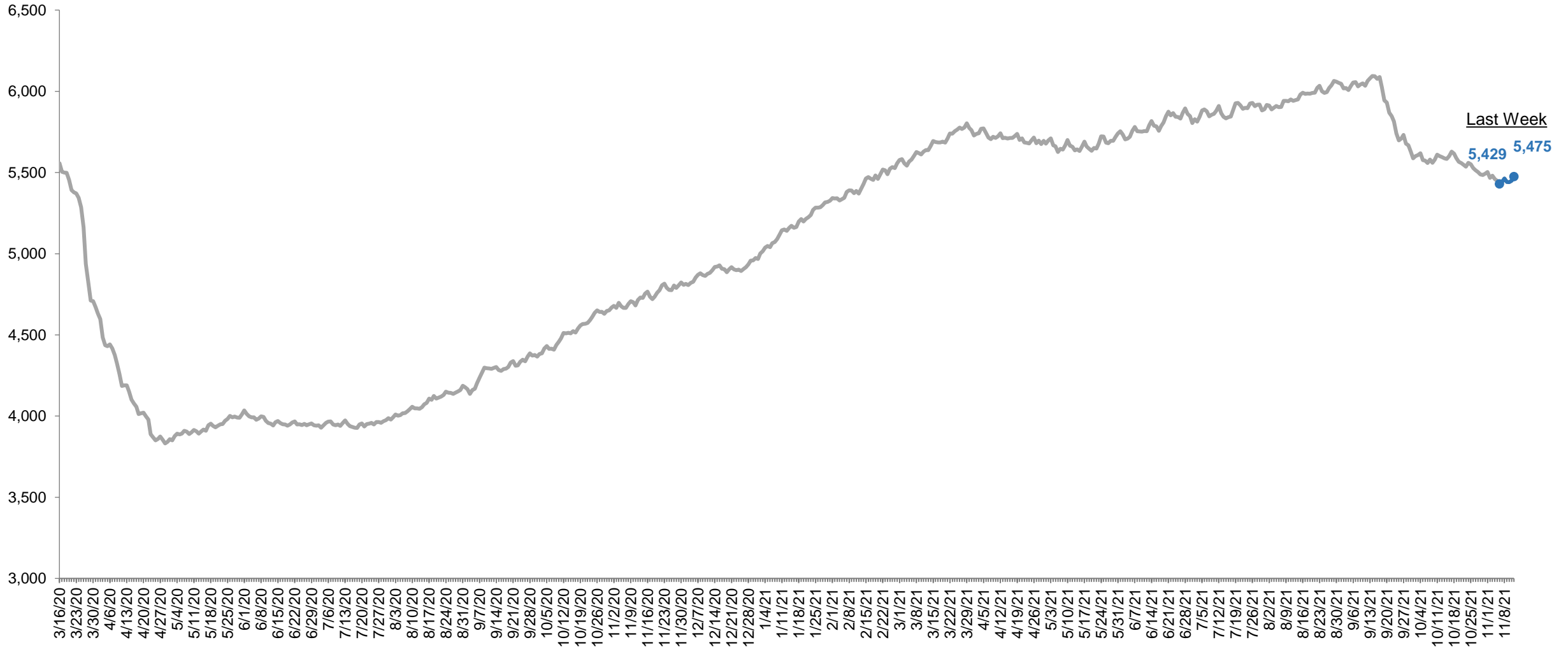

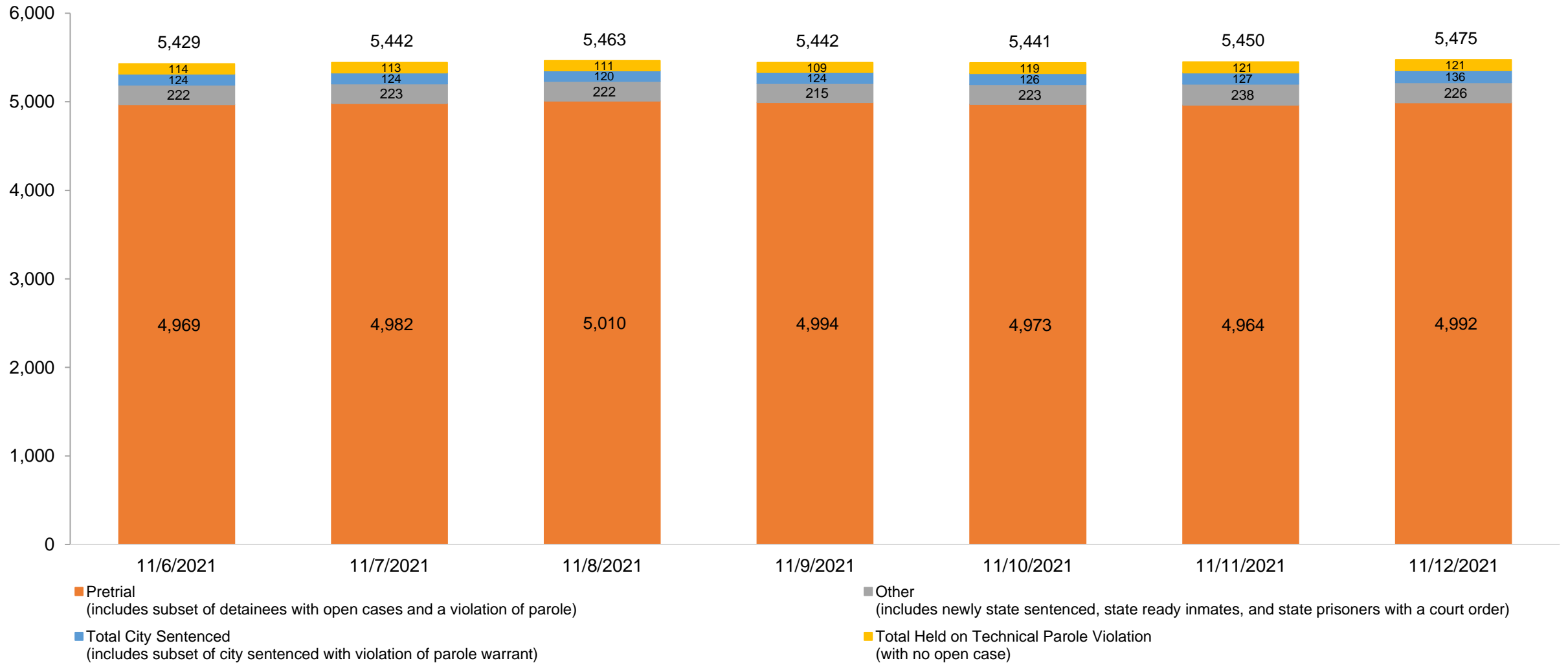
Total Population in DOC Custody

