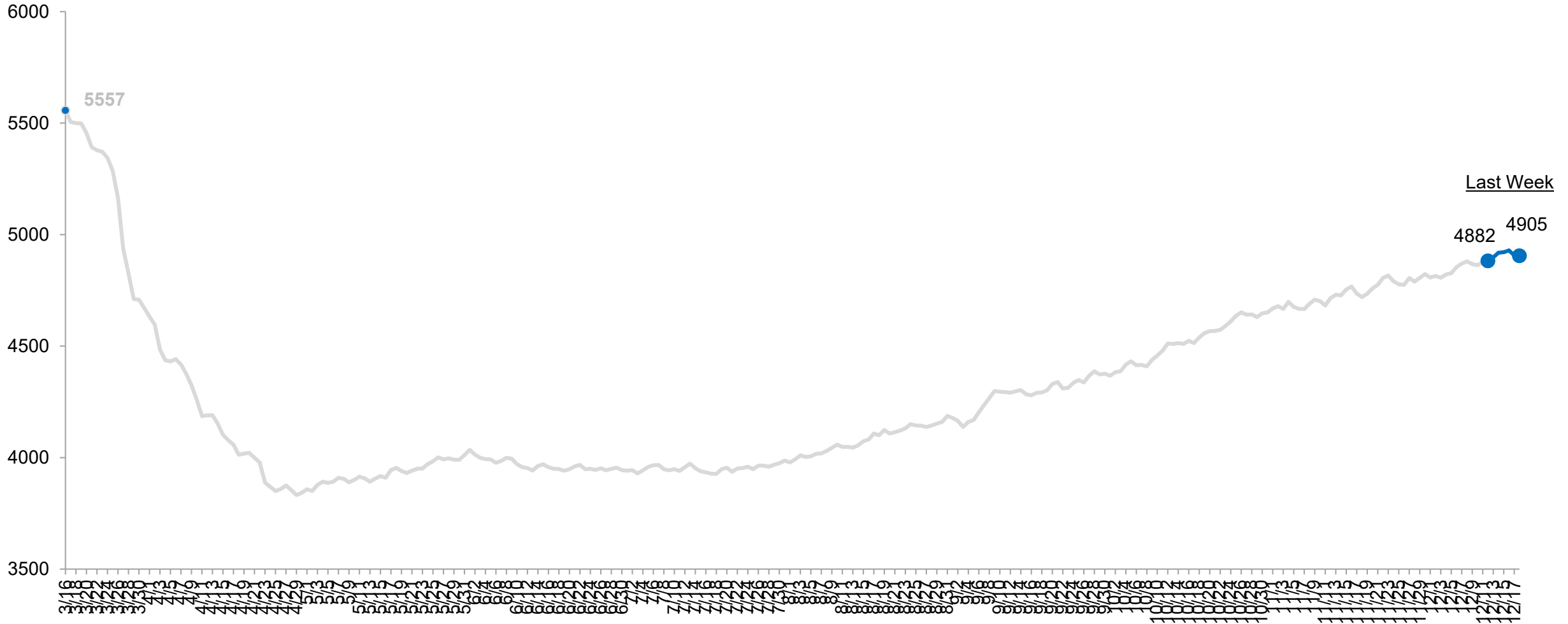

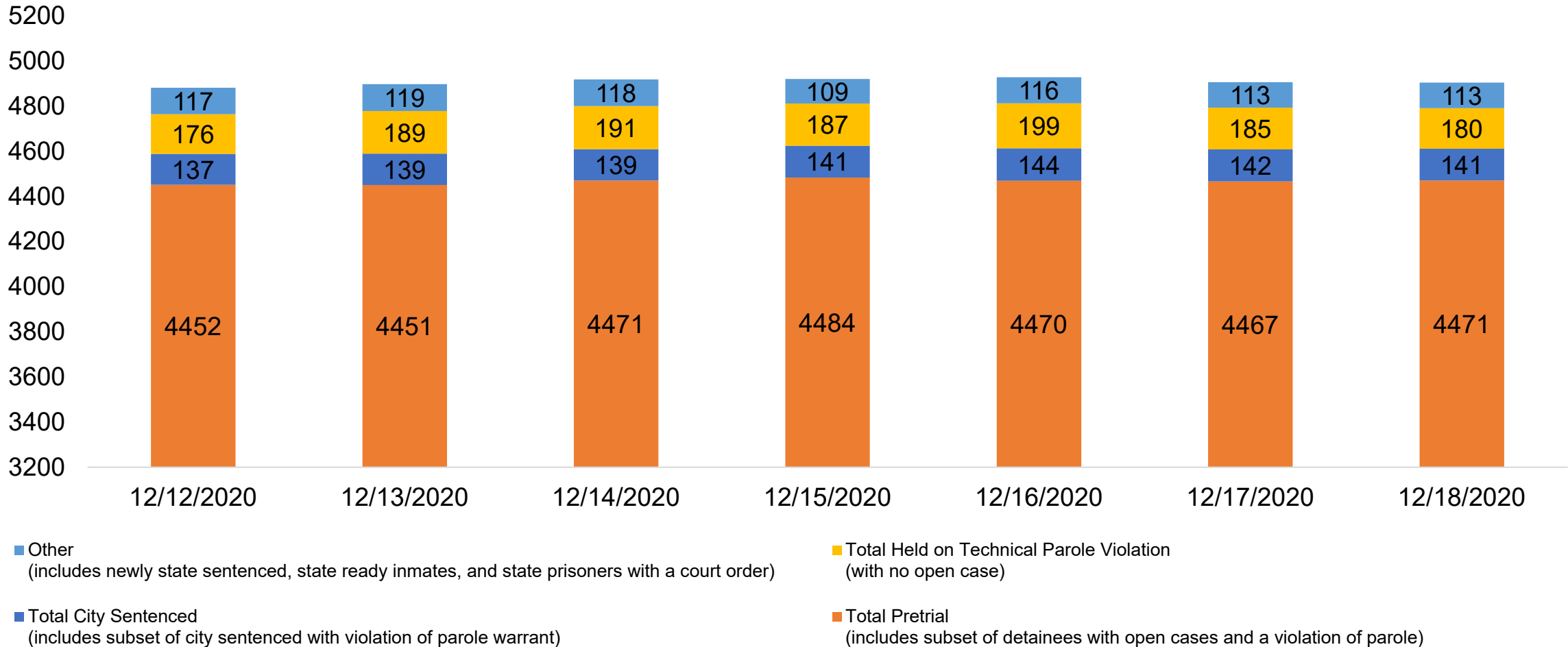
## Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – December 18, 2020

