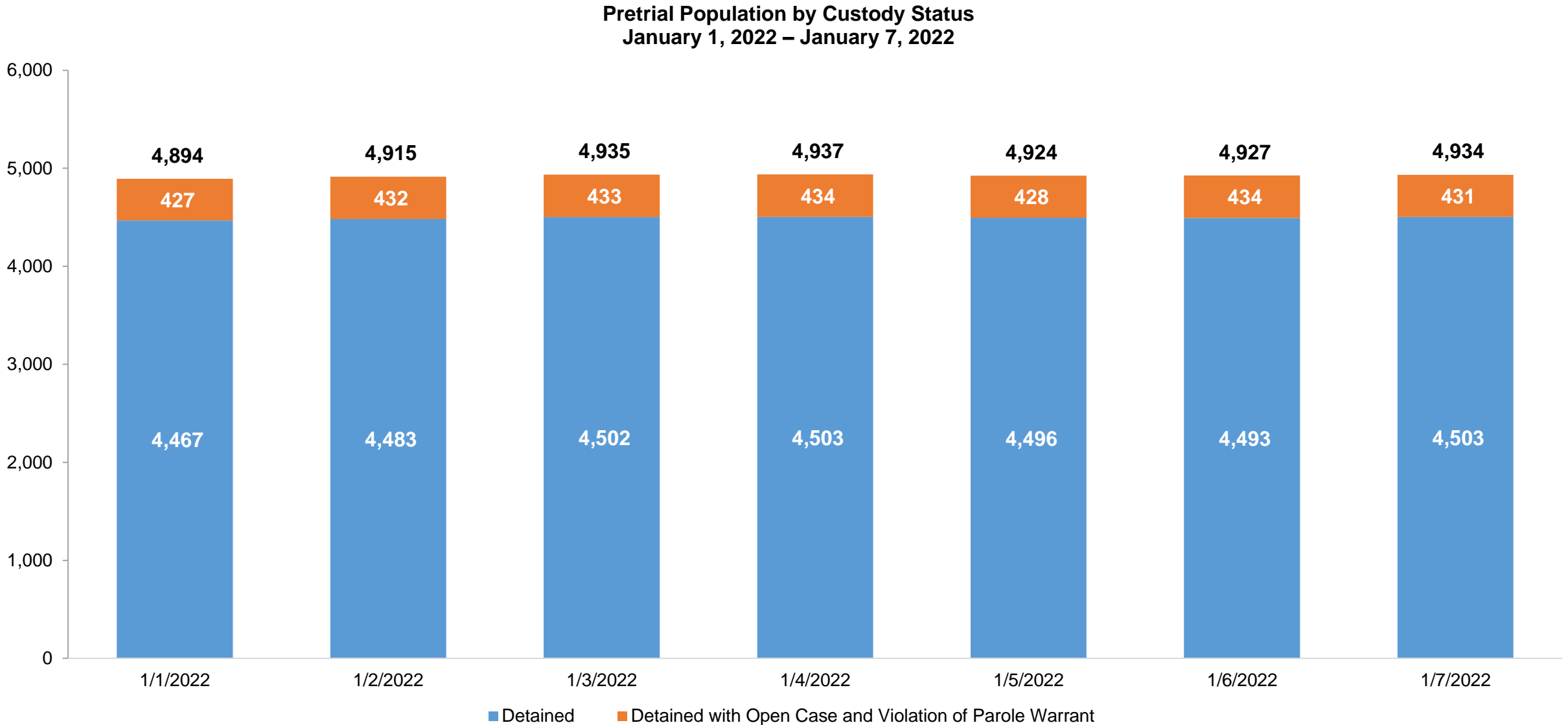

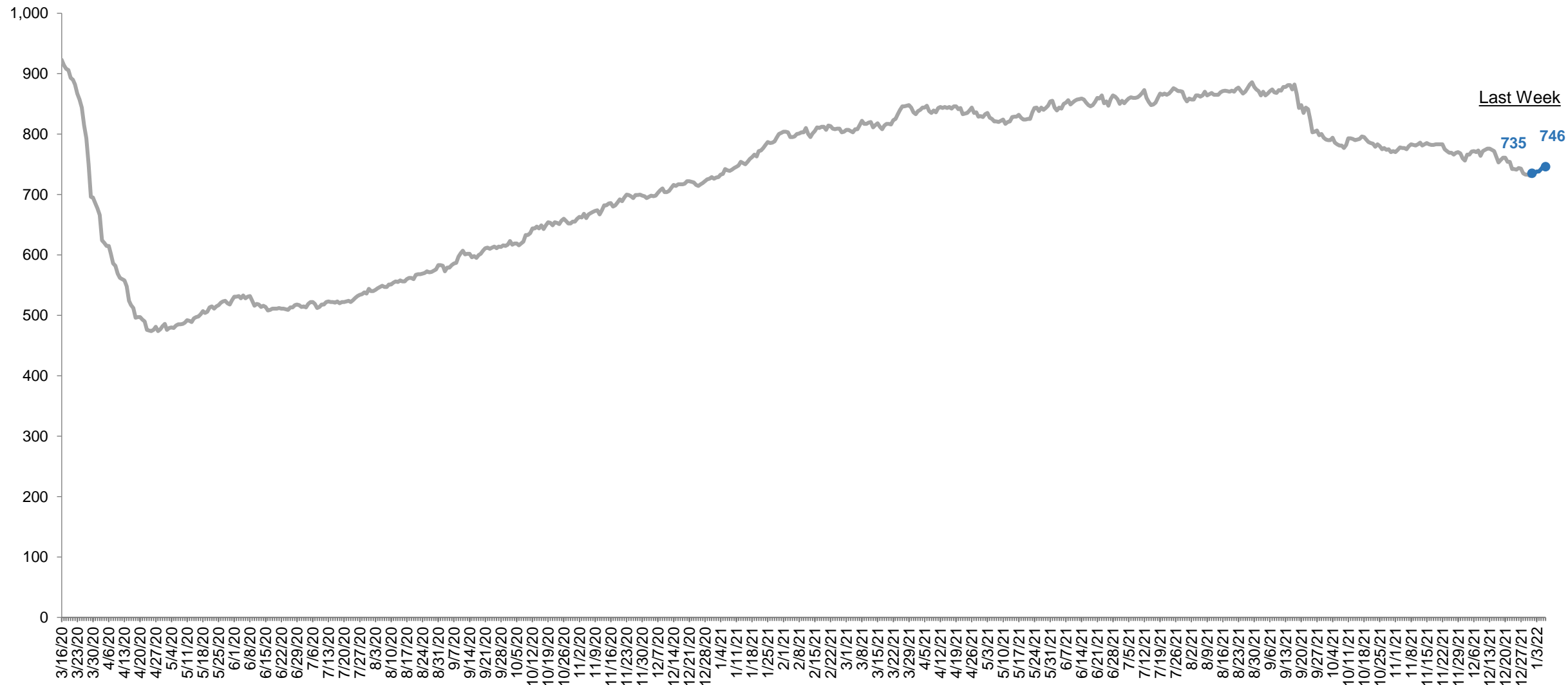

