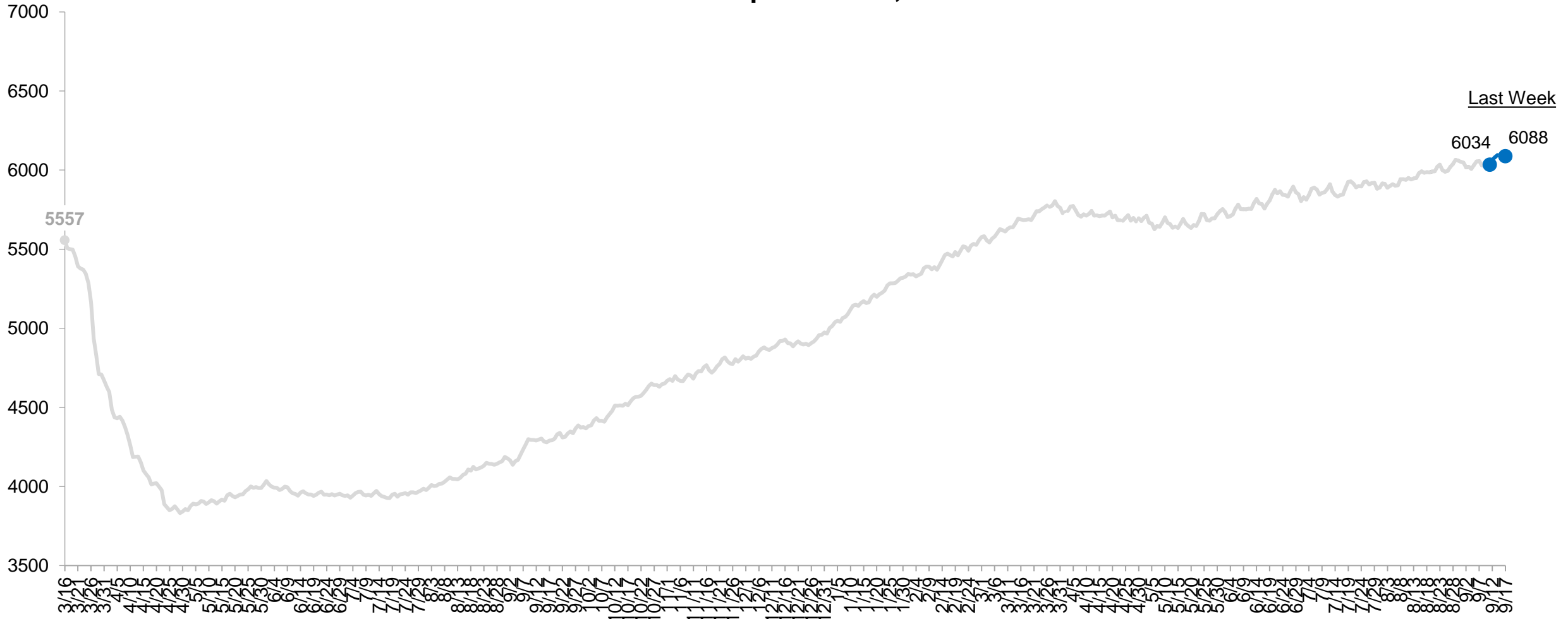

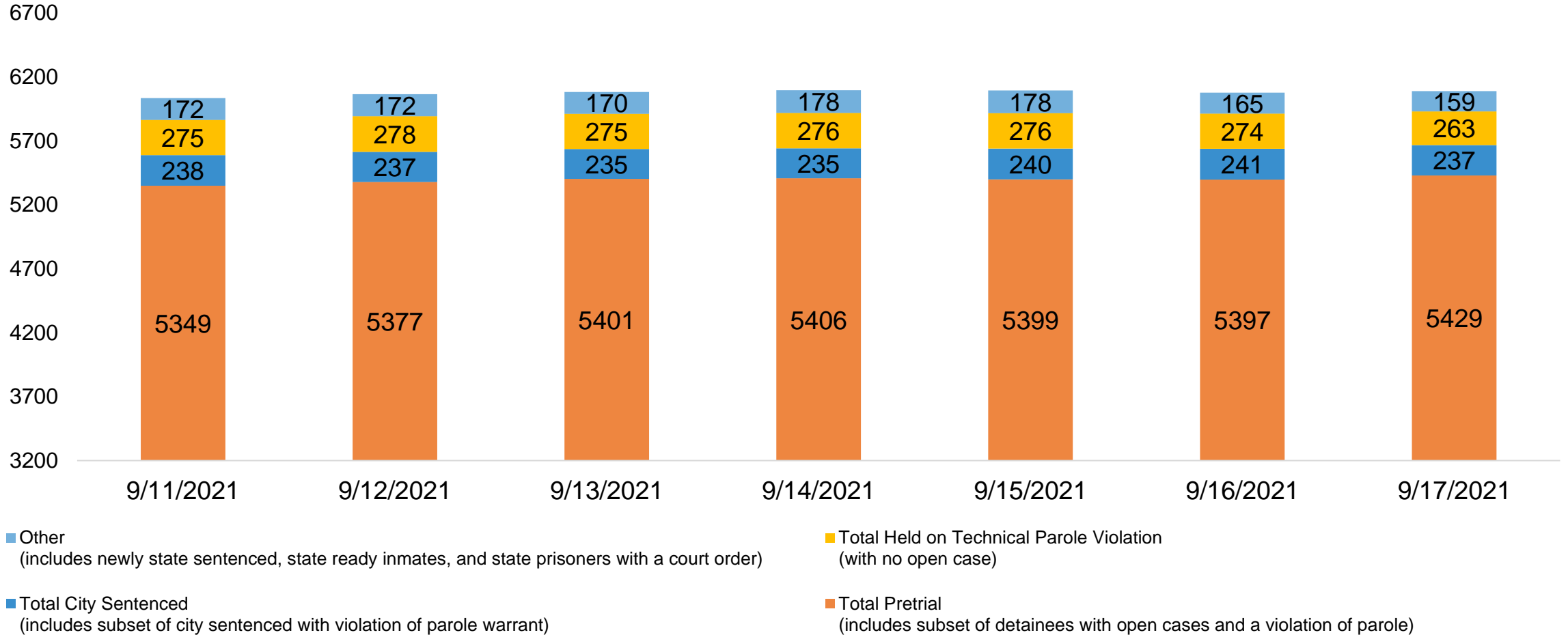
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – September 17, 2021

