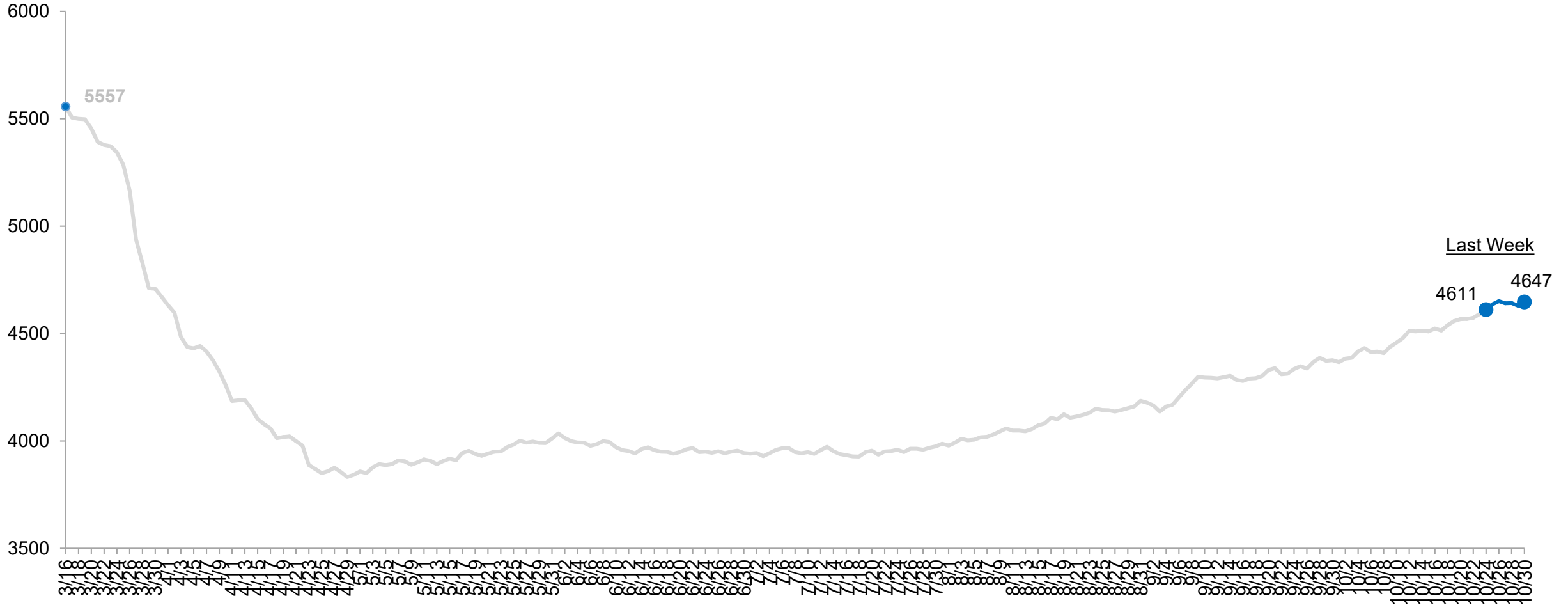

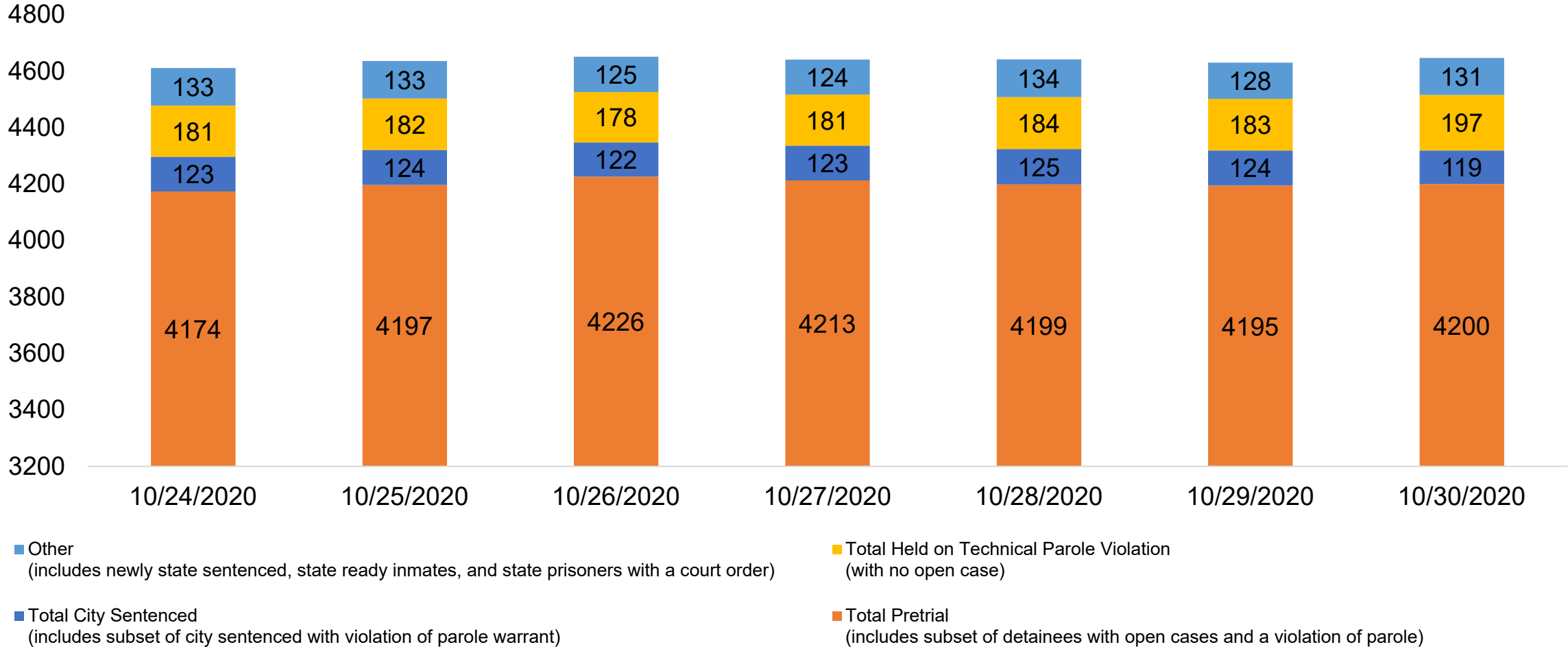
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – October 30, 2020