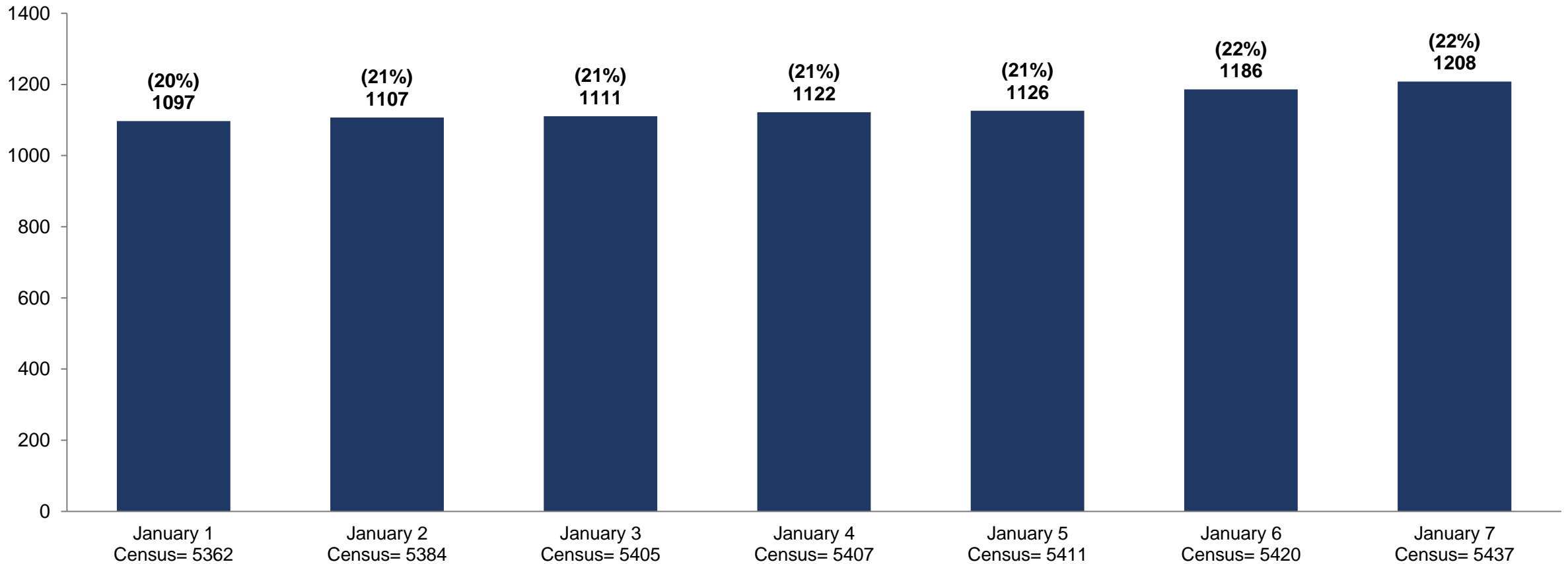

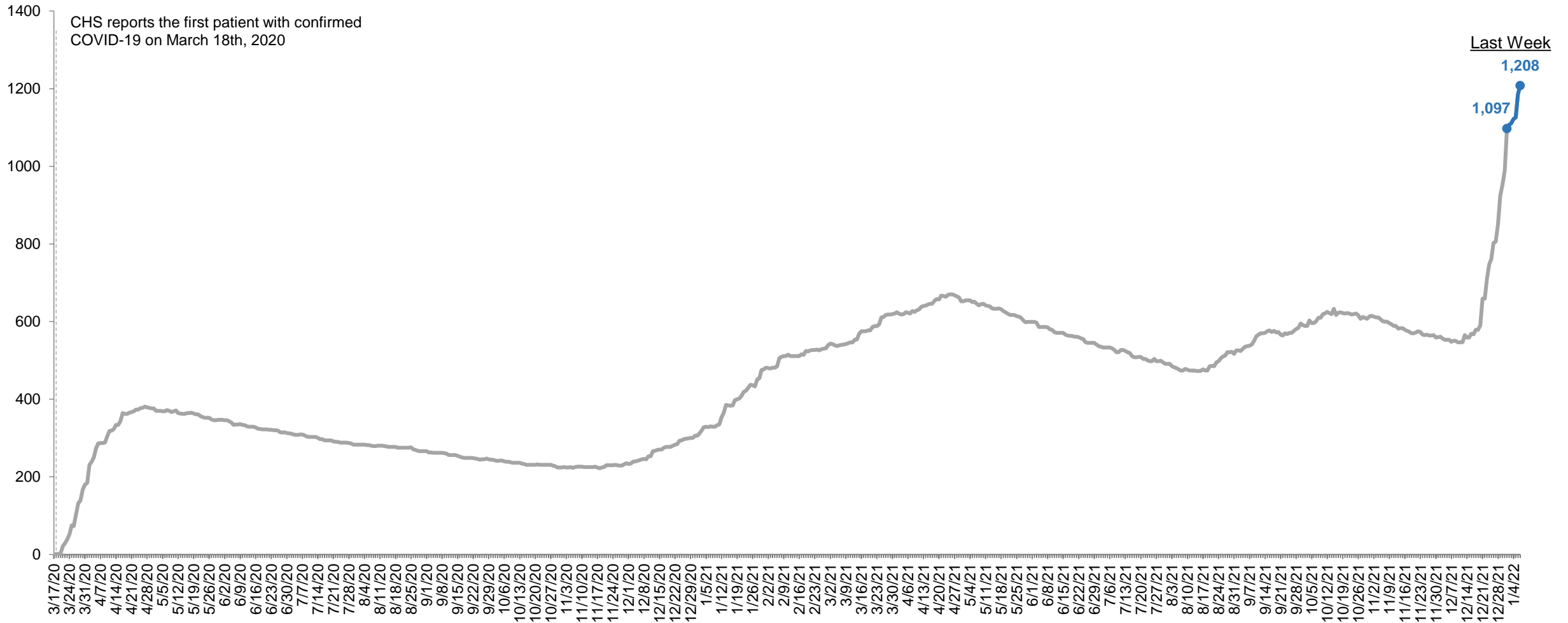