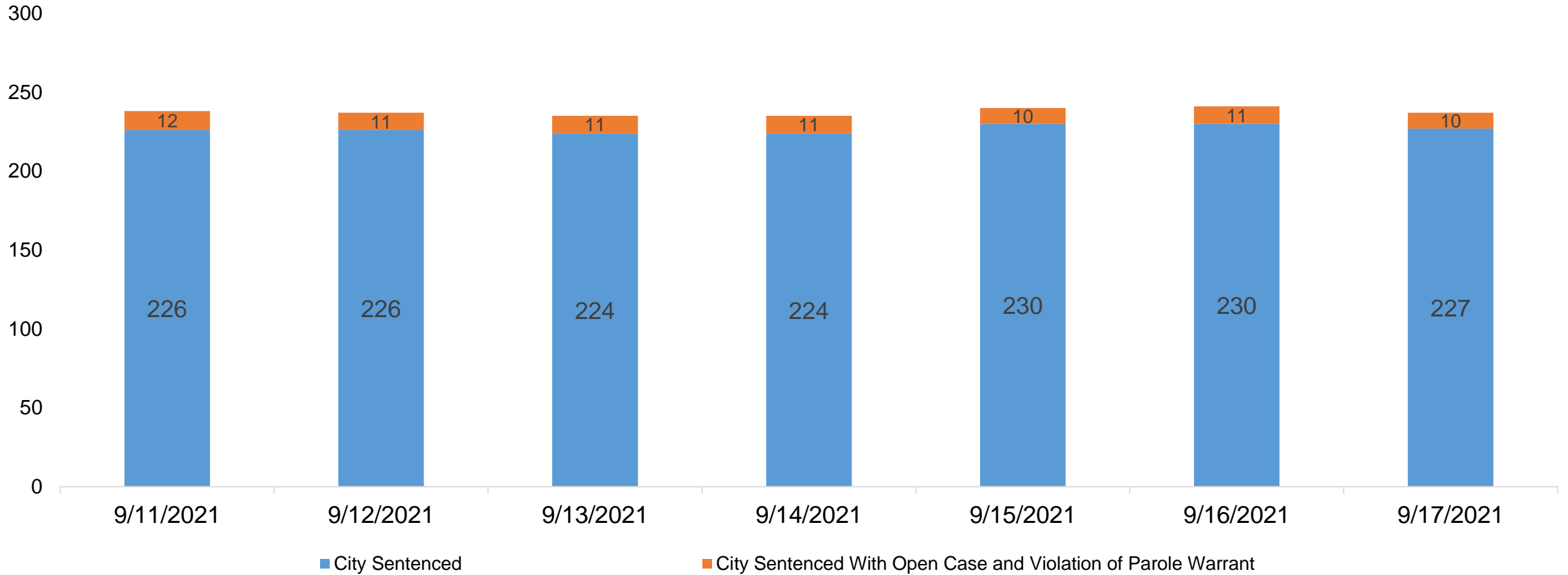

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 9/11/2021 - 9/17/2021