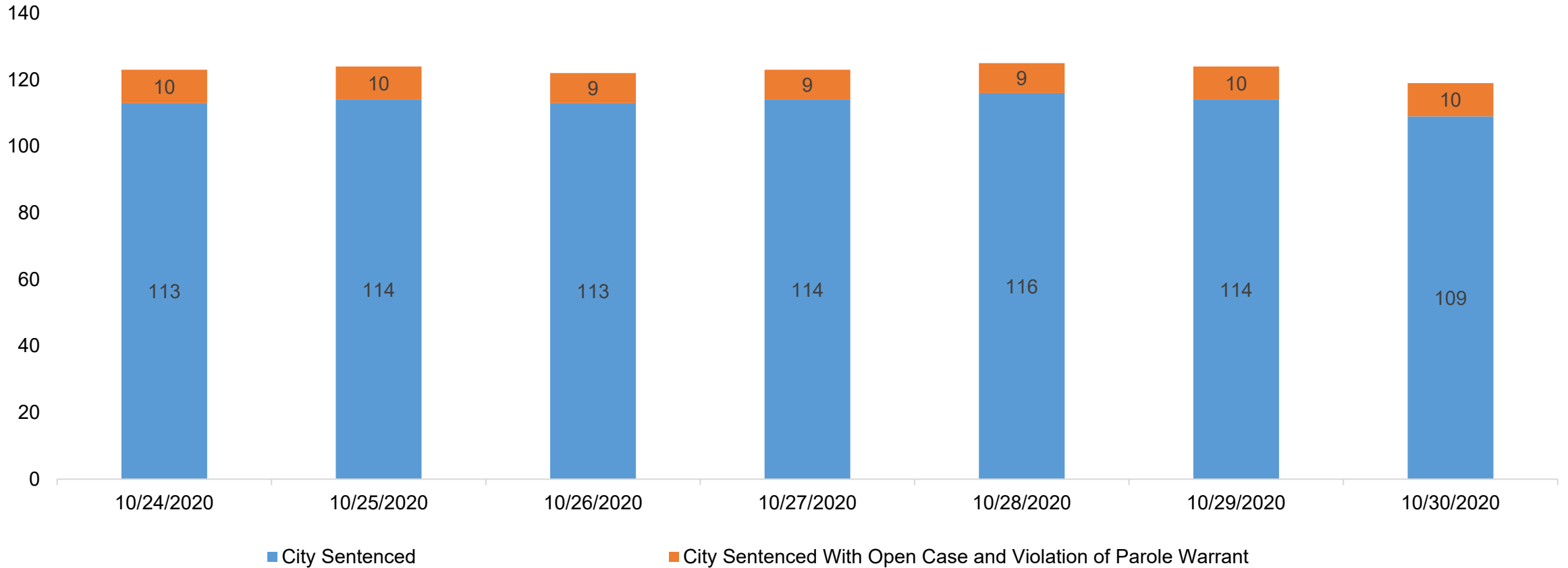

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 10/24/20-10/30/2020