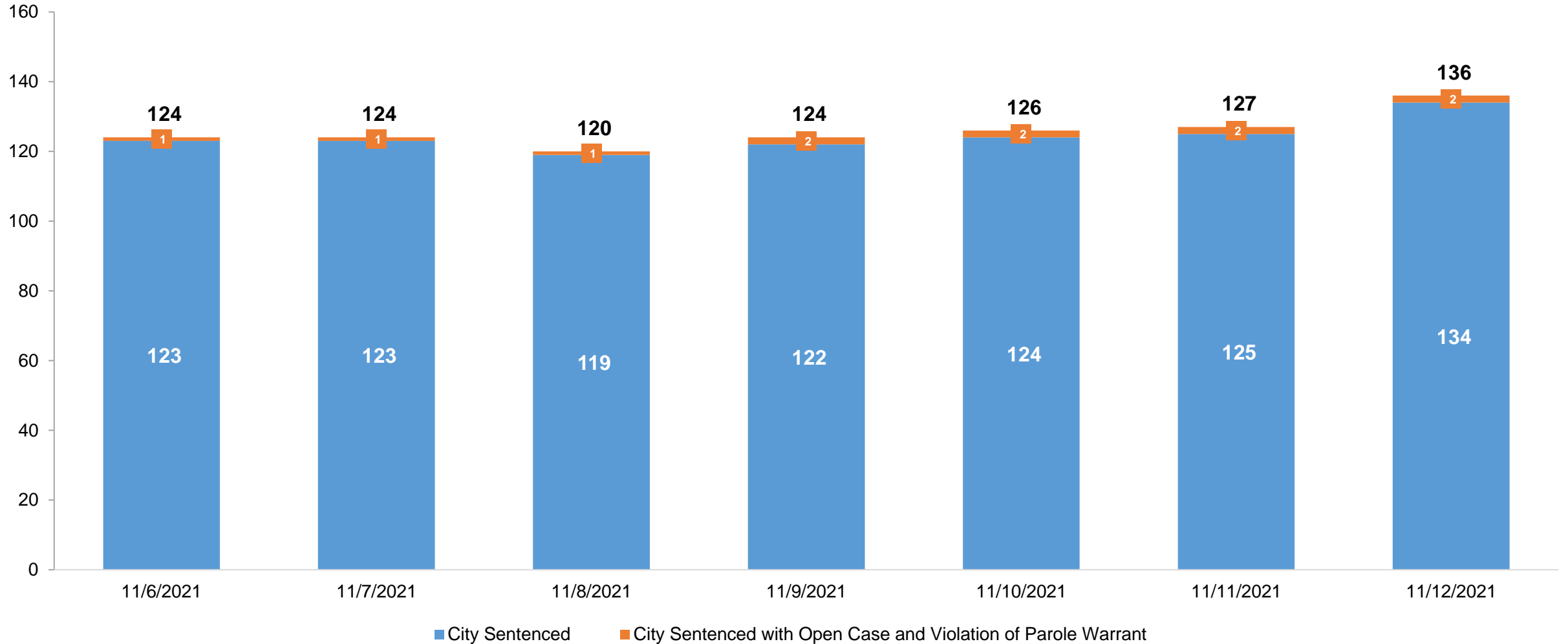

I. Population Change: City Sentenced Population