**Number and Percent of Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody

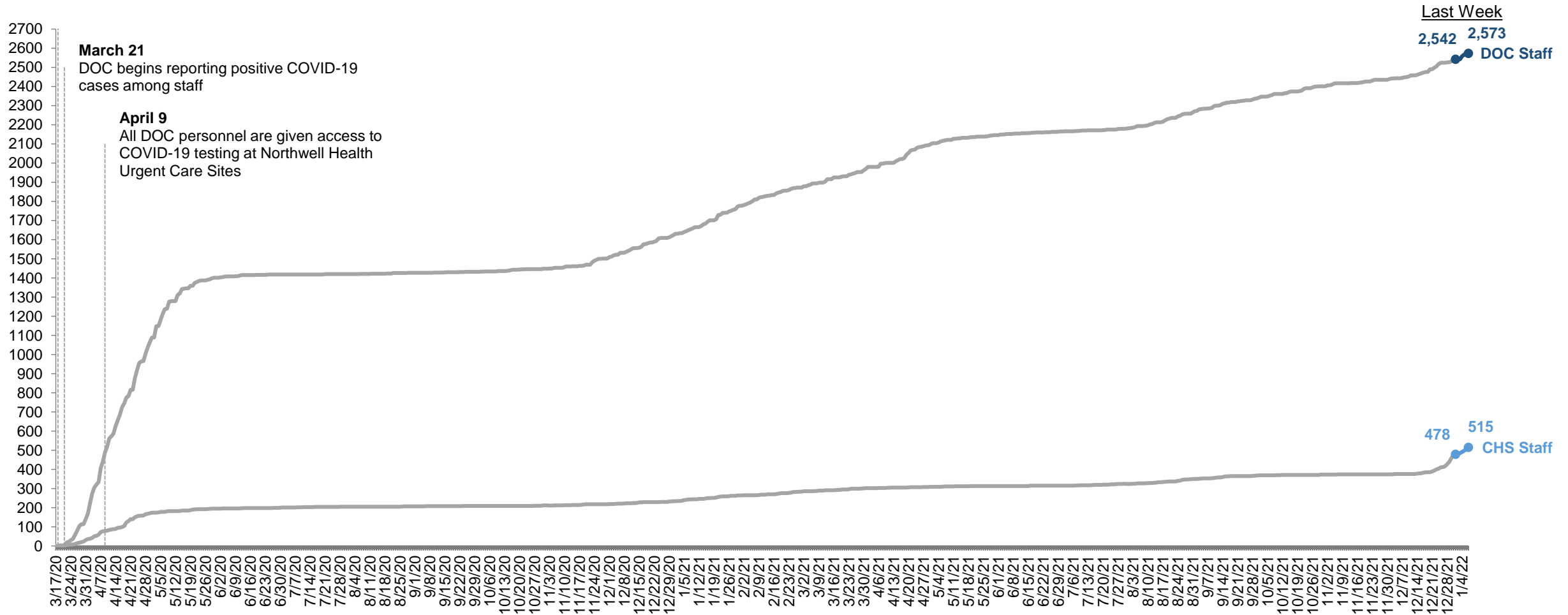
**Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody