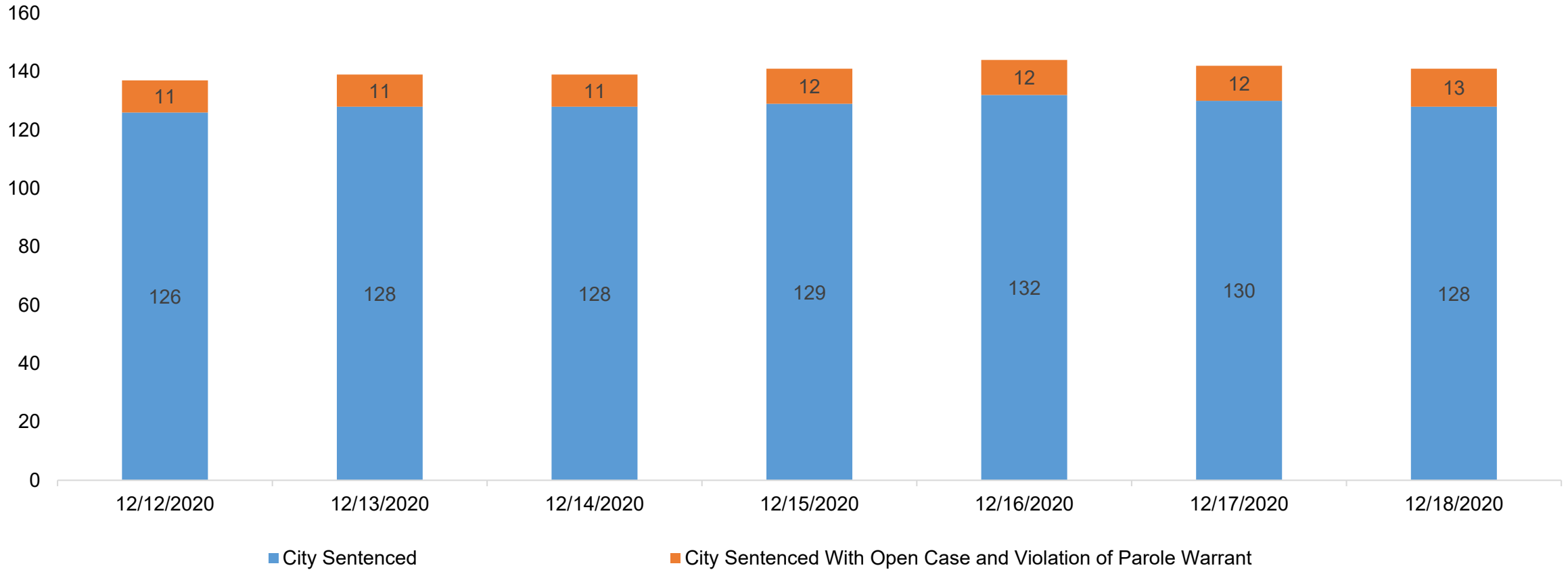

## Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 12/12/2020-12/18/2020