by Custody Status

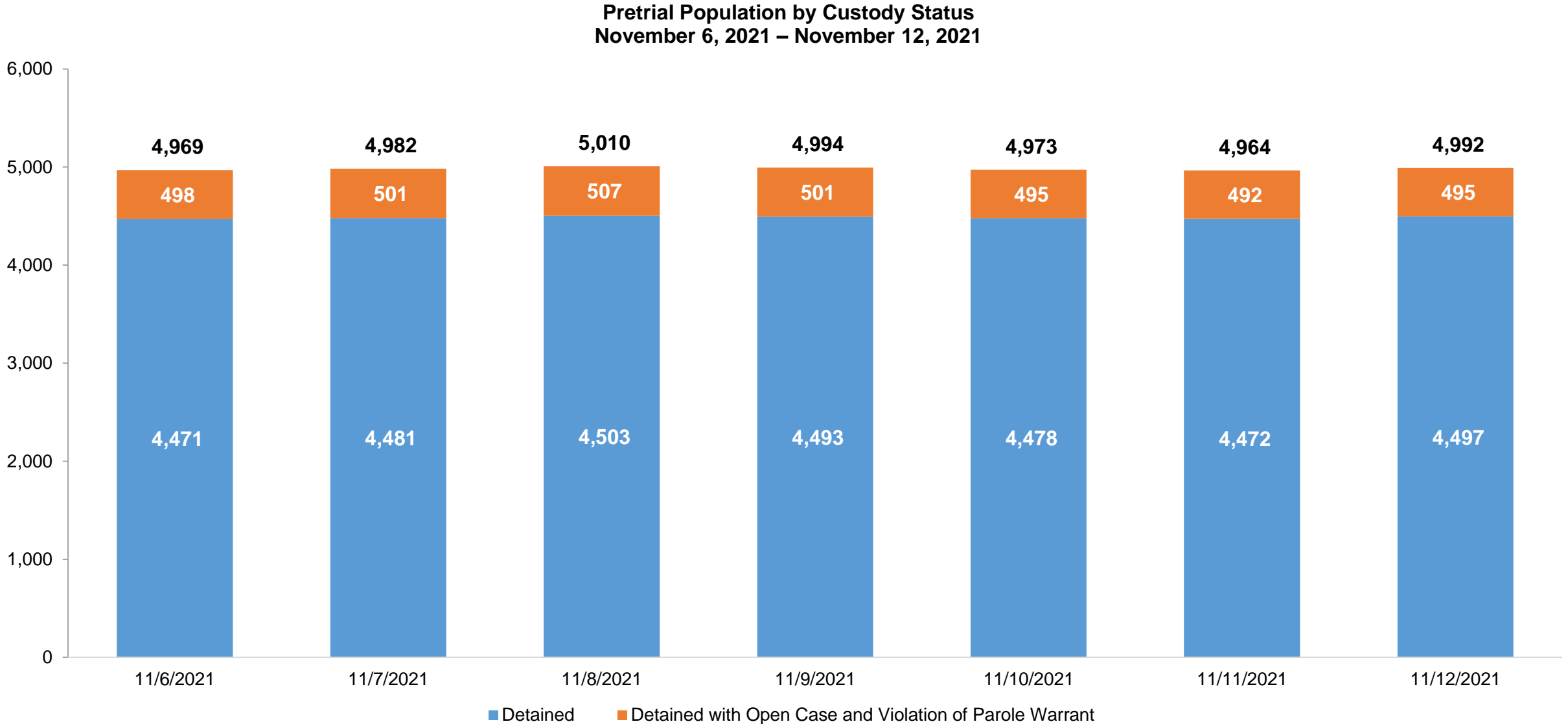
City Sentenced Population by Custody Status