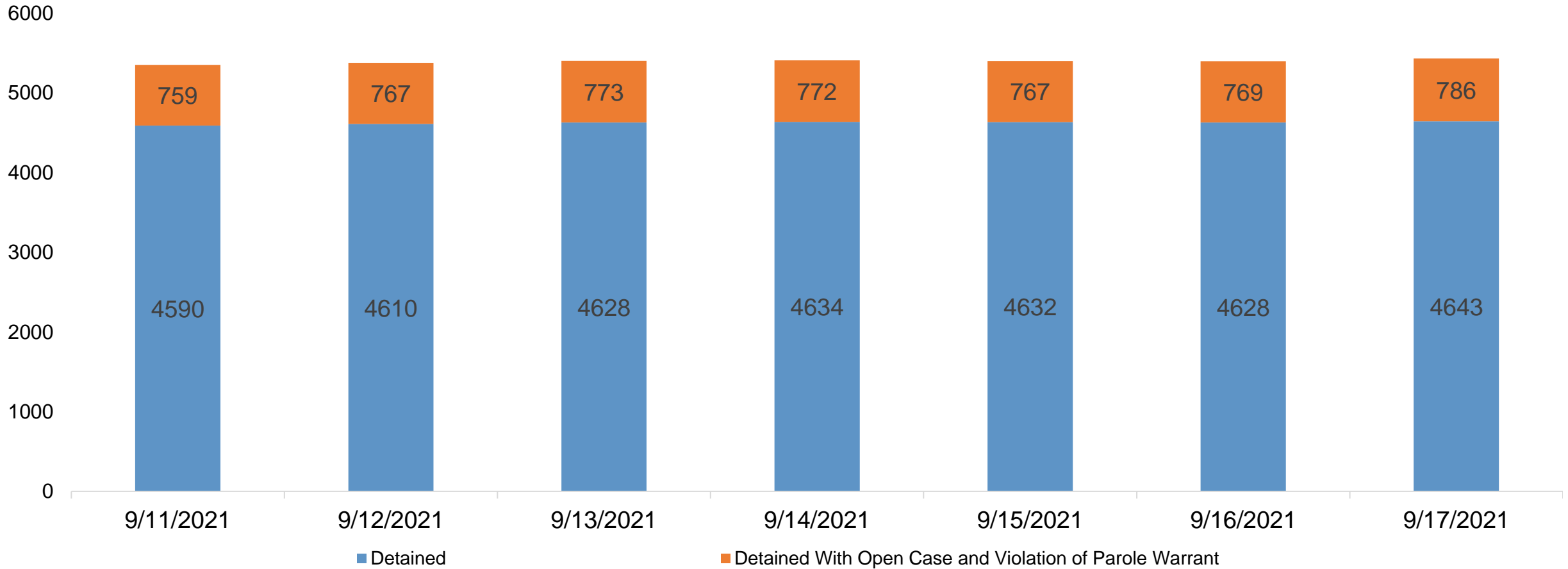

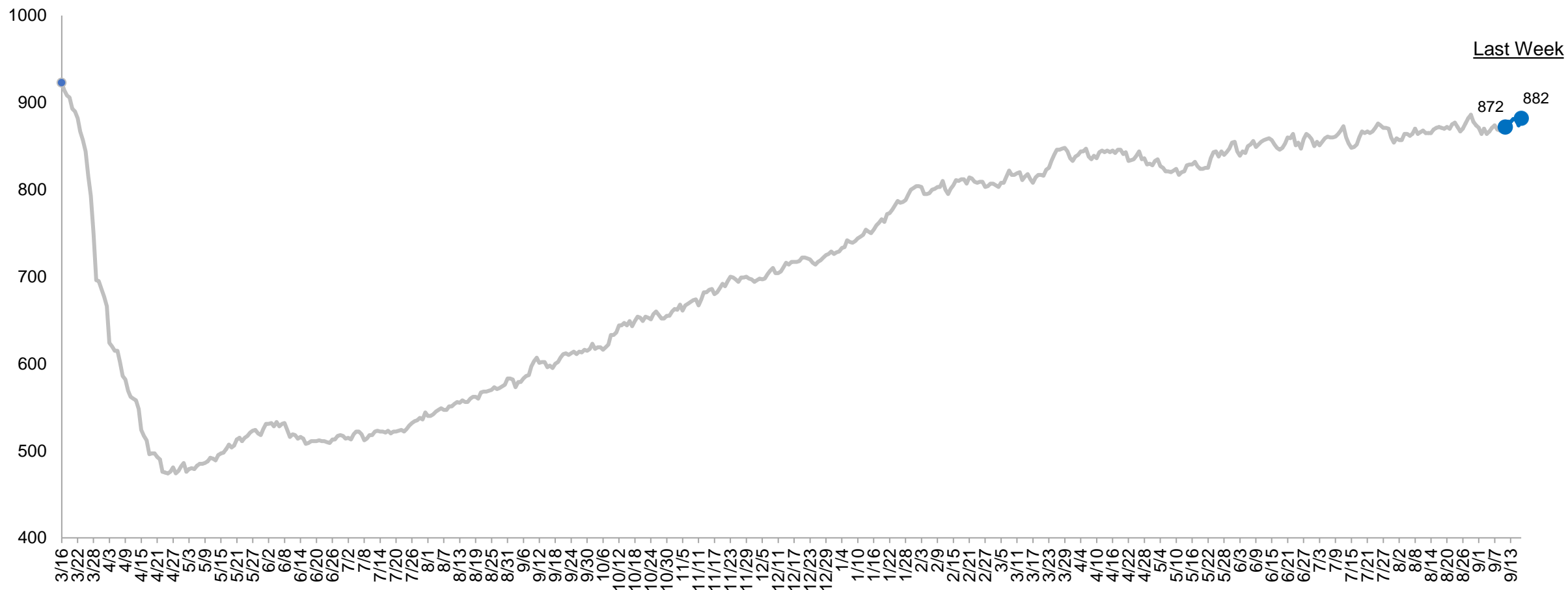