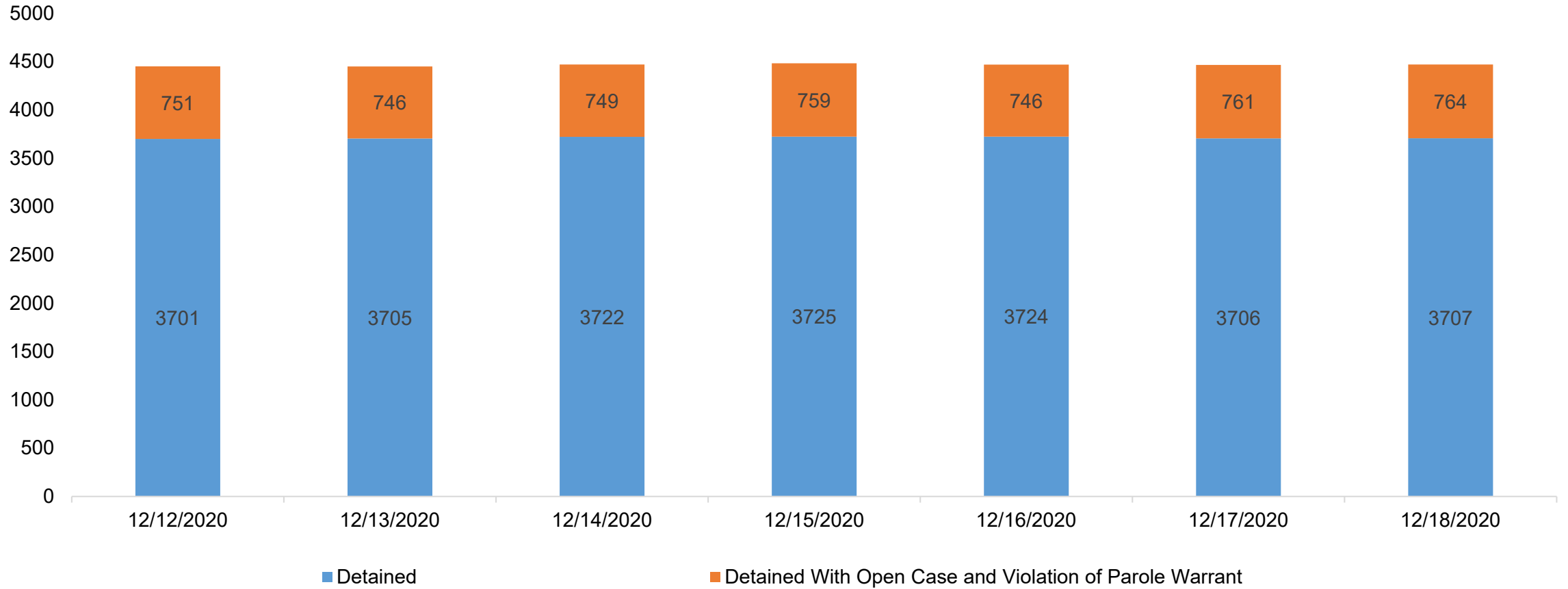

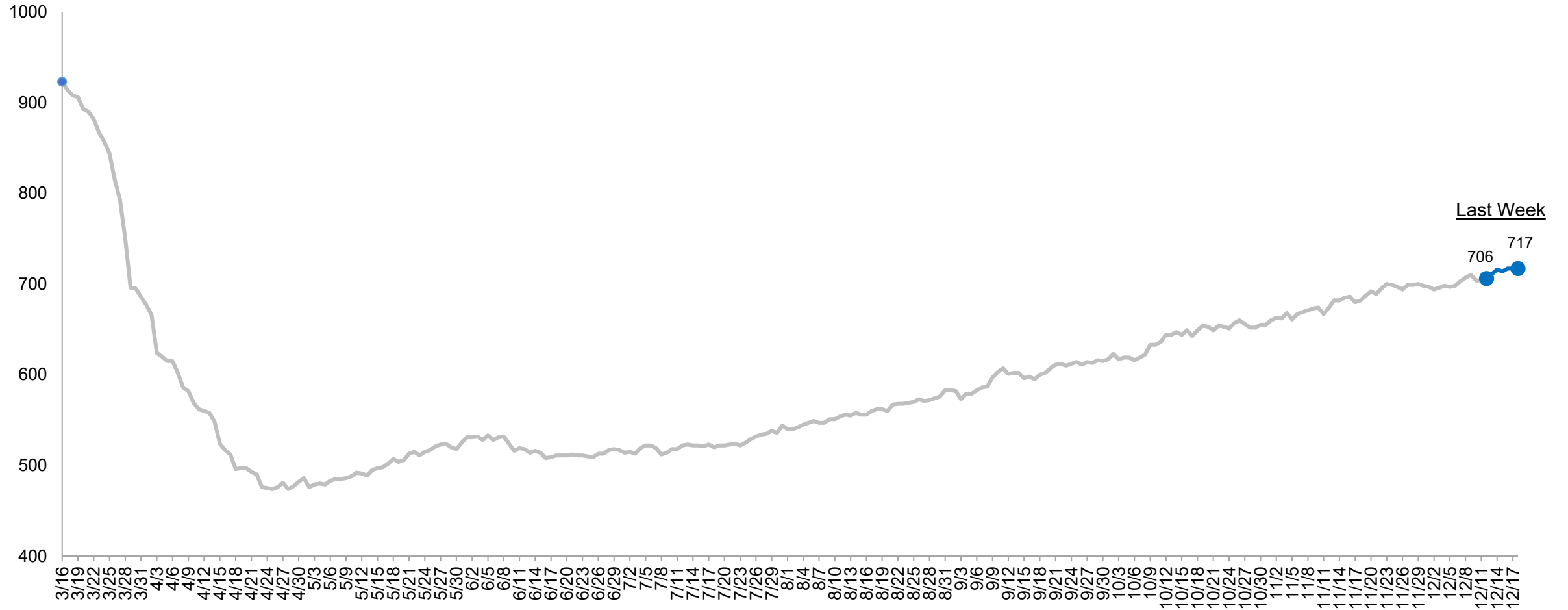

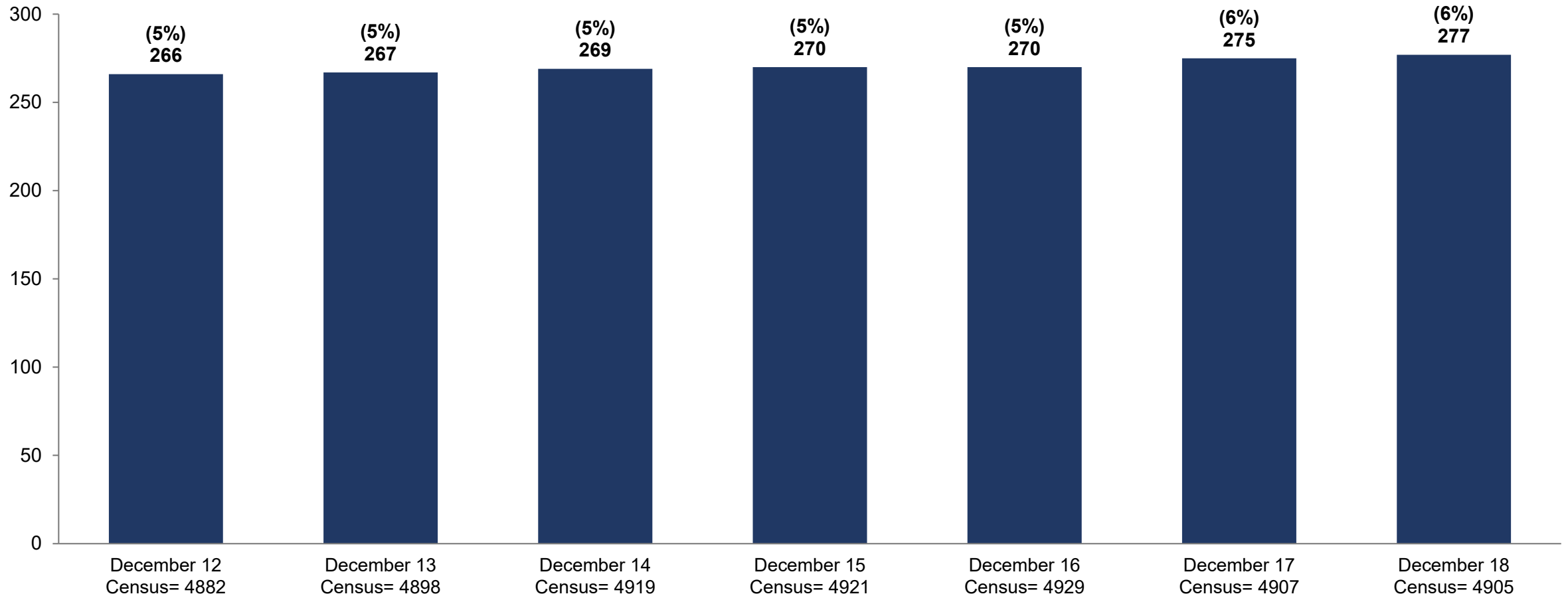

