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



I. Population Change: Total Population in DOC Custody





Total DOC Population by Custody Status October 2, 2021 – October 8, 2021










Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 October 2 – October 8, 2021




Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 March 17, 2020 – October 8, 2021








Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 – October 08, 2021


Number and Percent of Open Units Above and Below 50% Capacity by Housing Category October 7, 2021