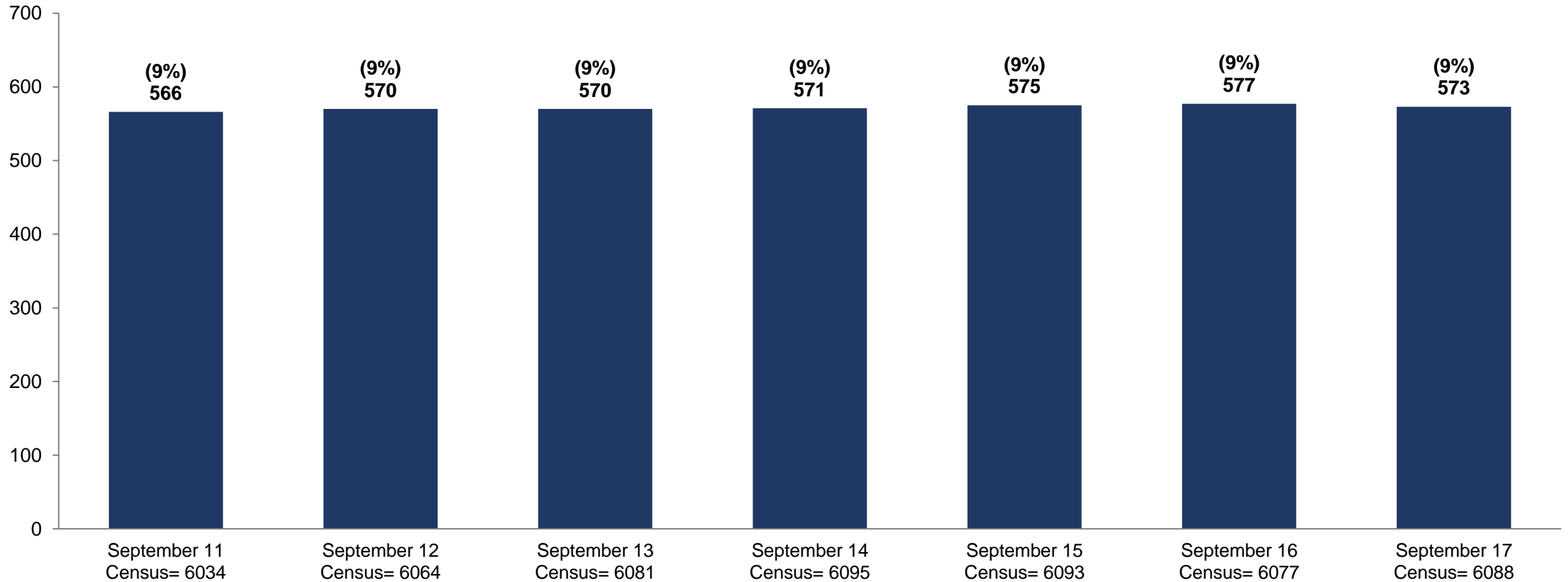

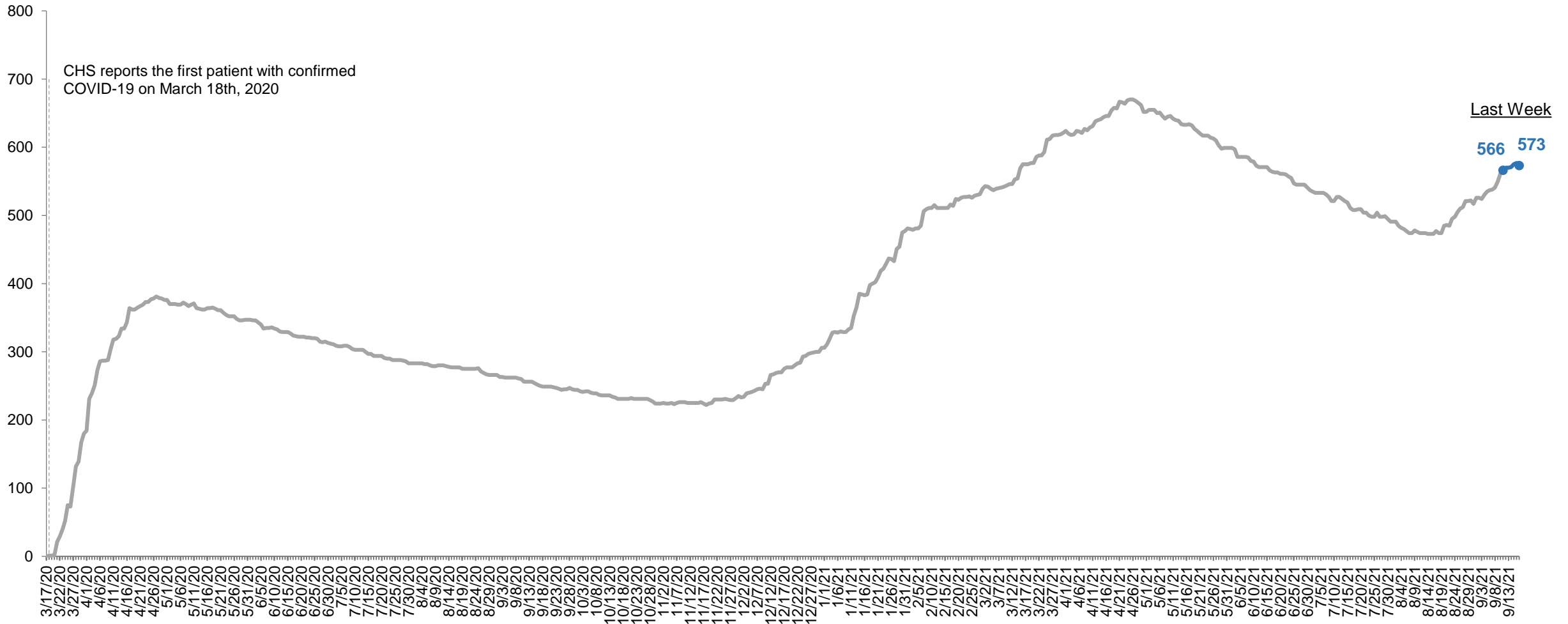
**Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