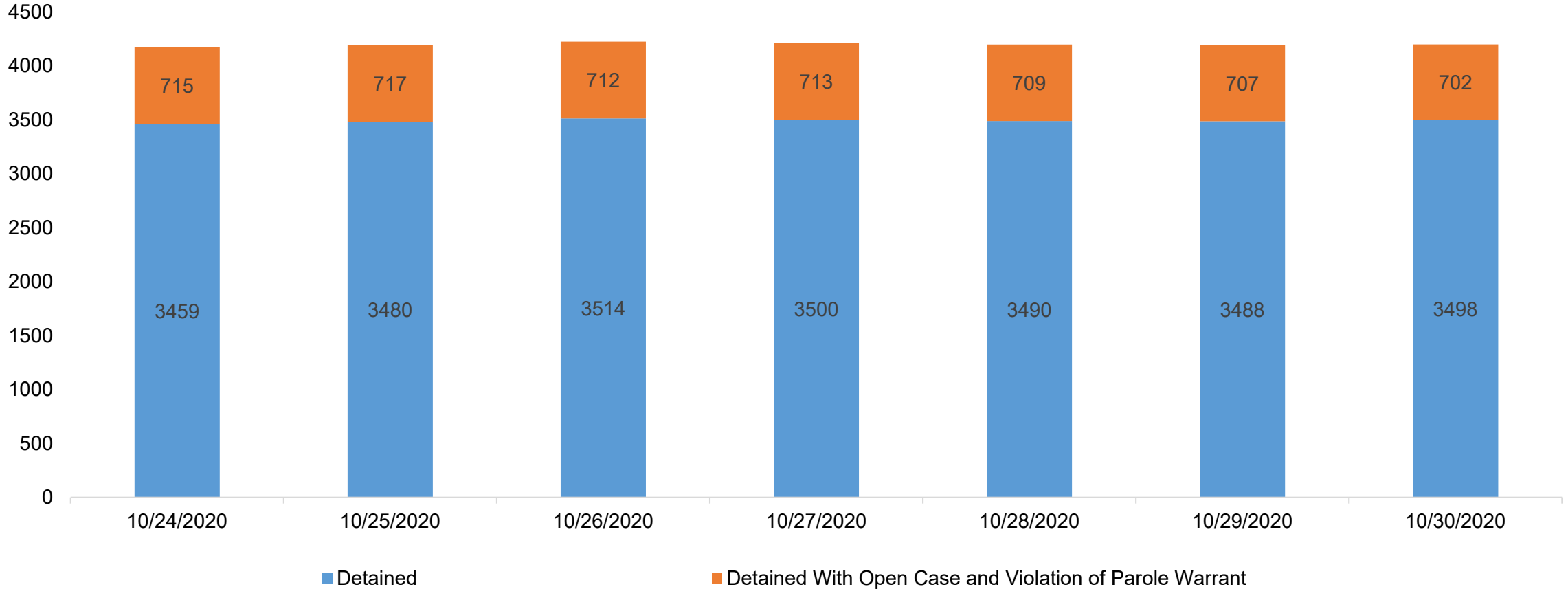

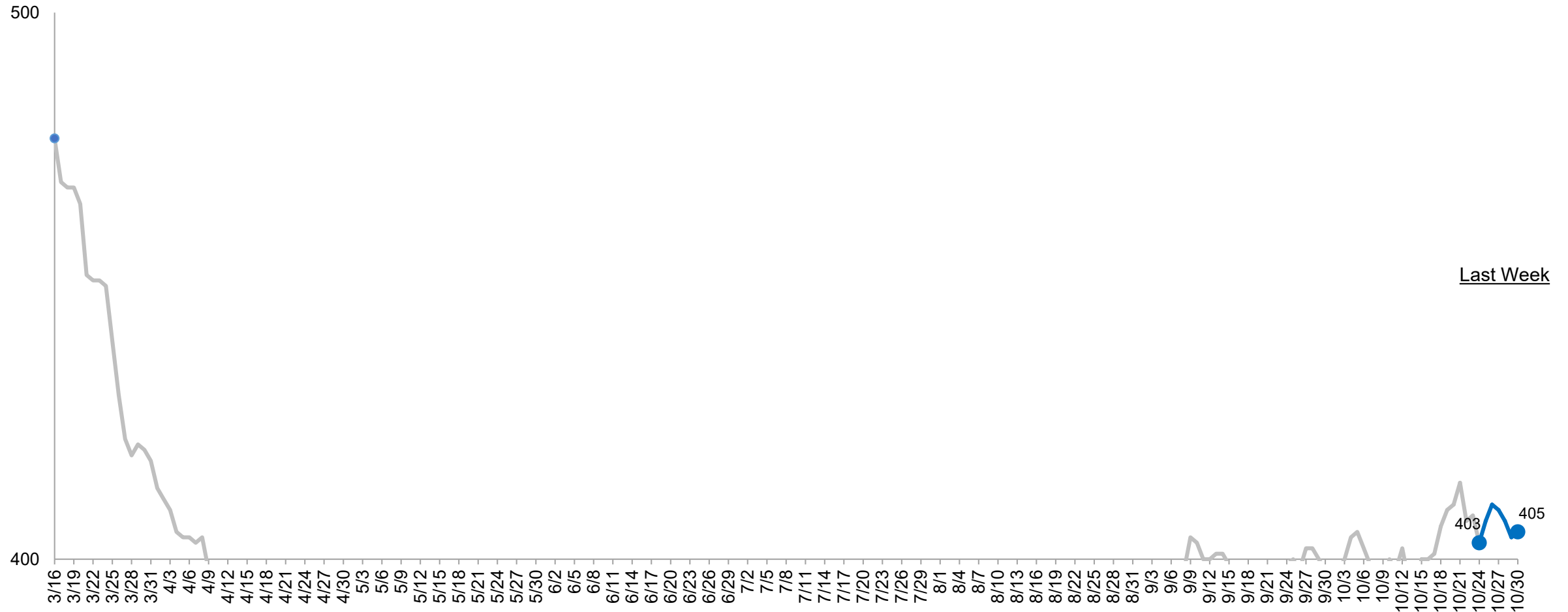

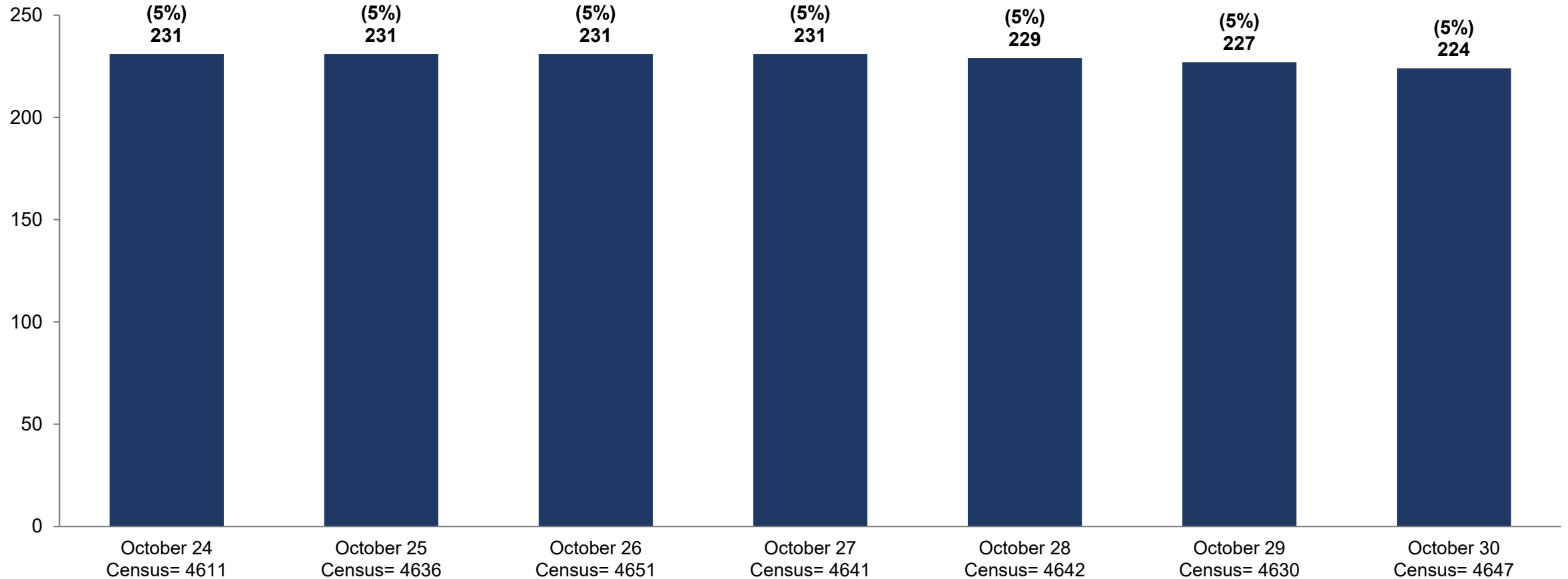