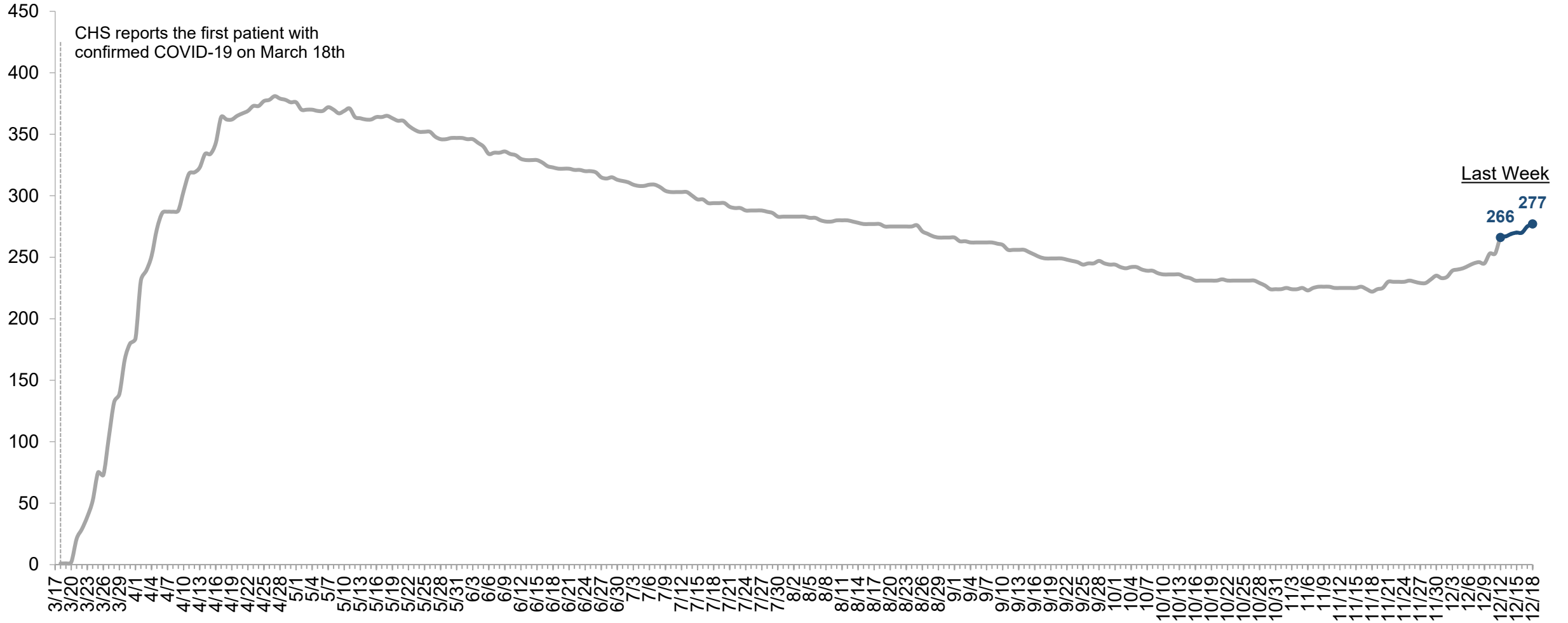
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

