






City Sentenced Population by Custody Status November 27, 2021 – December 3, 2021





Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 November 27 – December 3, 2021




Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody March 17, 2020 – December 3, 2021






Number of People in Likely Exposed but Asymptomatic Housing


Number of People in Confirmed/Symptomatic Housing March 16, 2020 – December 3, 2021




Number and Percent of Open Units Above and Below 50% Capacity by Housing Category December 2, 2021