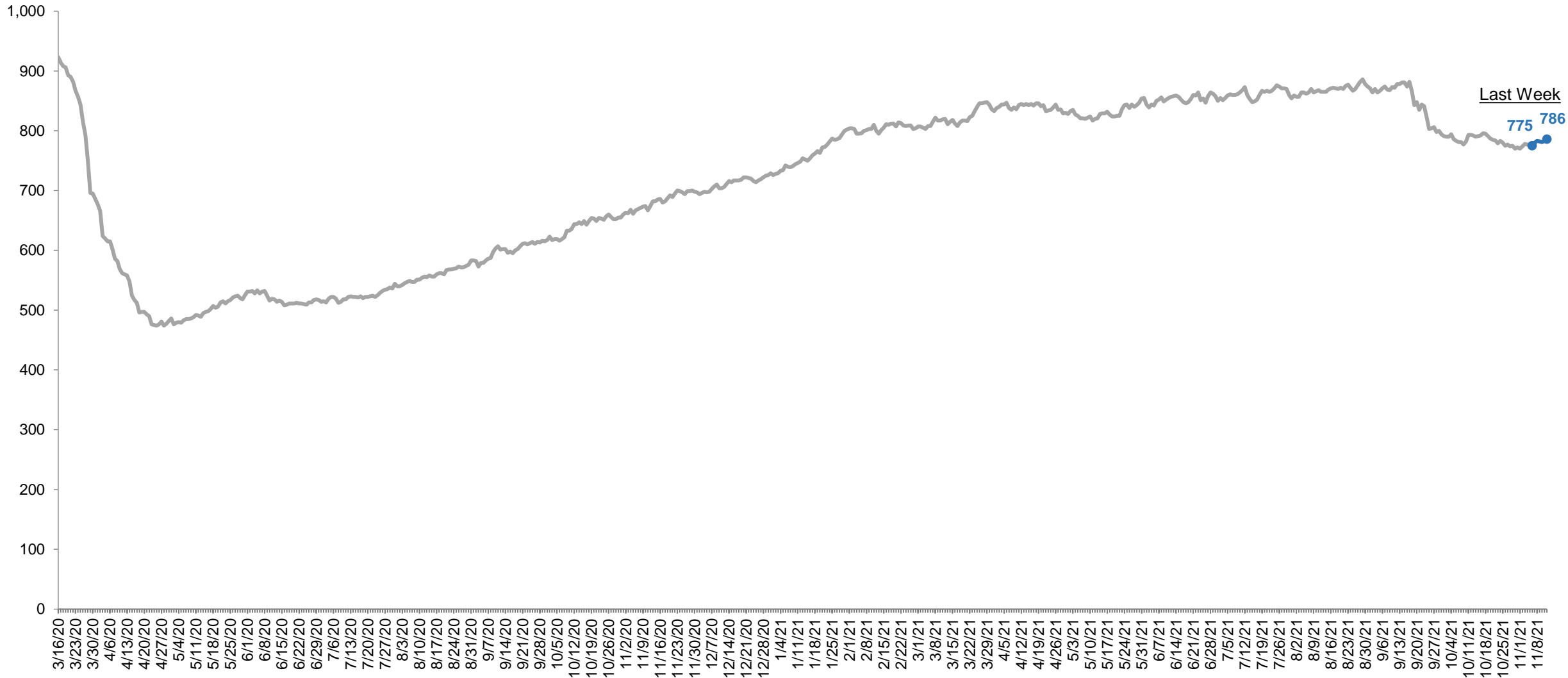

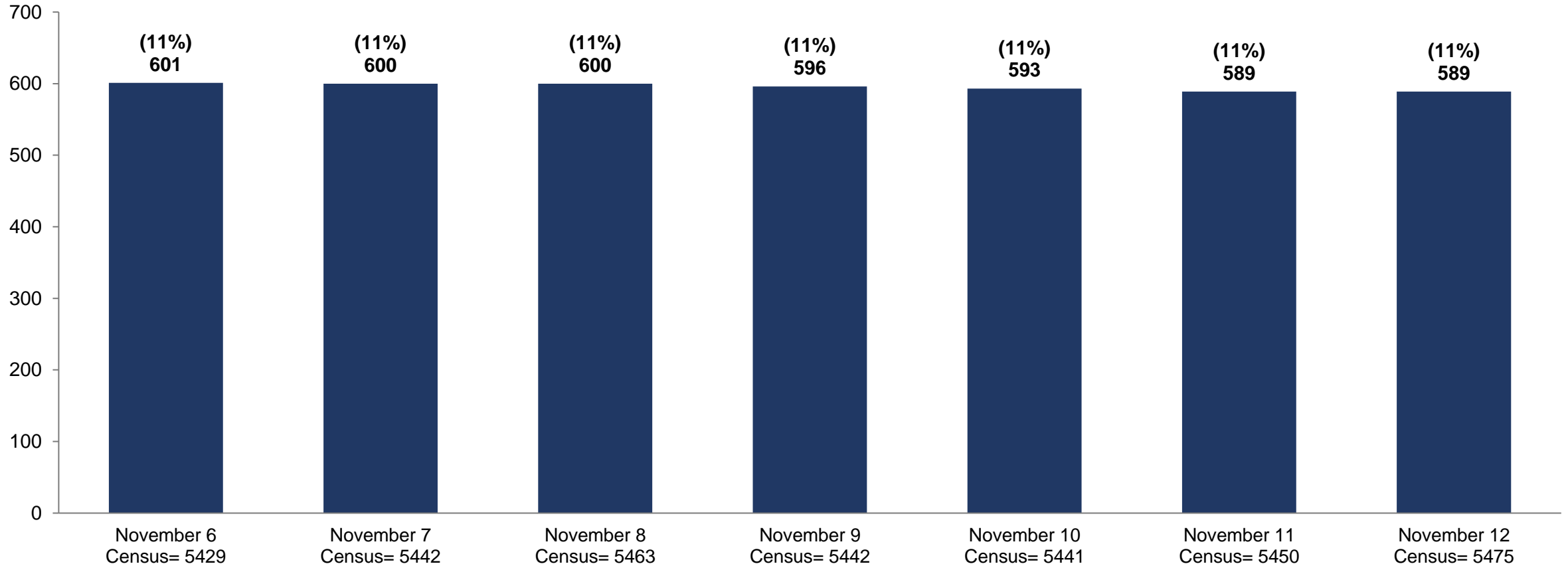

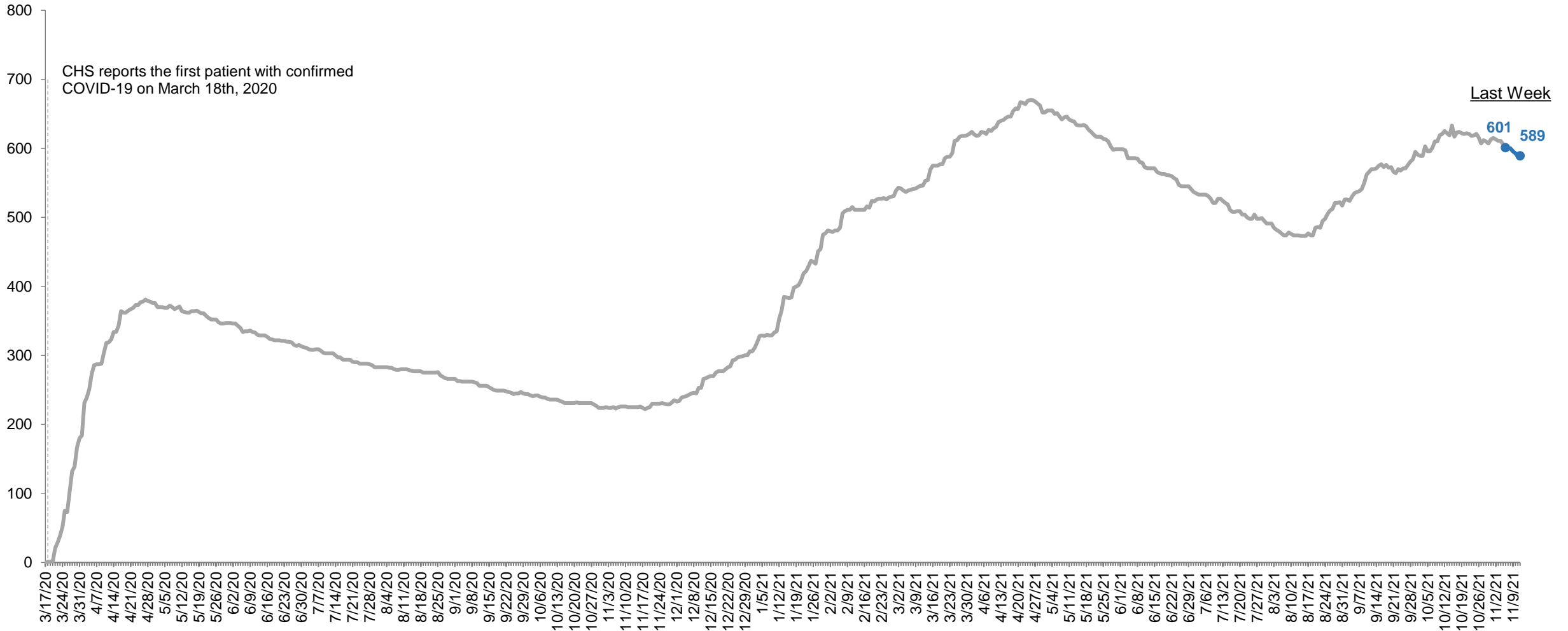
