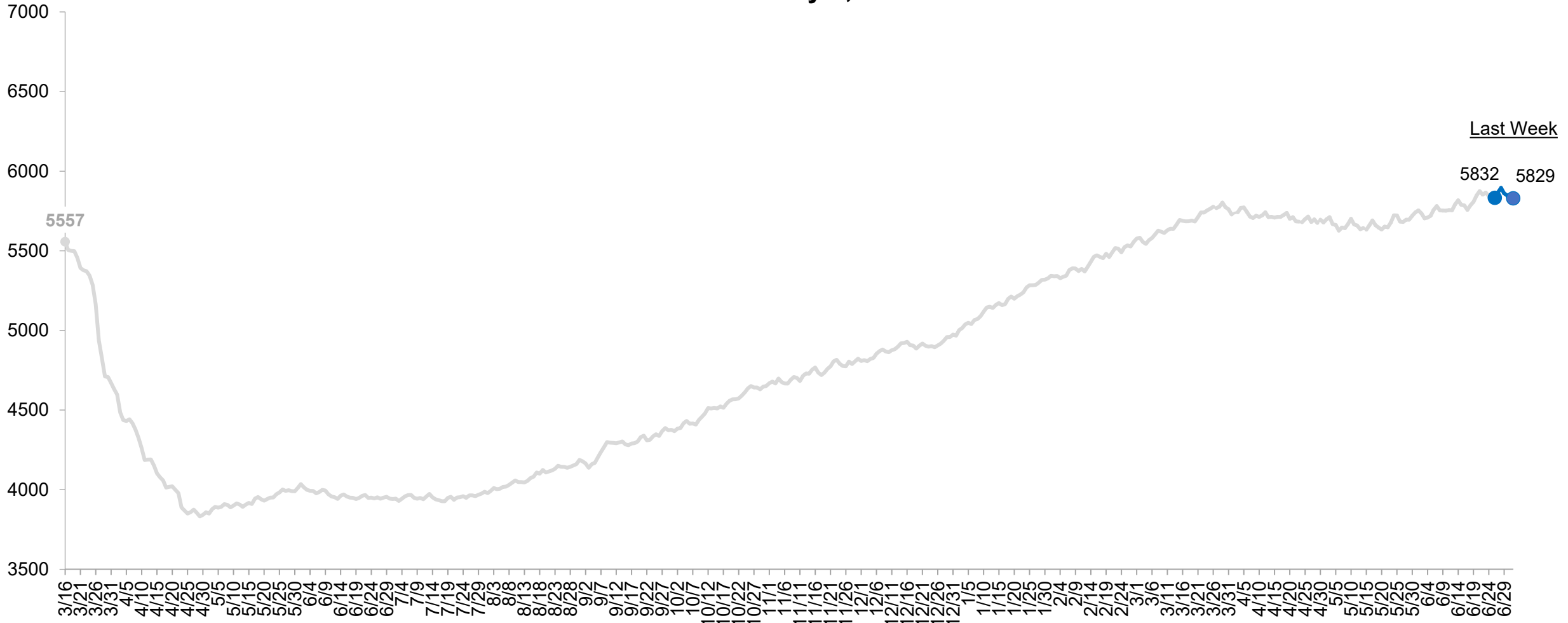

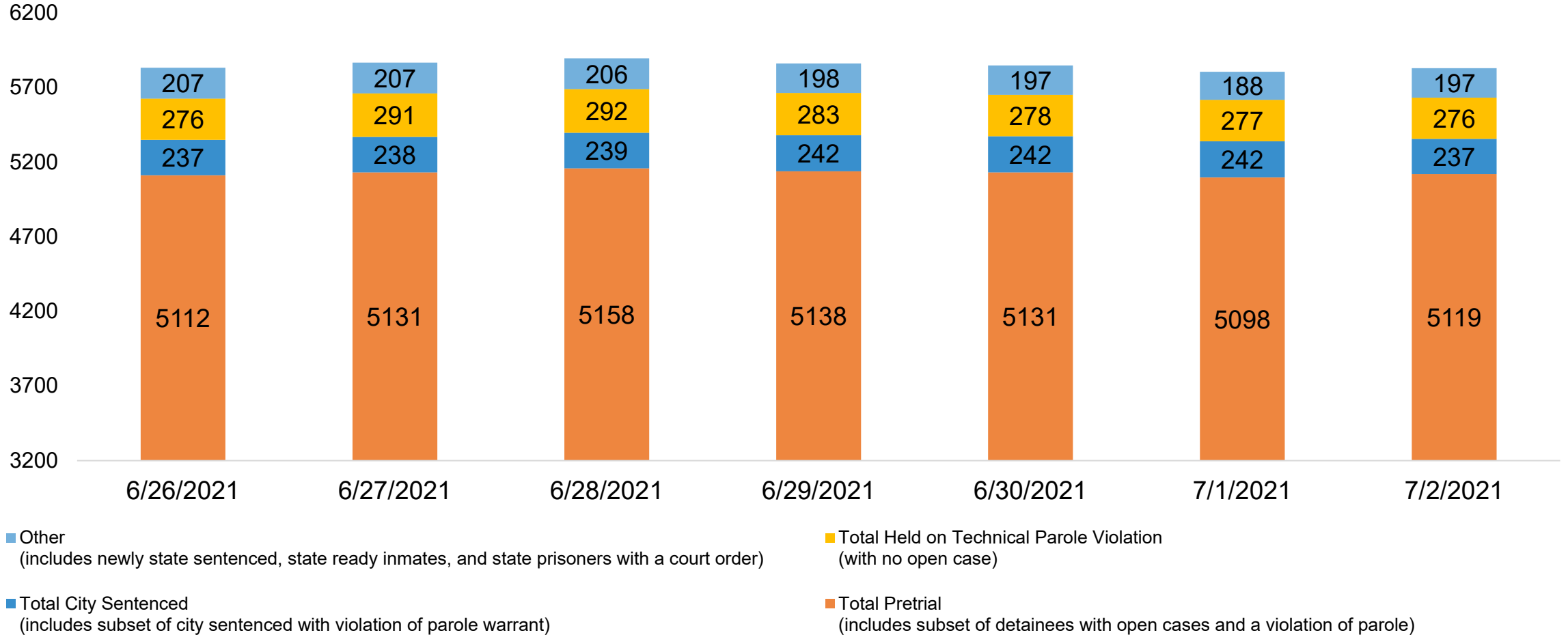