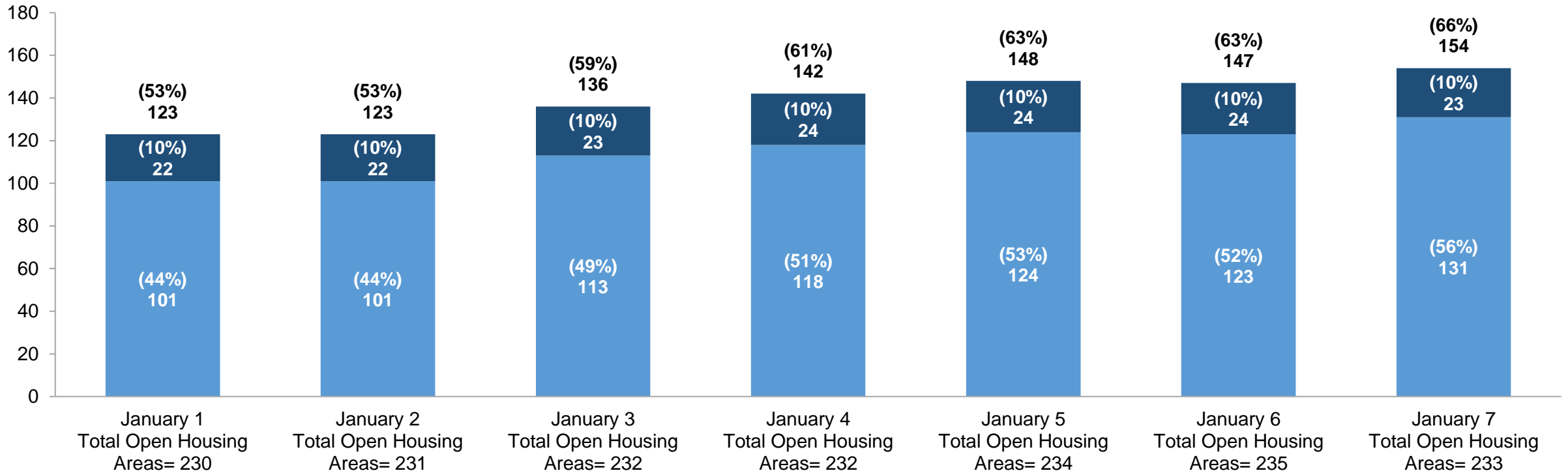

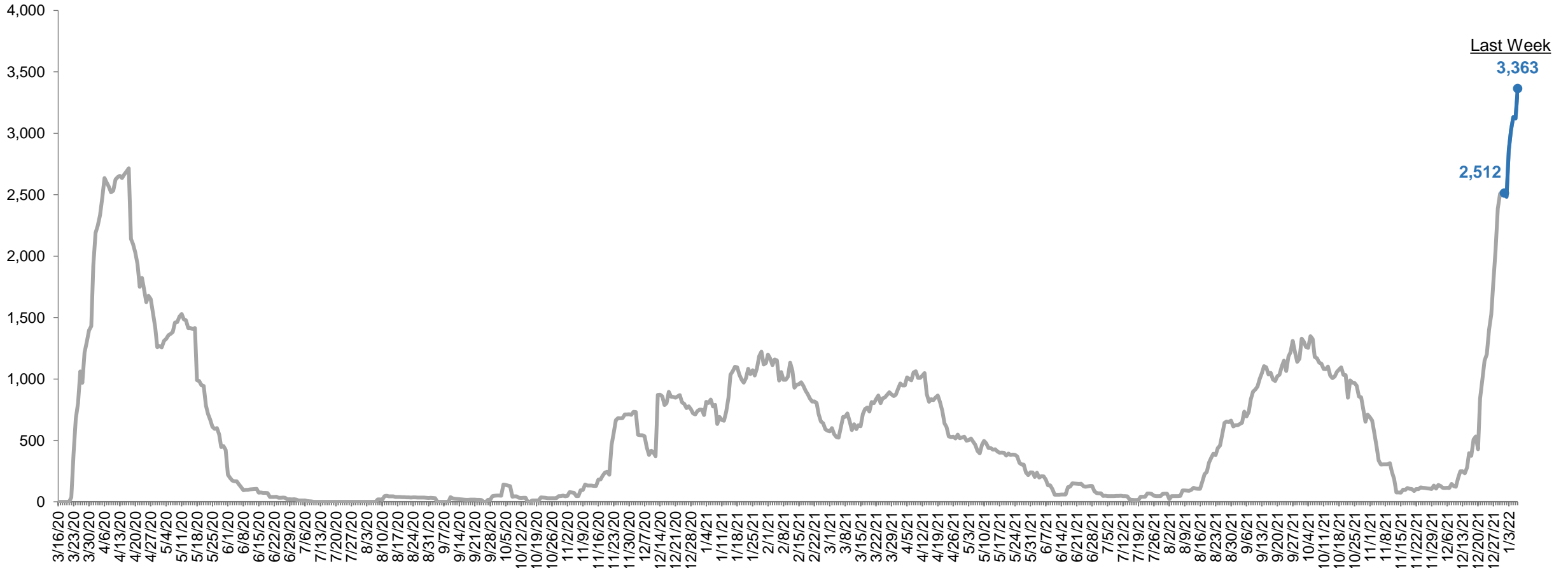