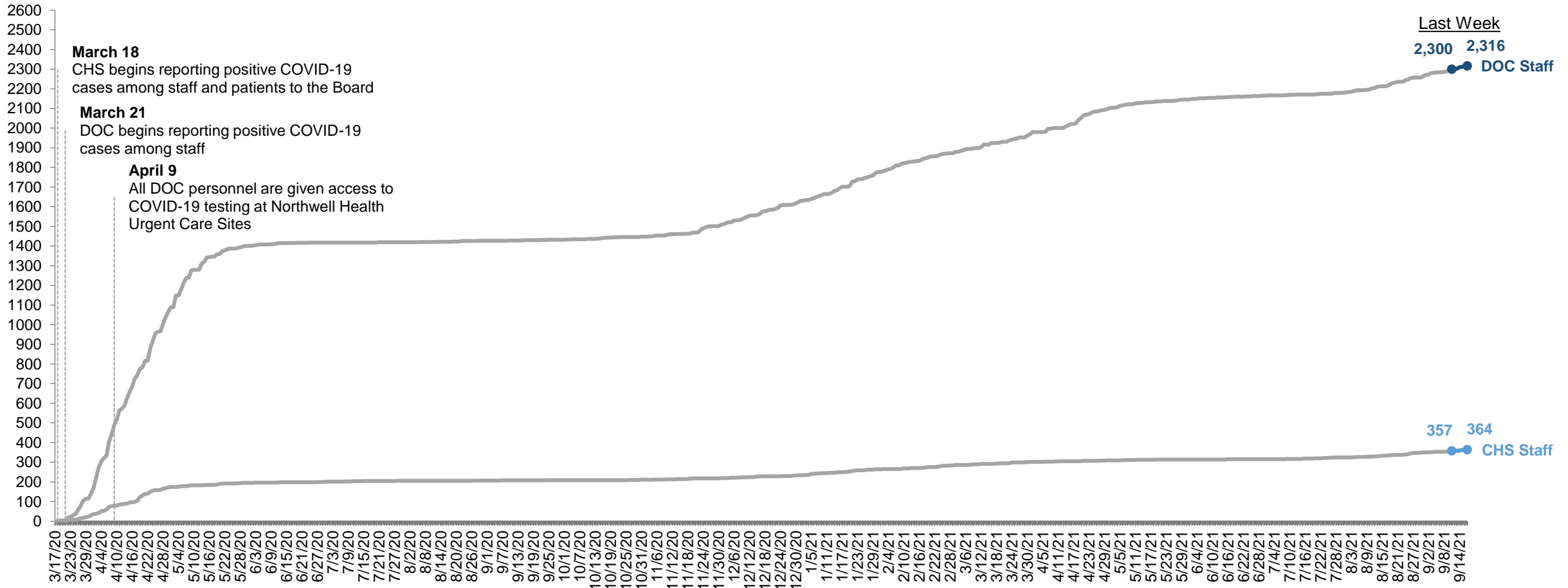
**Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