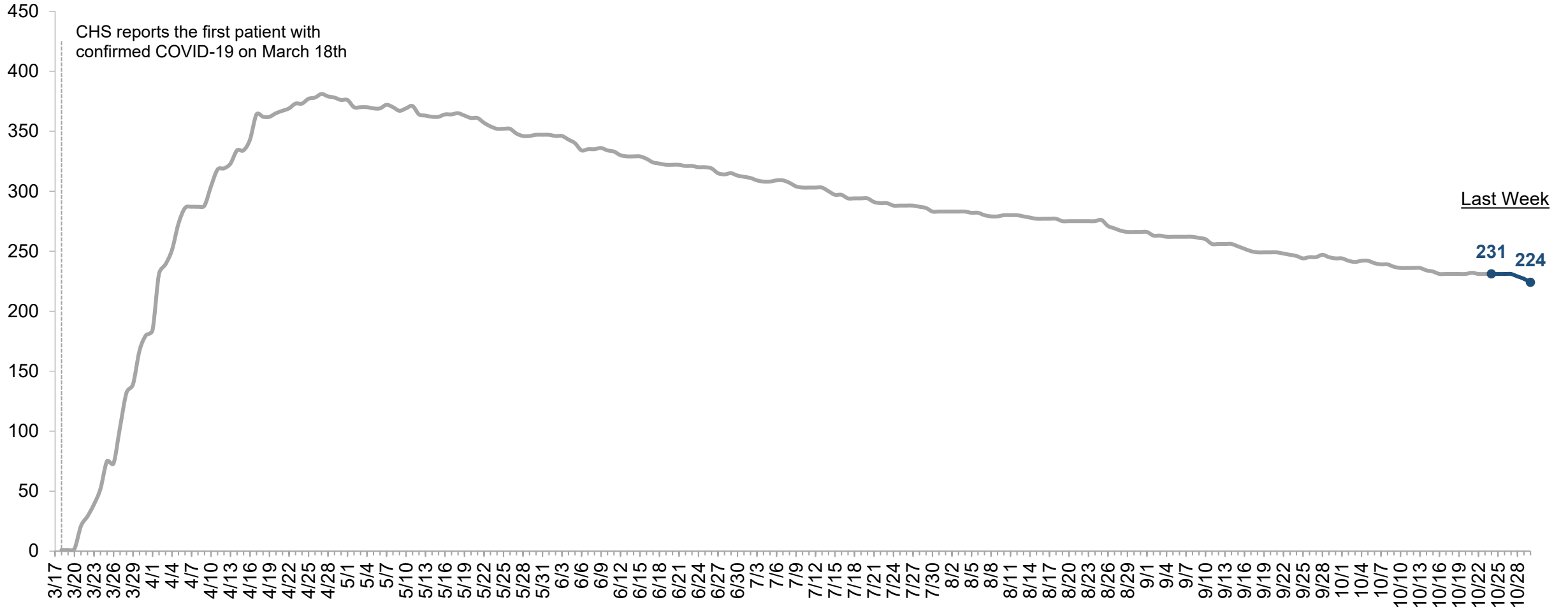
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