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

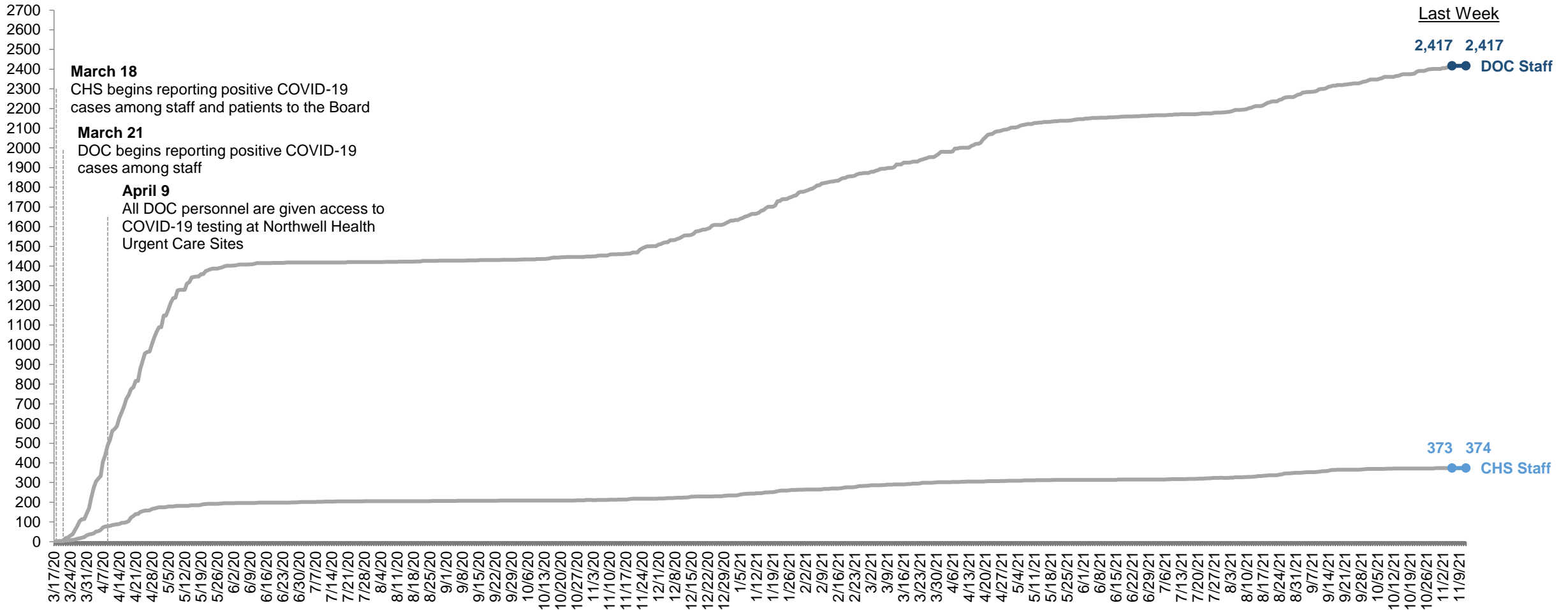
**Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody