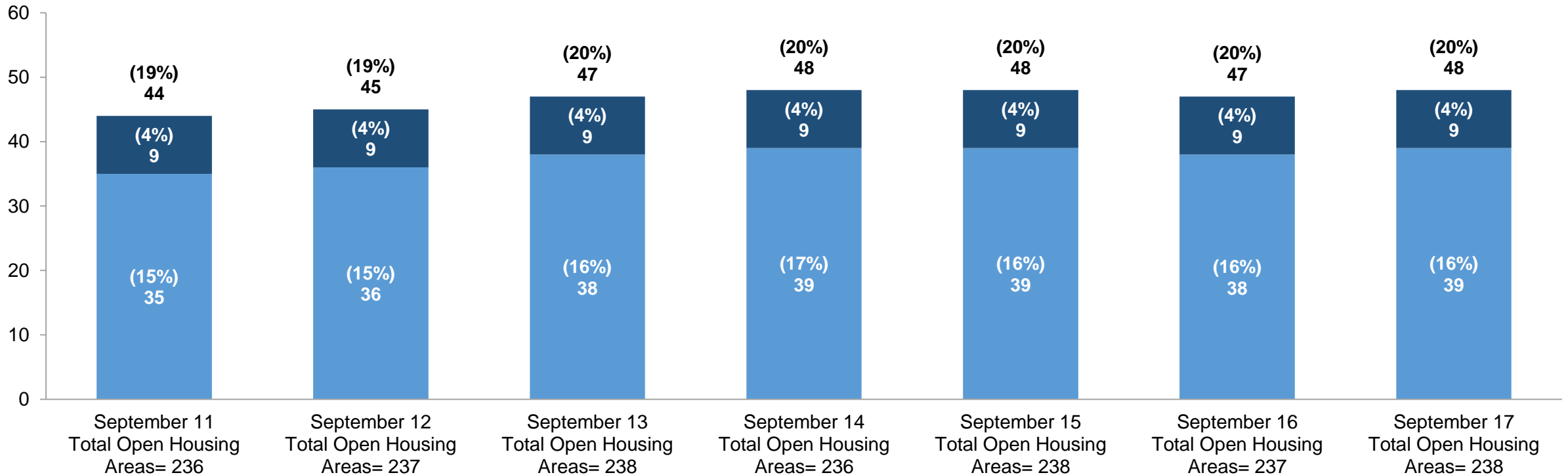

March 16 - September 17, 2021**