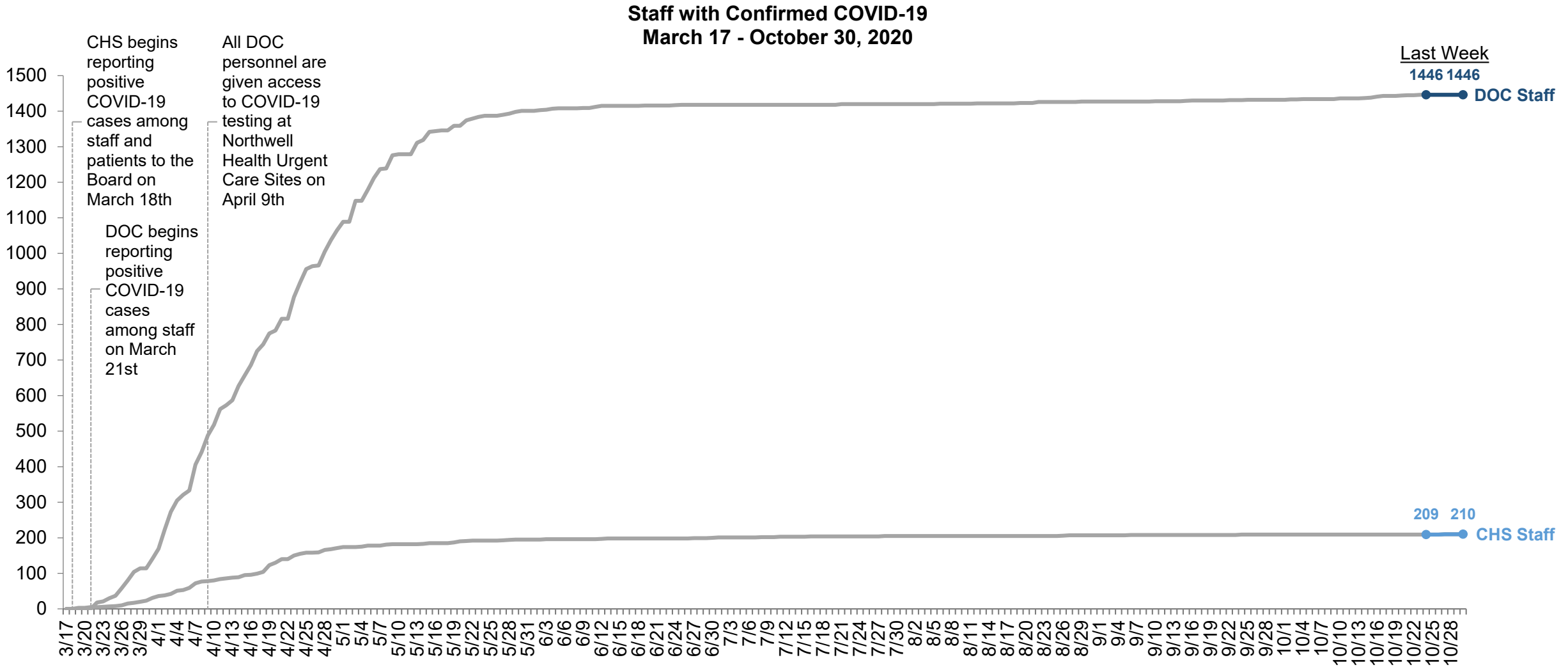

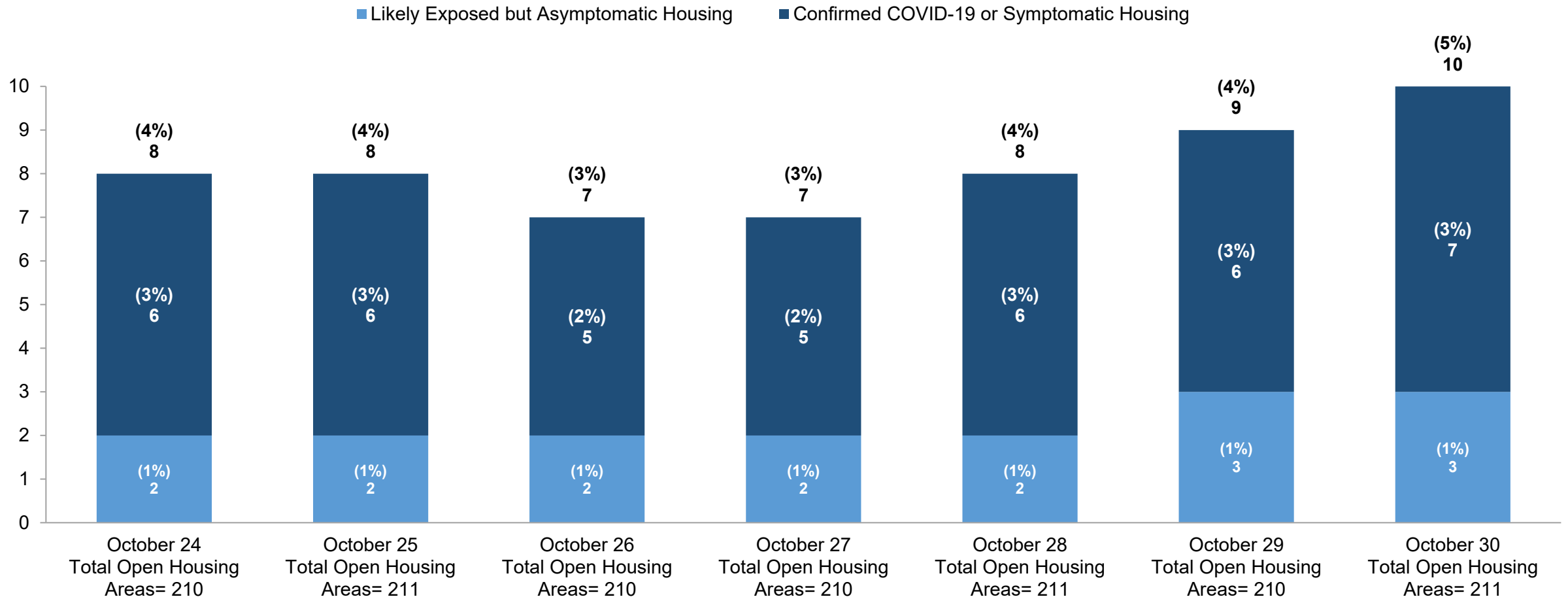

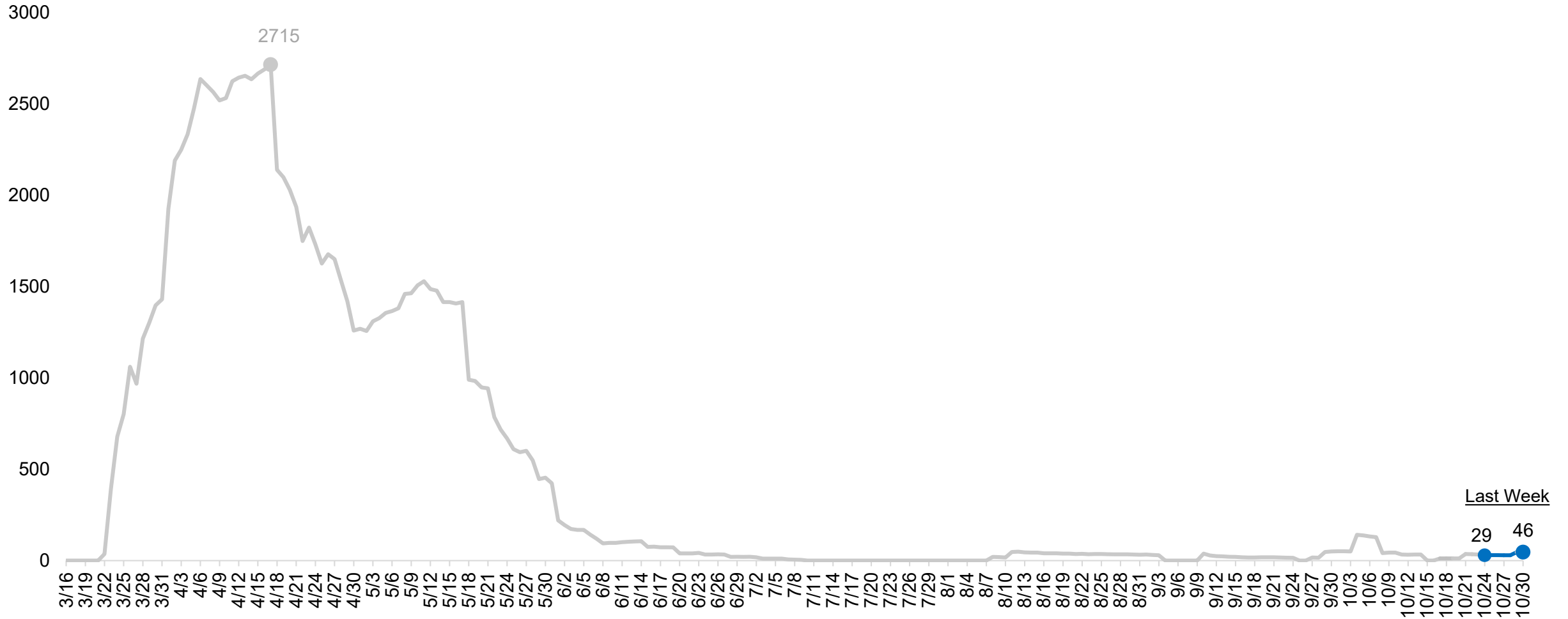

March 16 - October 30, 2020**