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 - July 2, 2021

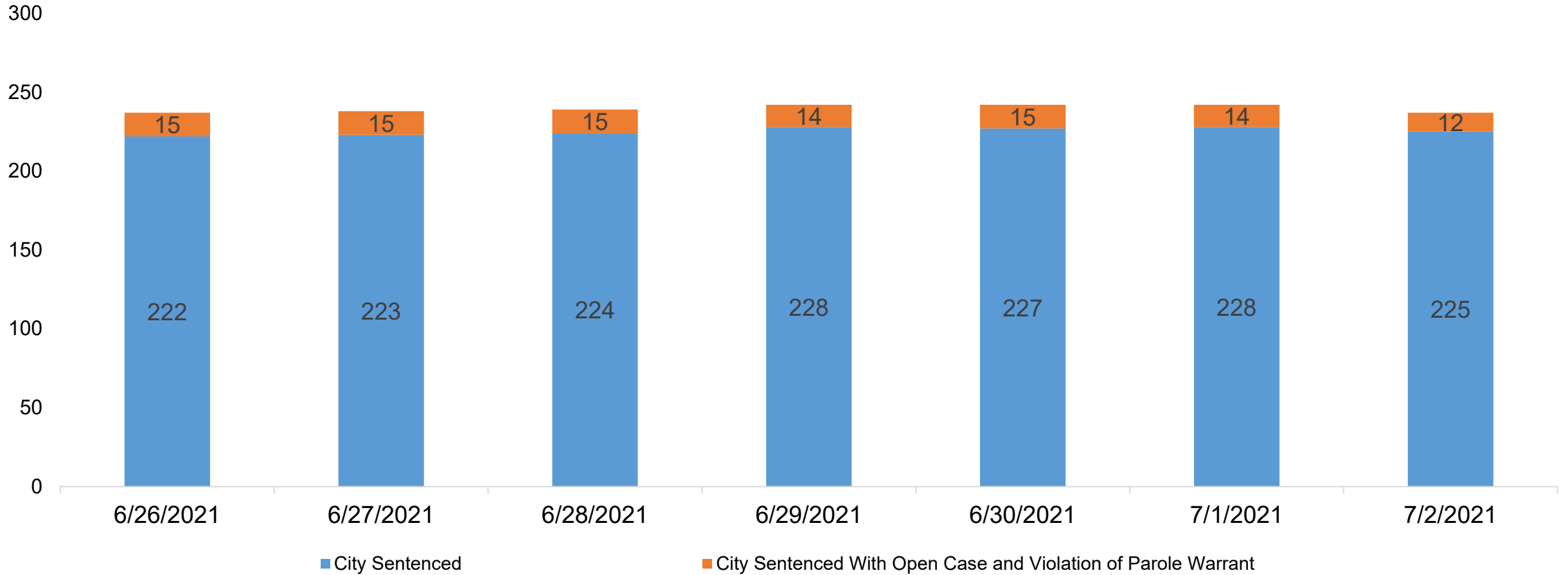

Total DOC Population by Custody Status, 6/26/2021 - 7/2/2021