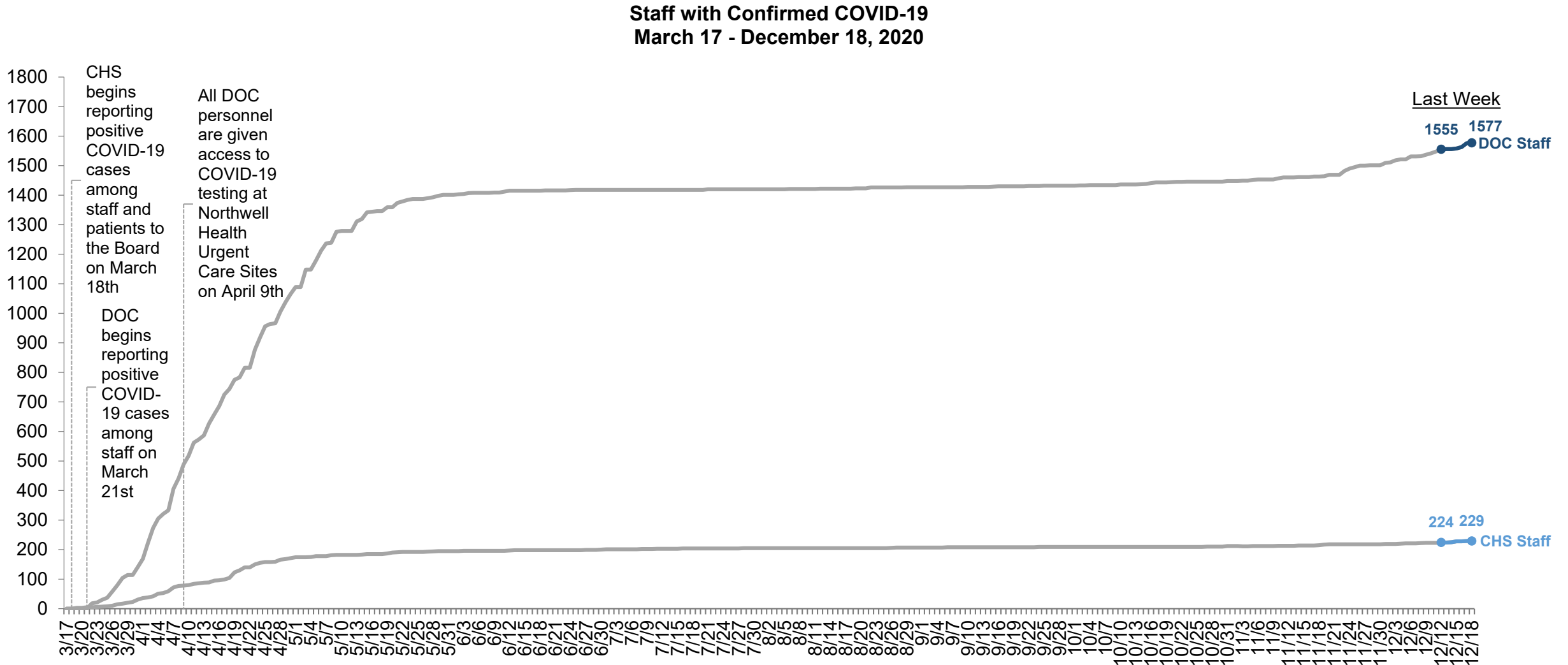

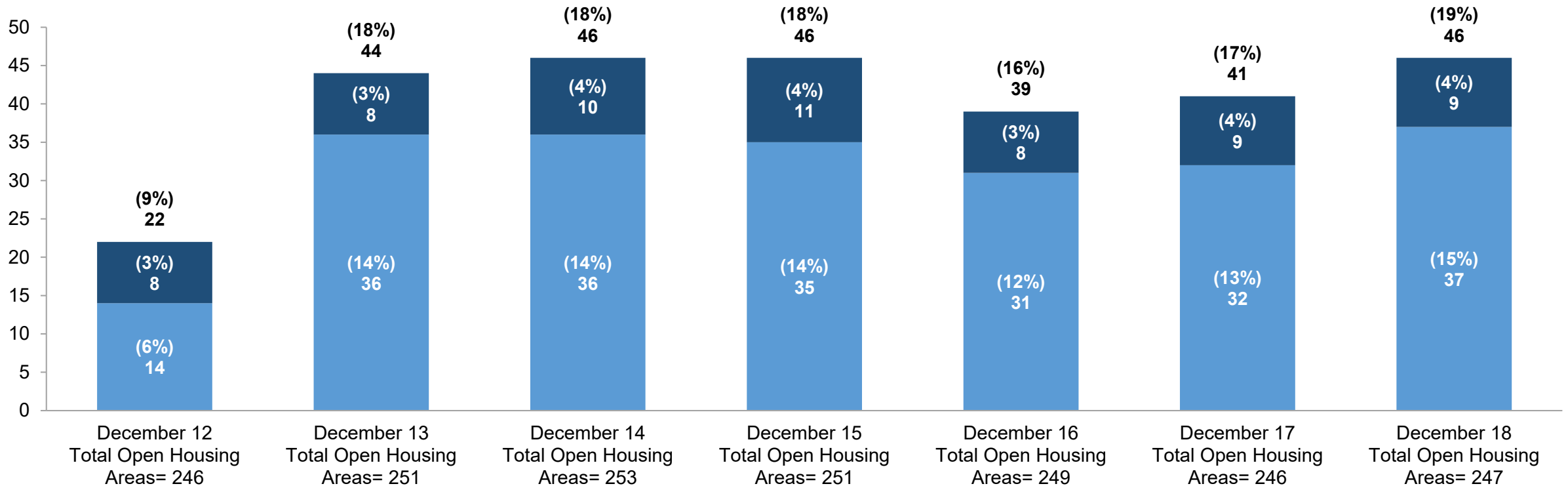

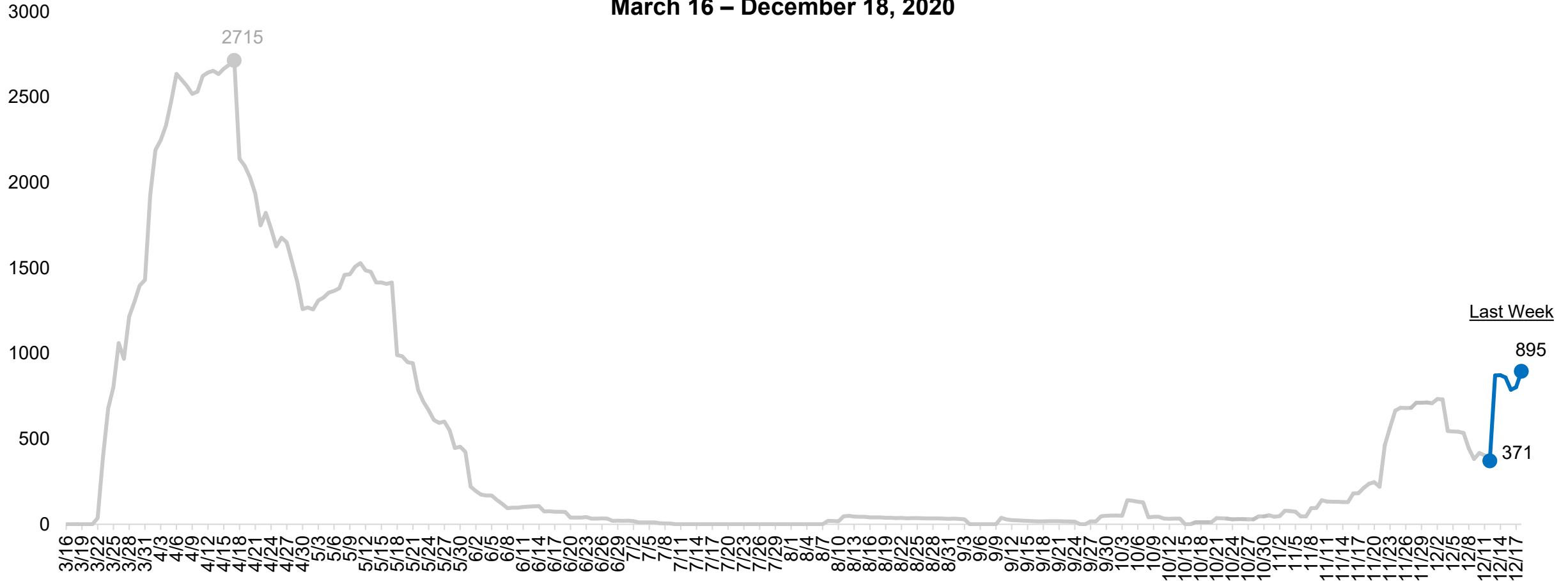

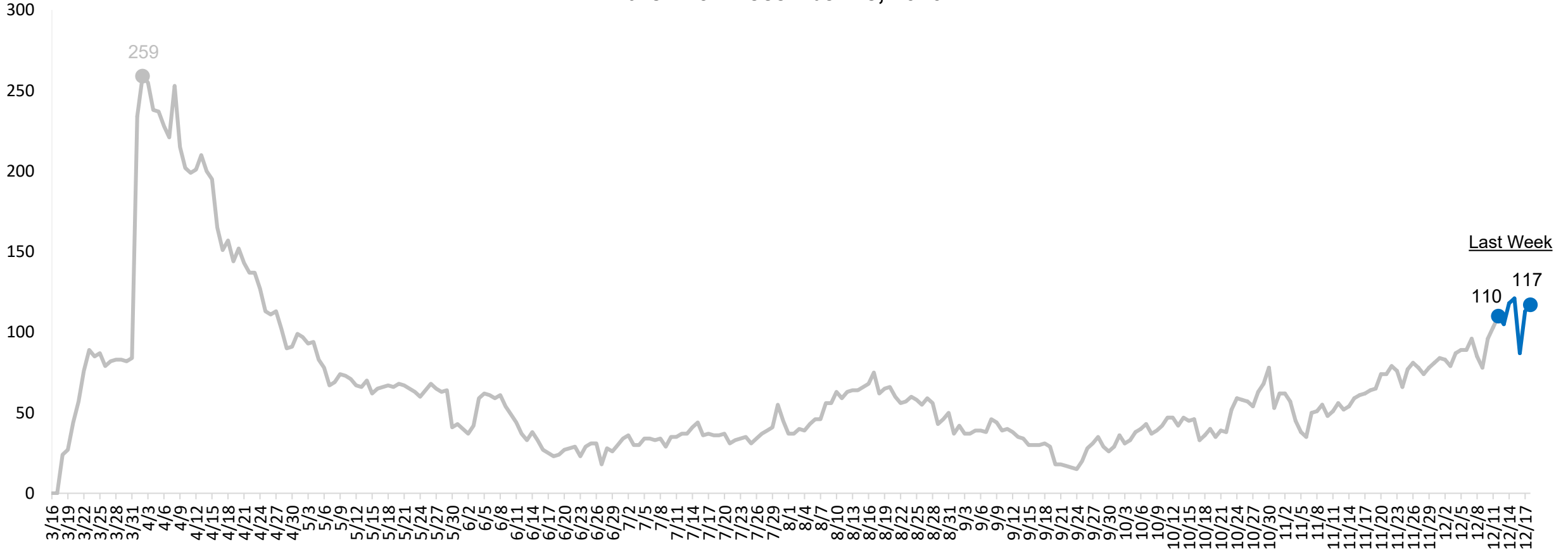

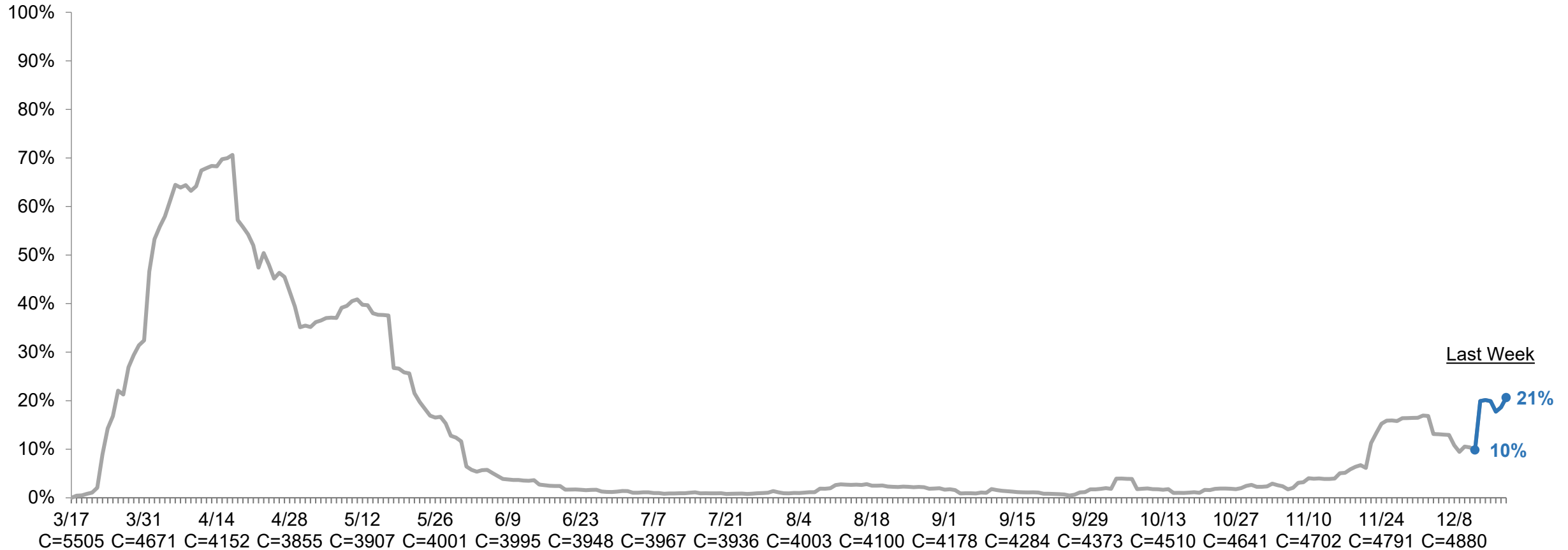

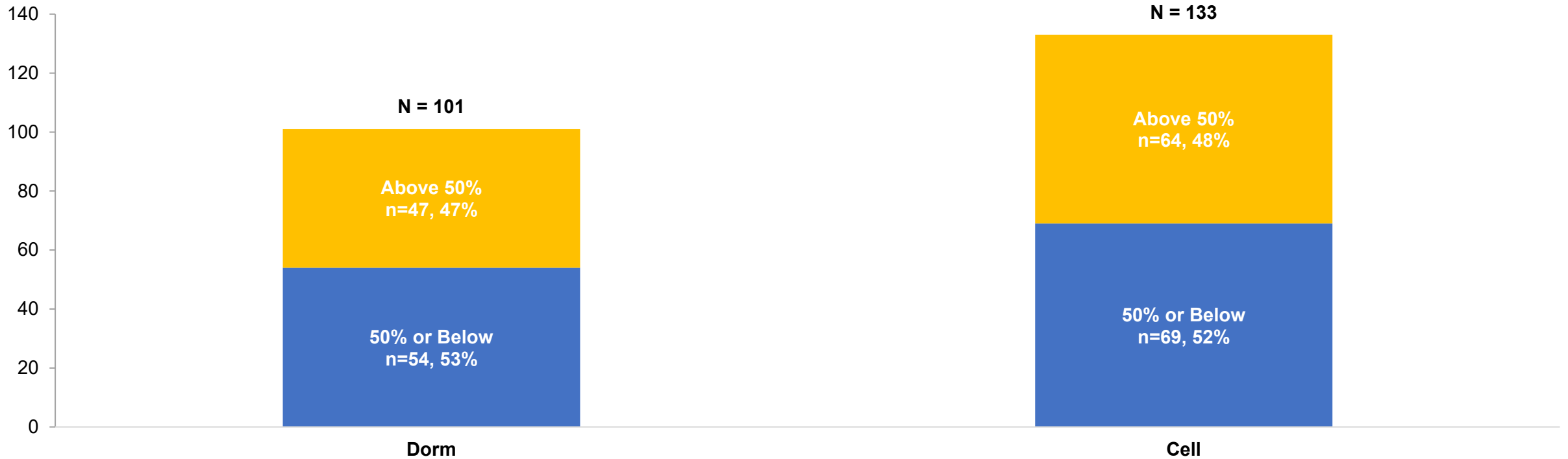

December 17, 2020

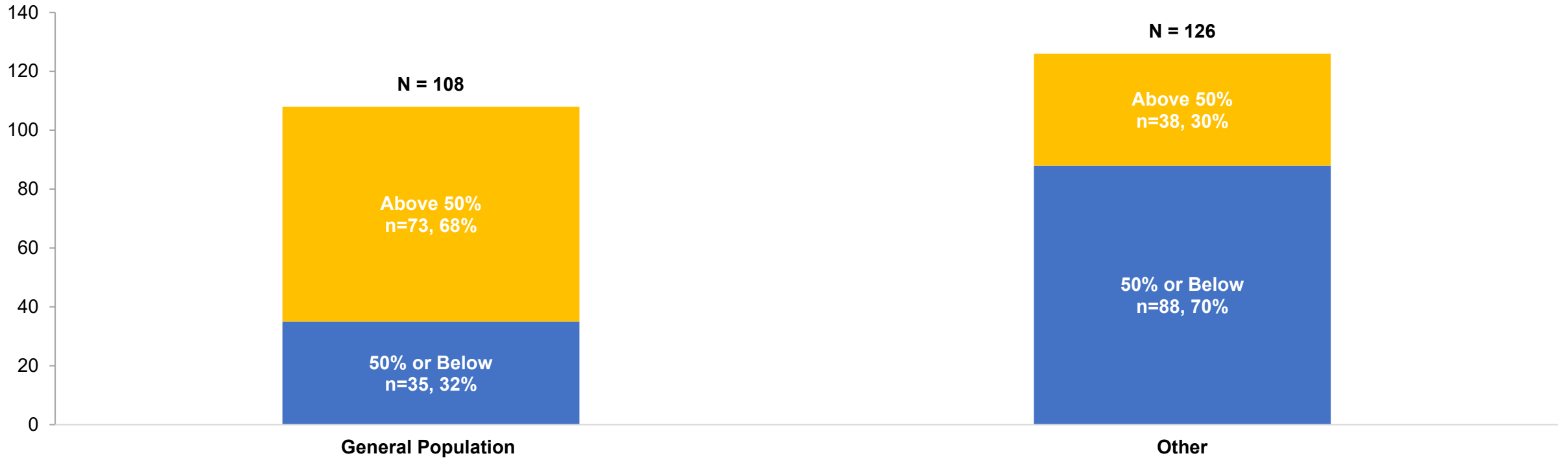