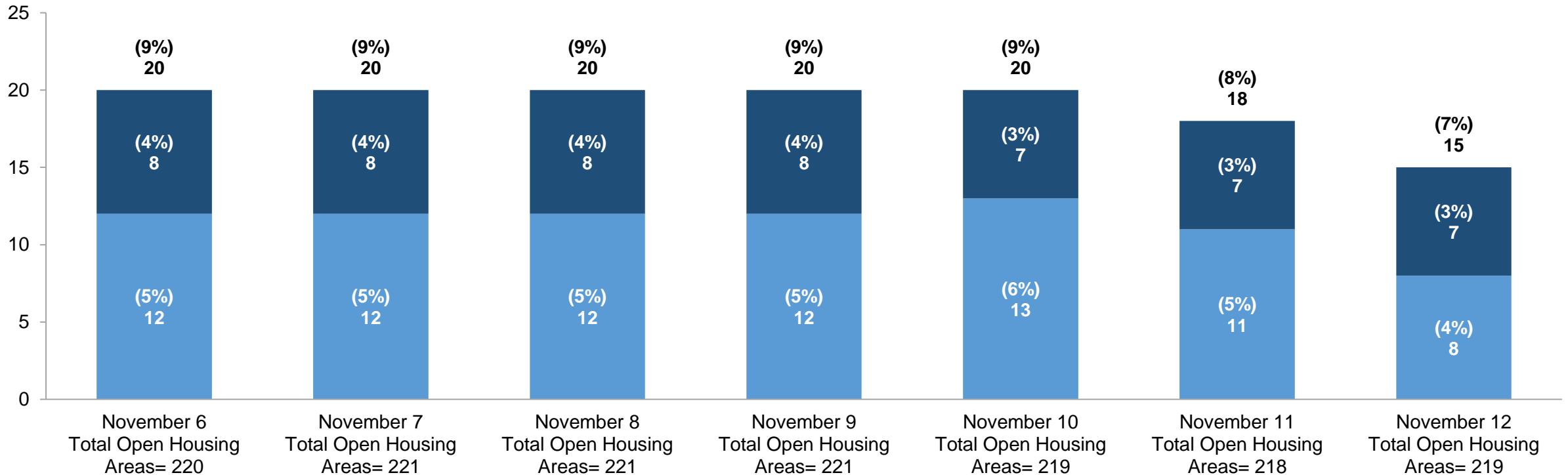

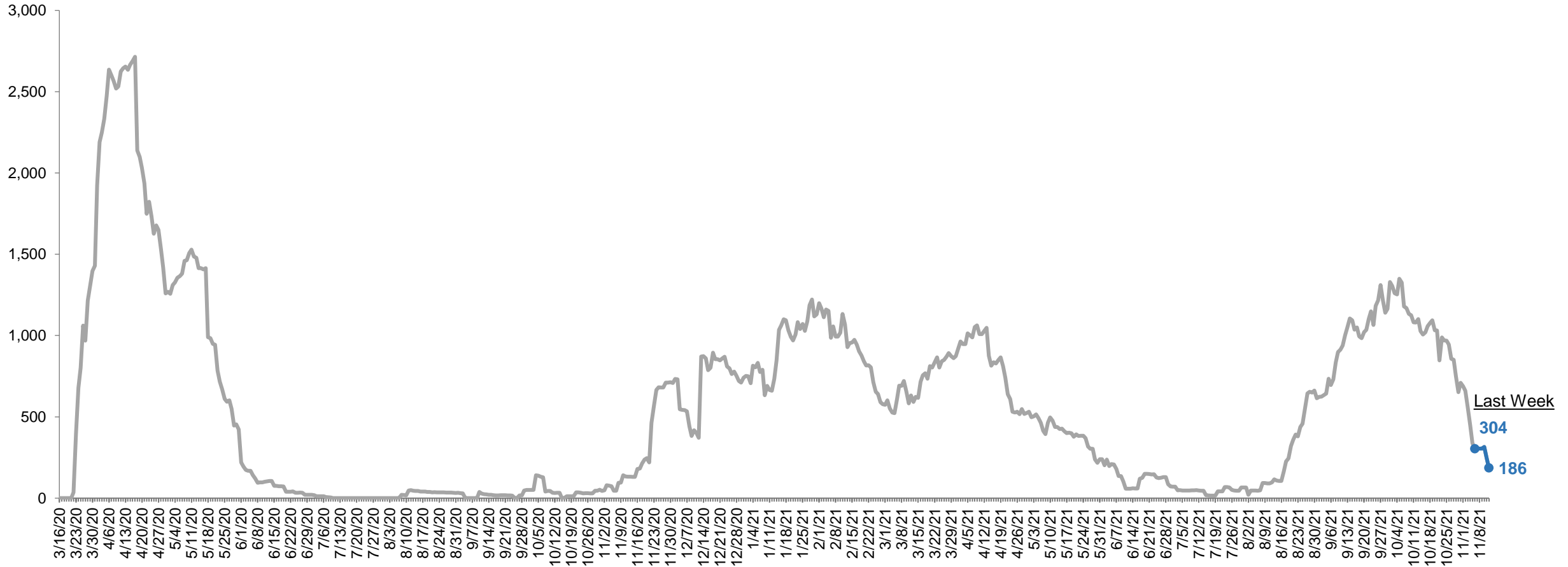