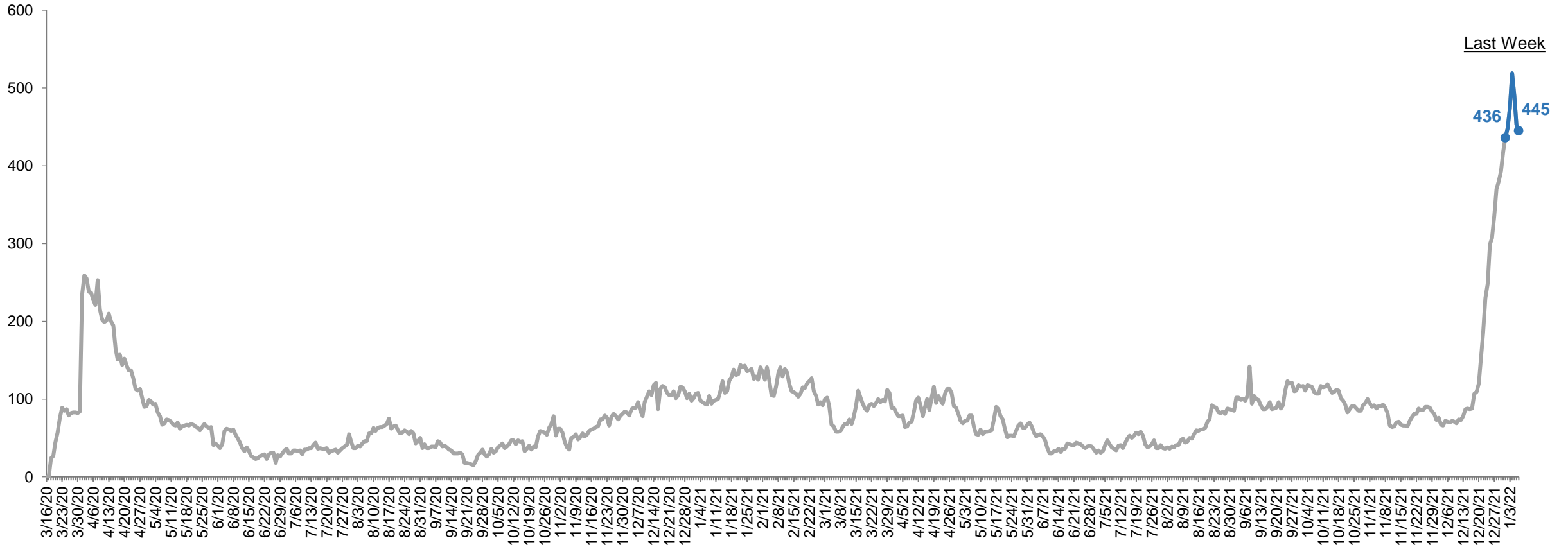

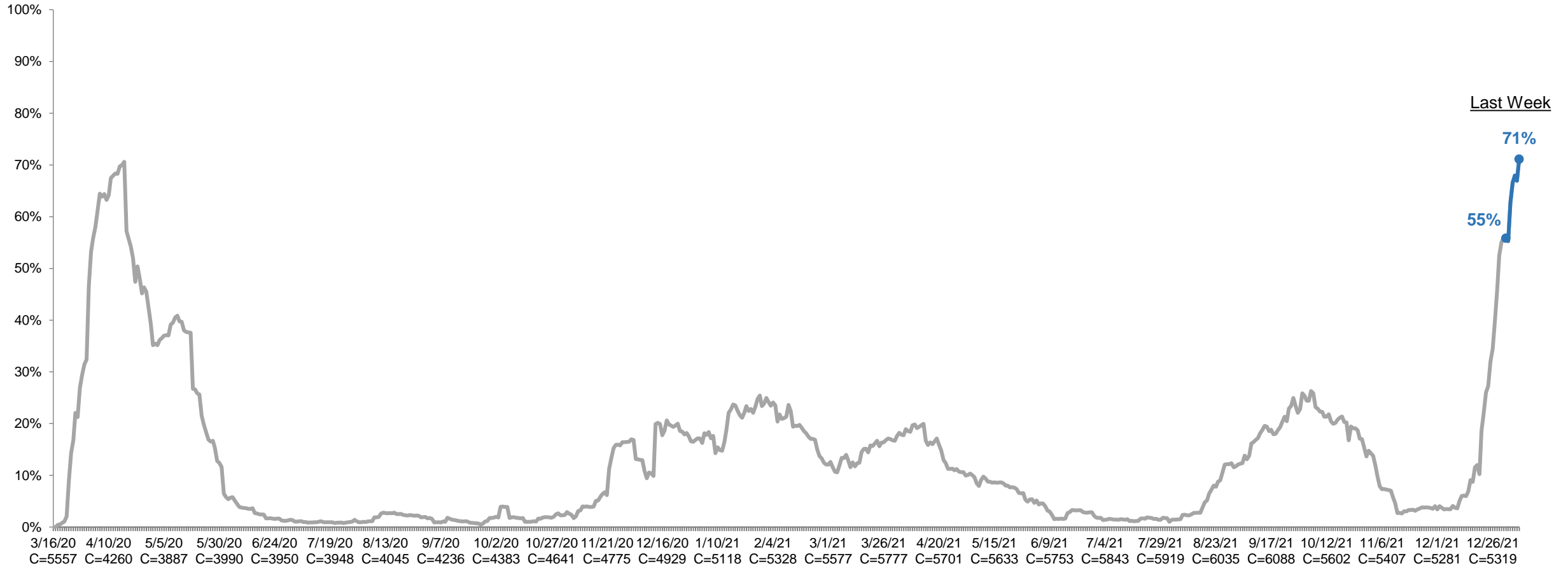