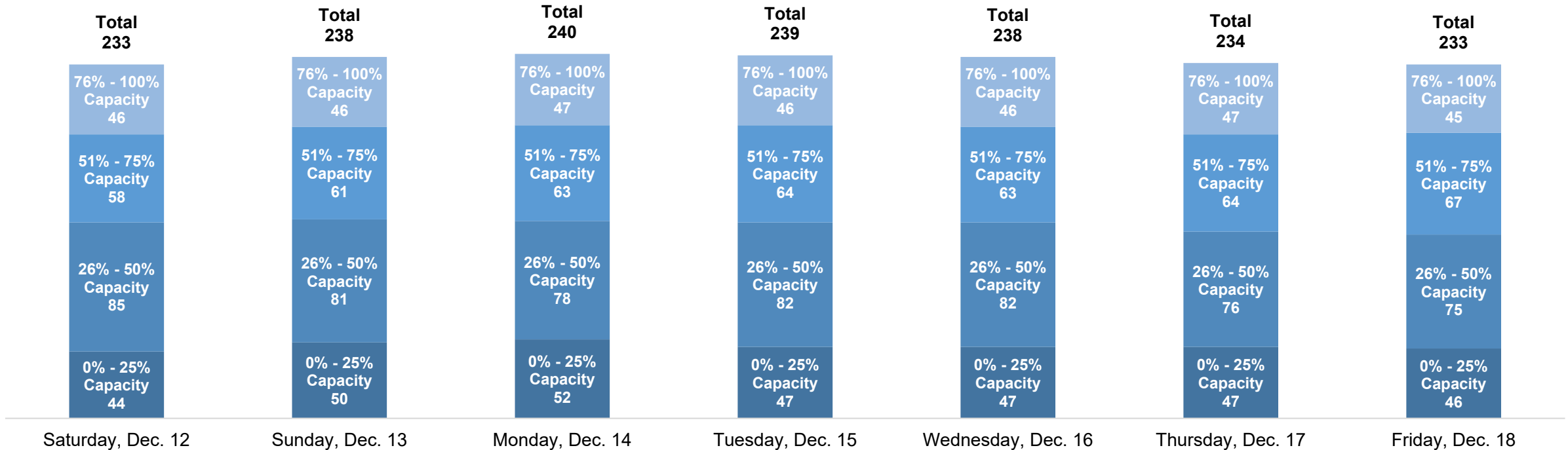

Accordingly, the capacity figures presented above are calculated by dividing housing area census by housing area designed capacity. This represents a change from prior BOC analyses which calculated capacity using the census and “beds at standard” values reported in DOC’s 5am census. DOC reports the “beds at standard” metric reflects each unit’s operational capacity after accounting for legal (e.g., Nunez Consent Decree housing limits, etc.), programmatic (e.g., PACE, CAPS, MO, etc.), and maintenance (e.g., inoperable or down cells, etc.) factors, which may be unrelated to the size of each unit and may change over time.
- 2) This analysis excludes Contagious Disease Units (CDUs) (where people in custody share no communal space), intake areas (where the census changes throughout the day), and the Bellevue Hospital Prison Ward (BHPW).