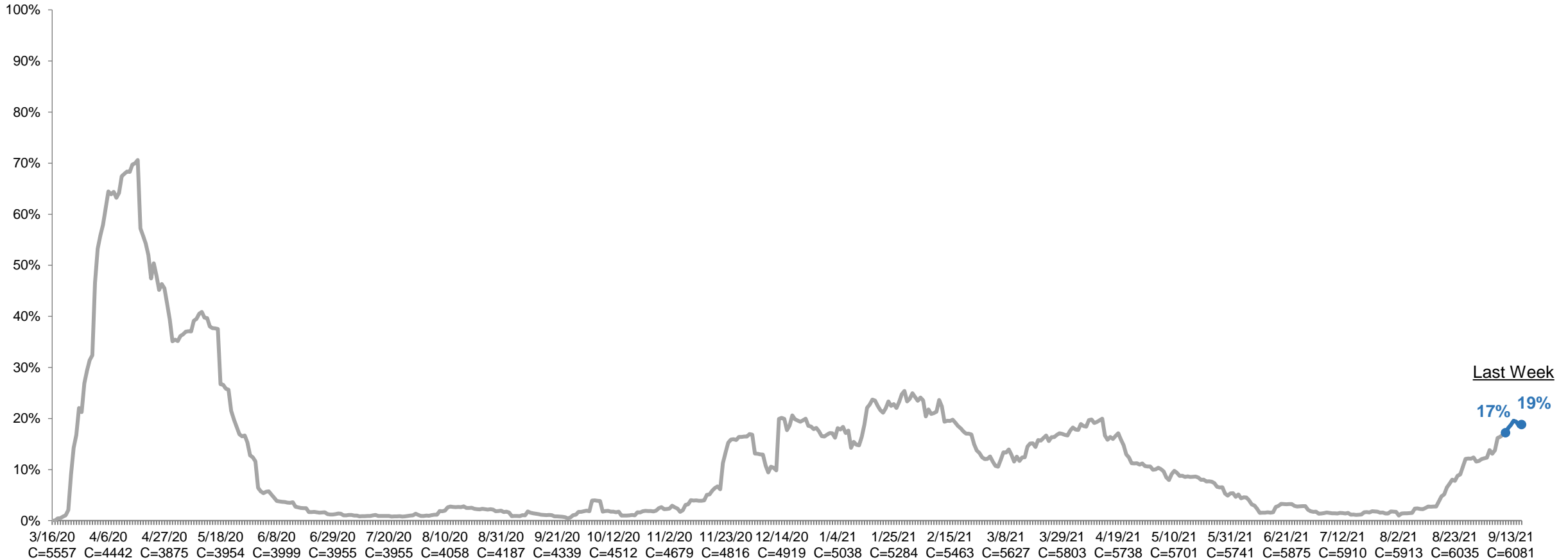

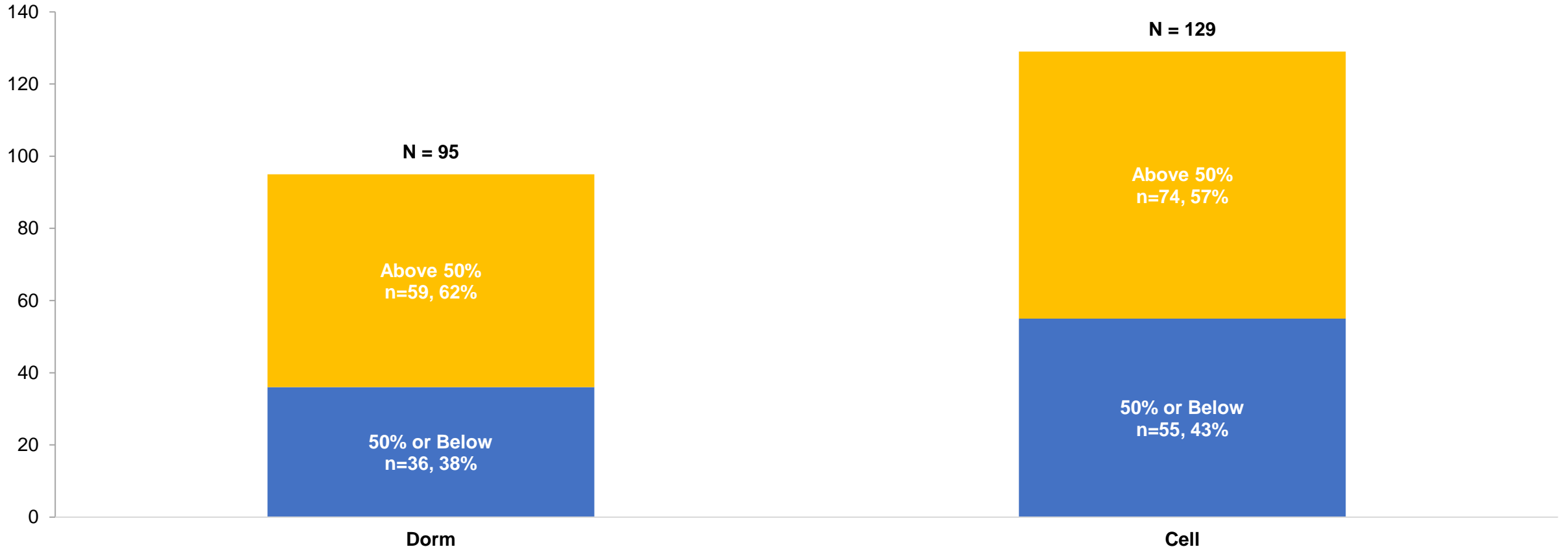

September 16, 2021