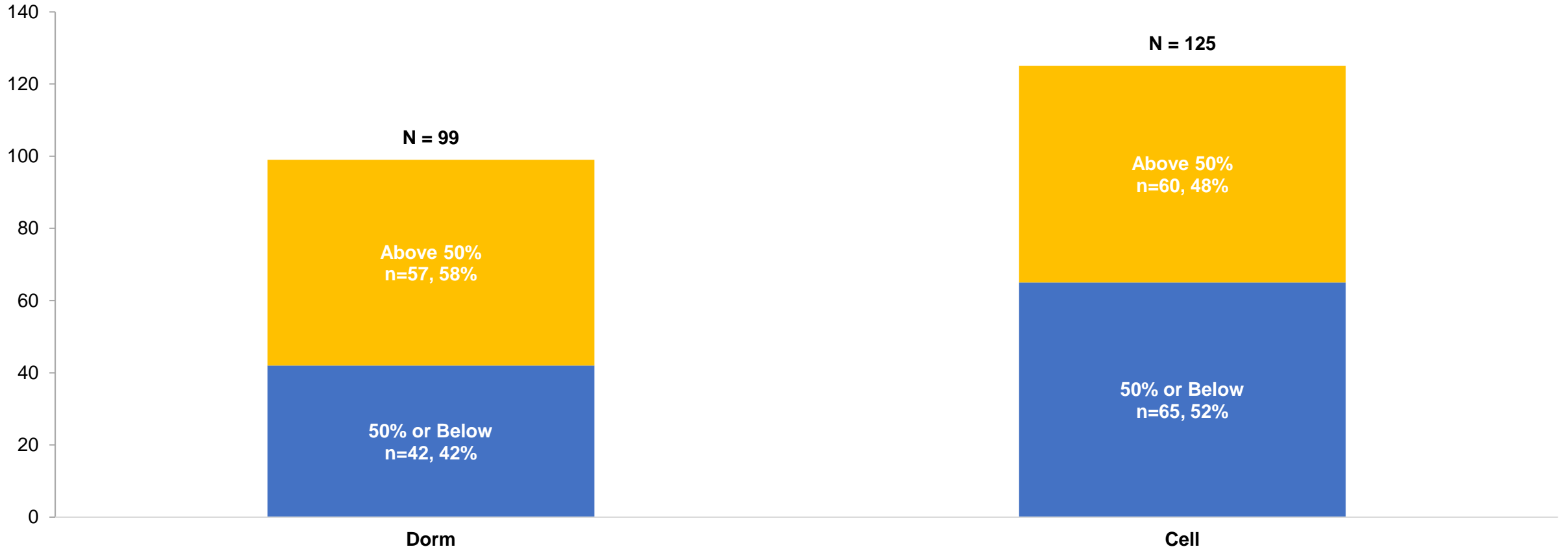

January 6, 2022



