





I. Population Change: DOC Population by Custody Status


Total DOC Population by Custody Status December 18, 2021 – December 24, 2021




City Sentenced Population by Custody Status December 18, 2021 – December 24, 2021





Number and Percent of Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody December 18 – December 24, 2021




Number of Incarcerated Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody March 17, 2020 – December 24, 2021
