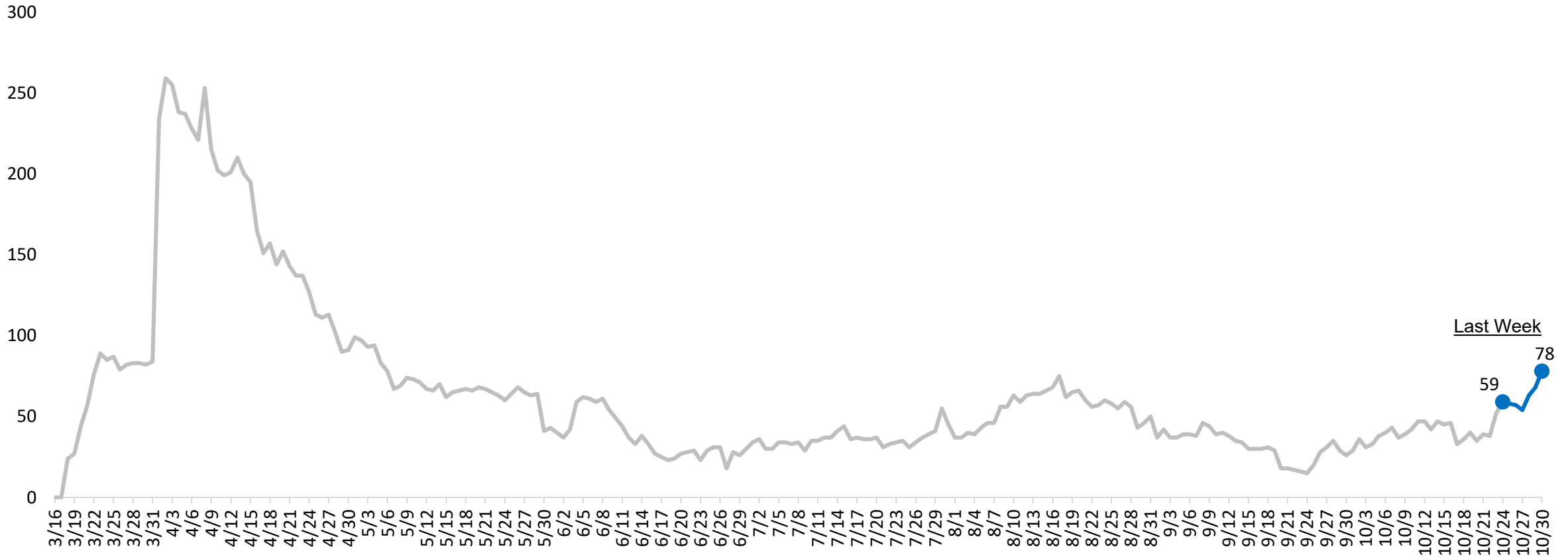

Number of People In Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing, March 16 - October 30, 2020