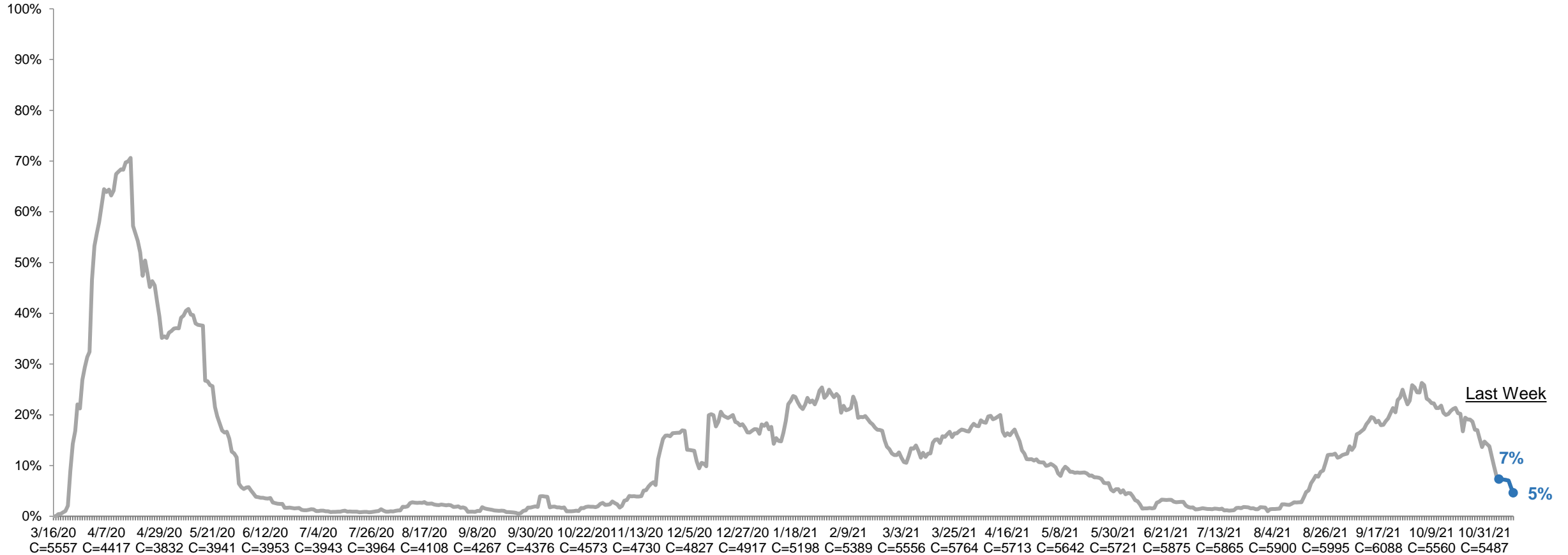

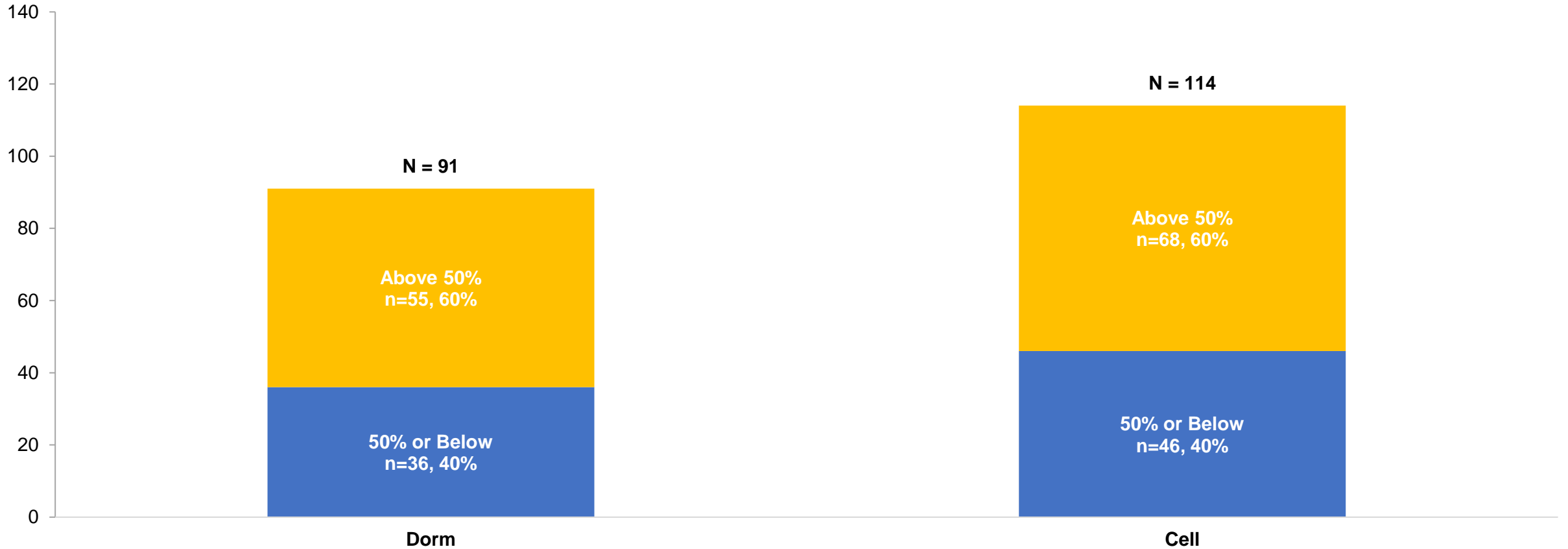

November 11, 2021



