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




I. Population Change: DOC Population by Custody Status

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 8/01/2020-8/07/2020




I. Population Change: City Sentenced Population by Custody Status




^{*}CHS stopped reporting the number of patients under observation on August 3rd, 2020. This metric was based on the number of people in jail-based housing areas with a COVID-19 confirmed or symptomatic designation. With the spread of the coronavirus in the jails currently contained, communicable disease units may include patients other than those who have been diagnosed with or are symptomatic for the virus. As such, this metric is no longer the best proxy to determine the number of infectious COVID cases. To more accurately determine the total number of current known contagious cases in the jail, CHS recommends referring to metrics reported in CHS's Local Law 59 report, noting that this number can be calculated by subtracting metric 3 ("Number of currently incarcerated/detained individuals tested for infection with positive test result and no longer contagious") from metric 2 ("Number of currently incarcerated/detained individuals tested for infection with positive test result").

^{**} This metric includes hospitalized patients.

^{***} The number of CHS patient deaths does not include patients who may have been diagnosed and treated while in custody and died post-release.

Number and Percent of Patients Under Observation or with Confirmed COVID-19 **August 1 - August 7, 2020**











Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 - August 7th, 2020