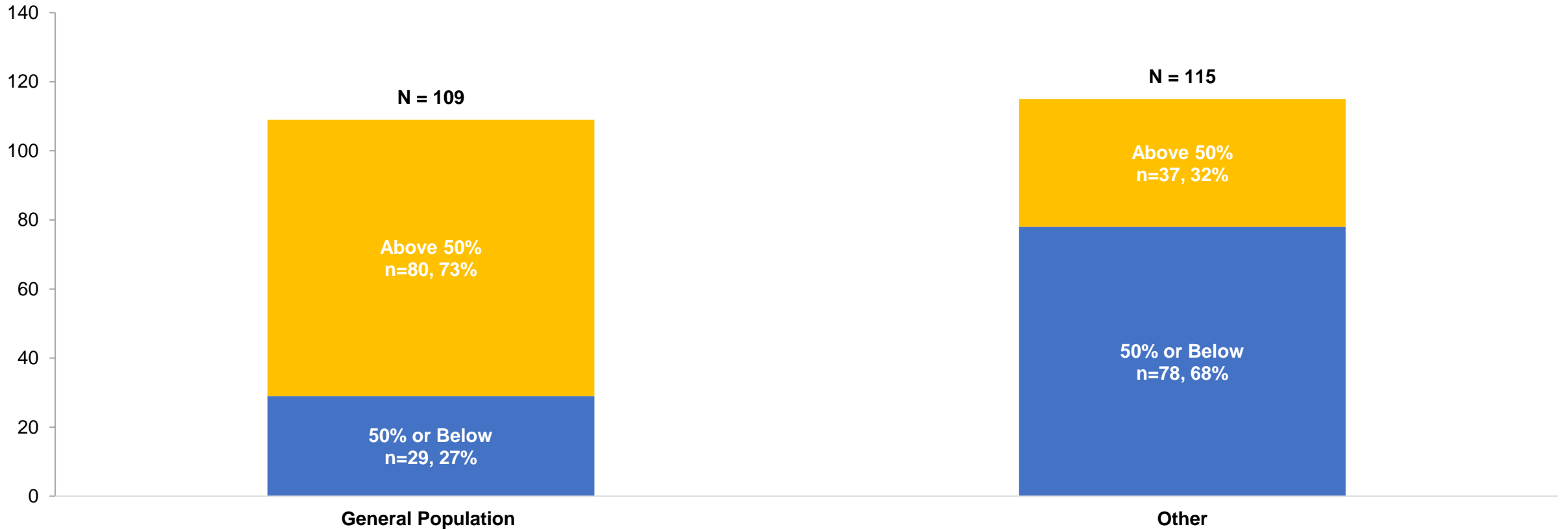

January 6, 2022



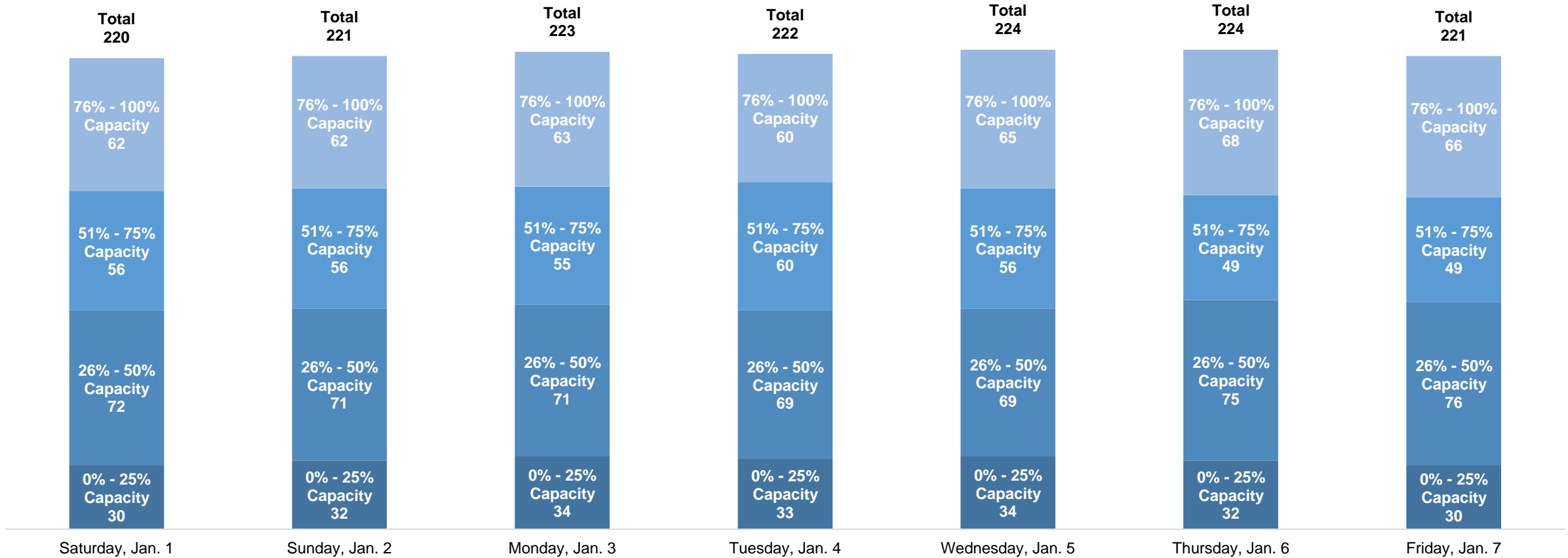