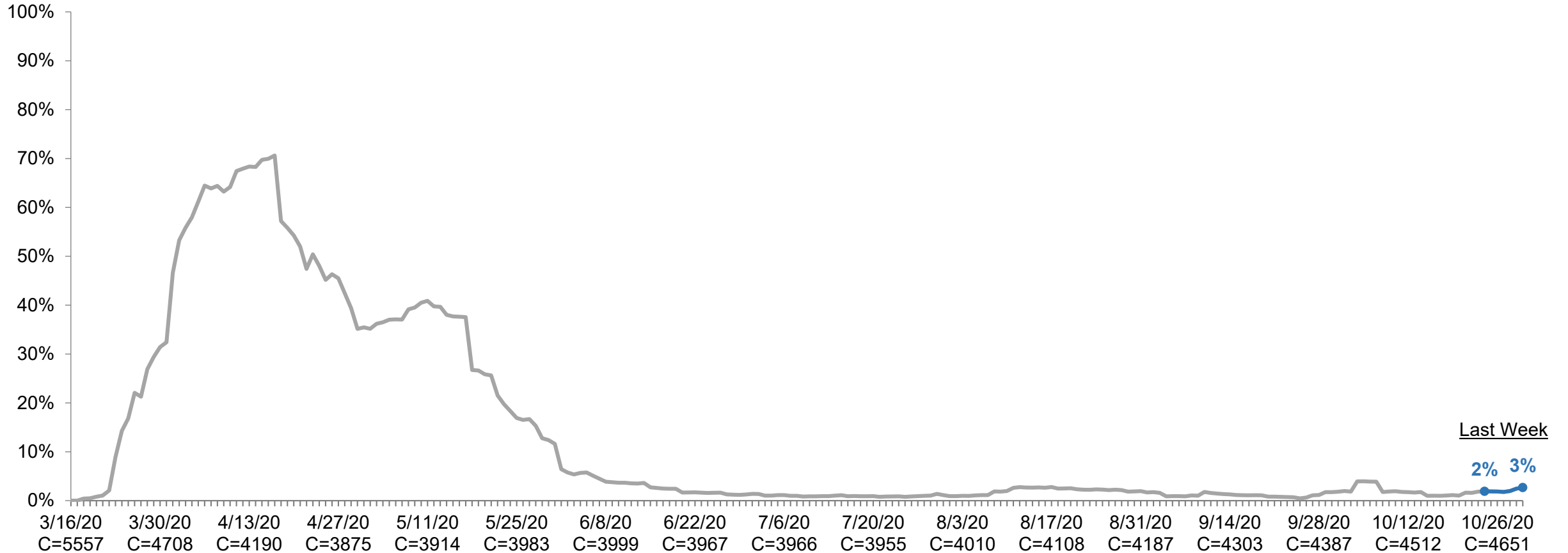

March 16 – October 30, 2020



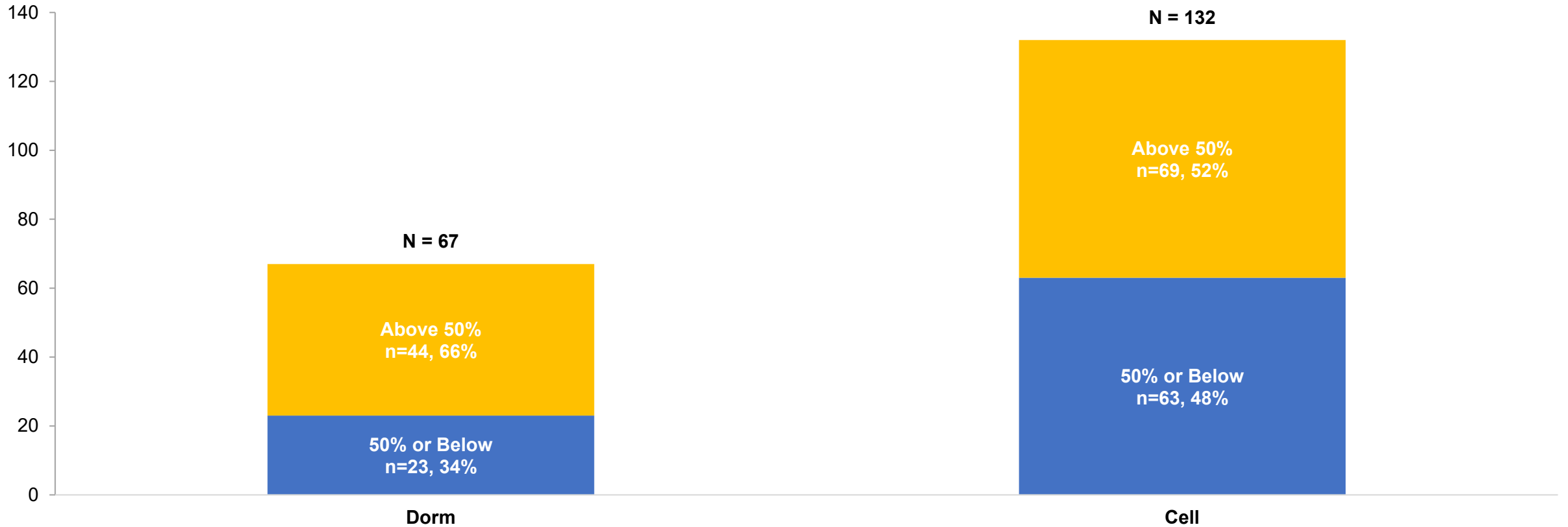