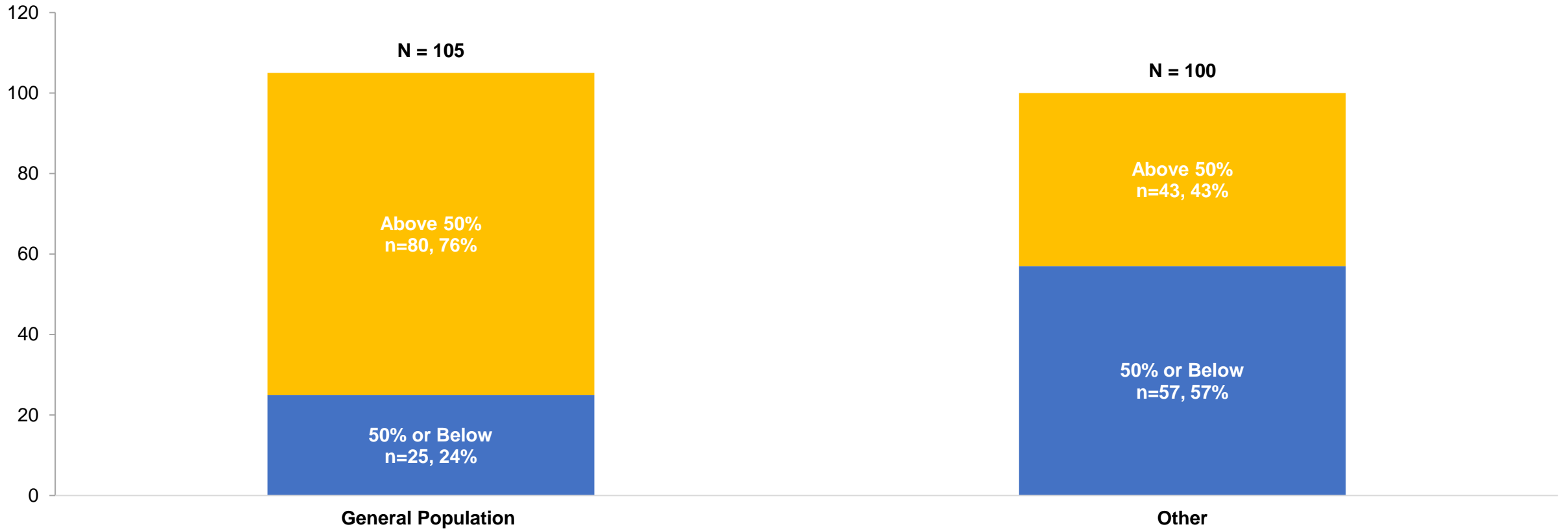

November 11, 2021



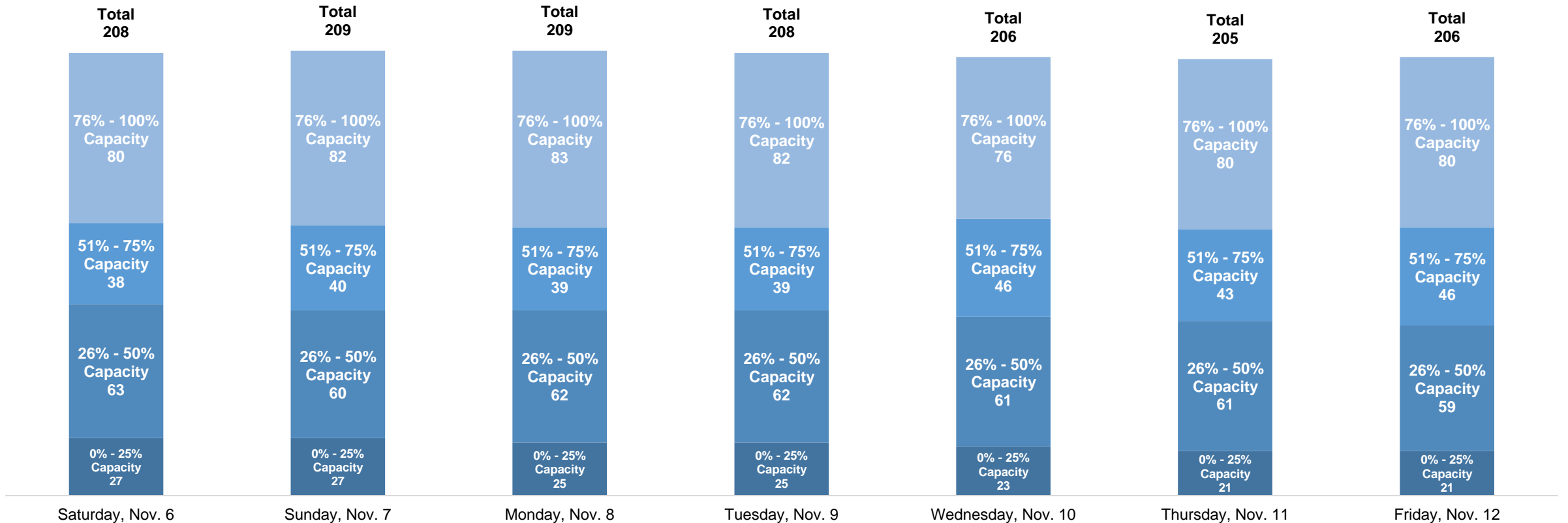