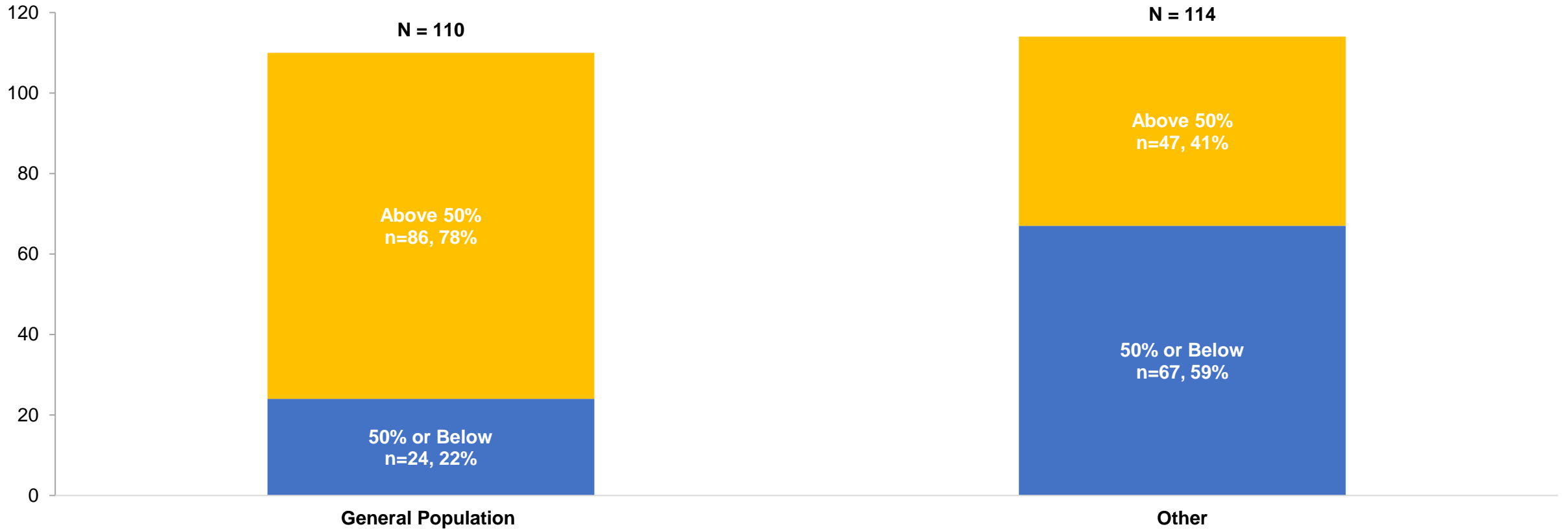

September 16, 2021



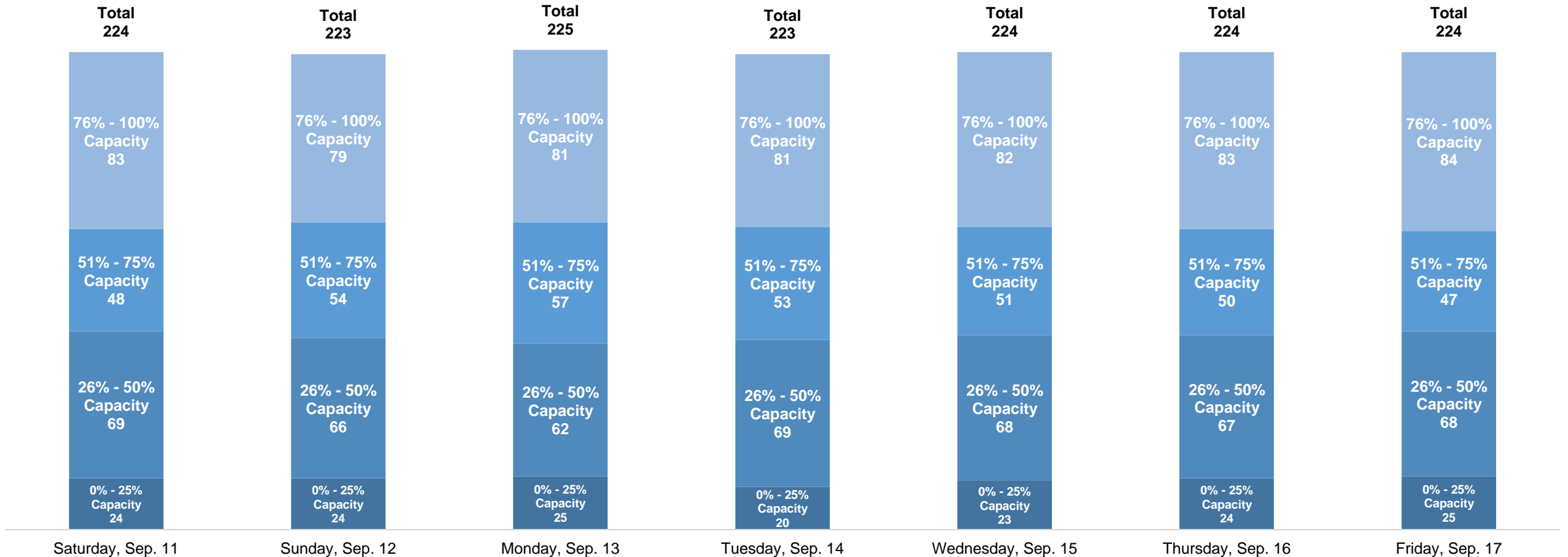