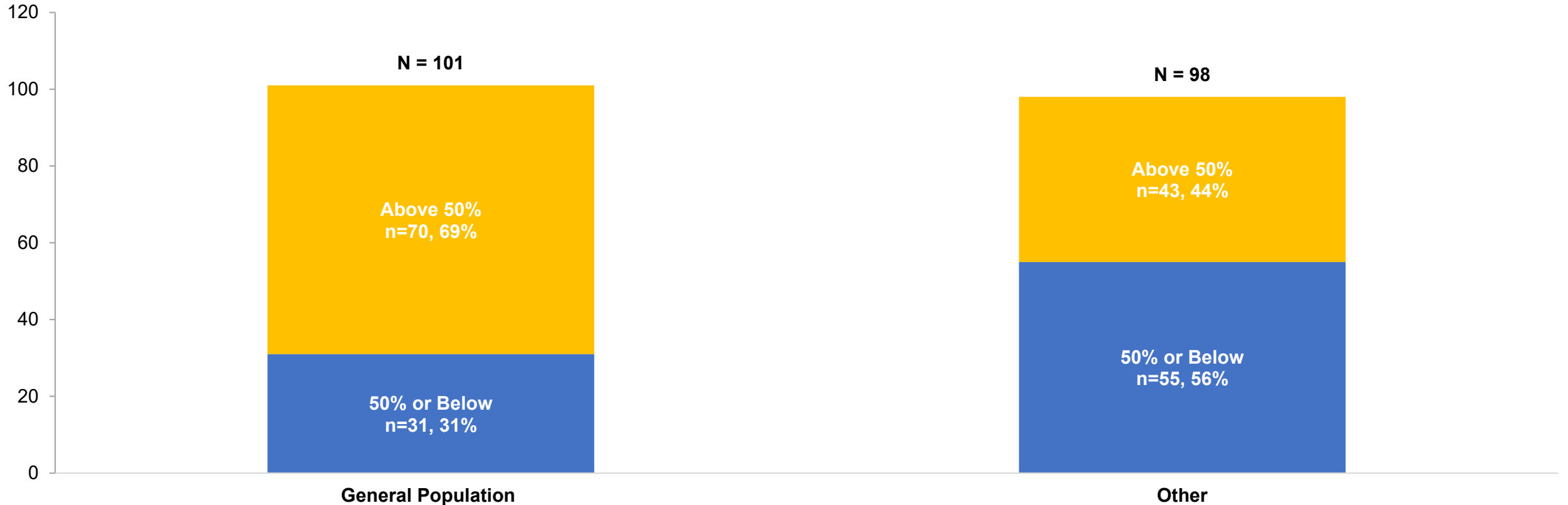

October 29, 2020



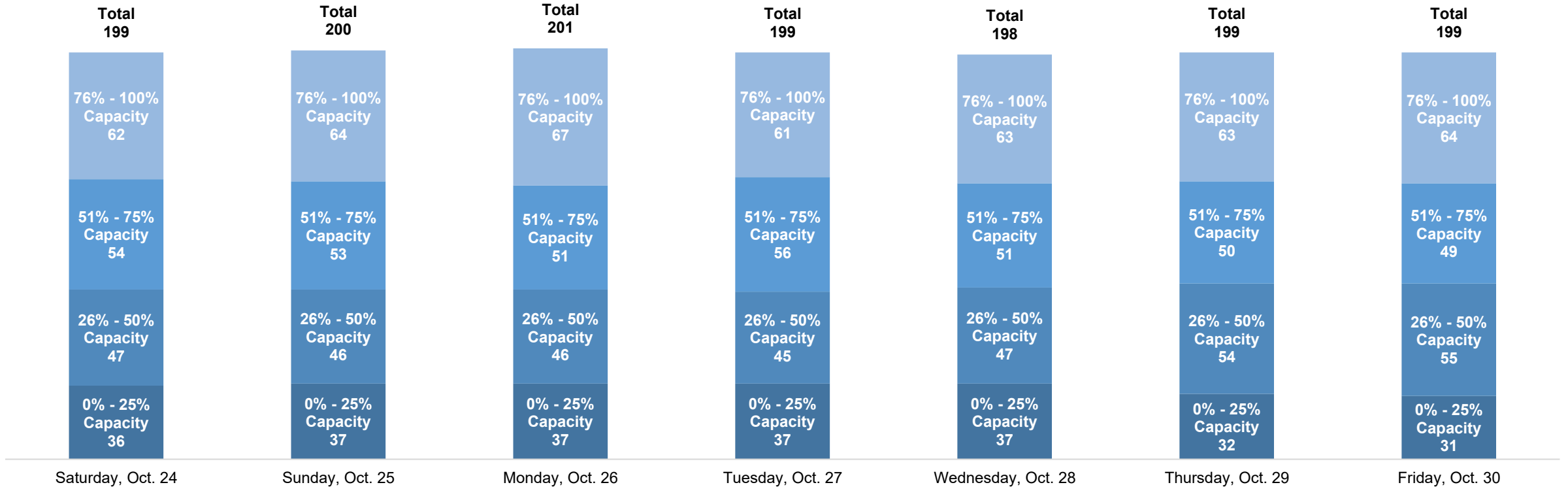