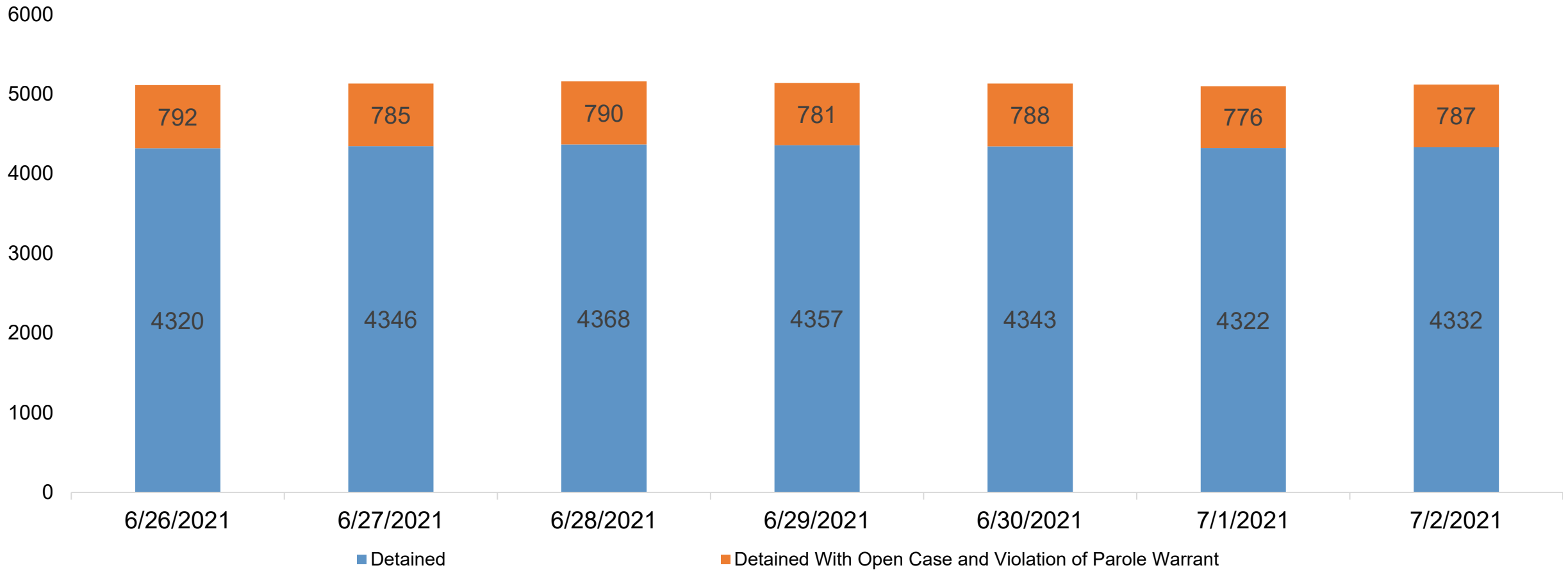

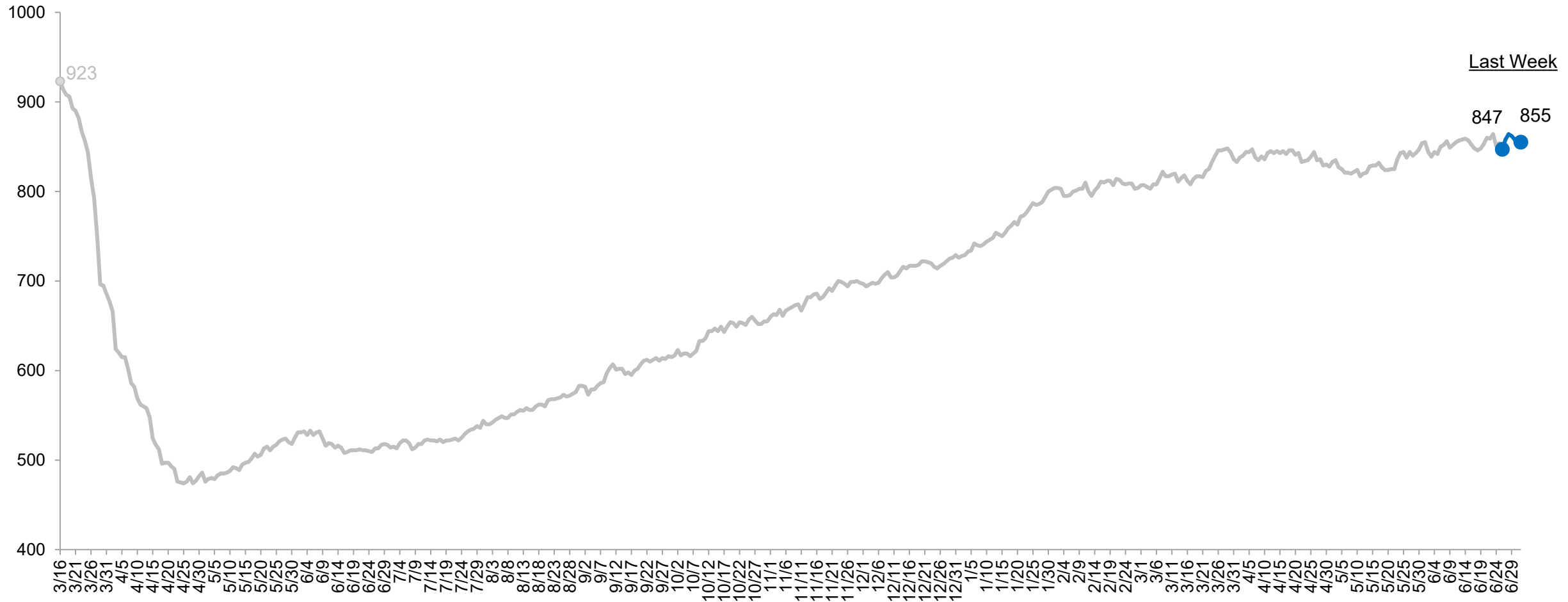

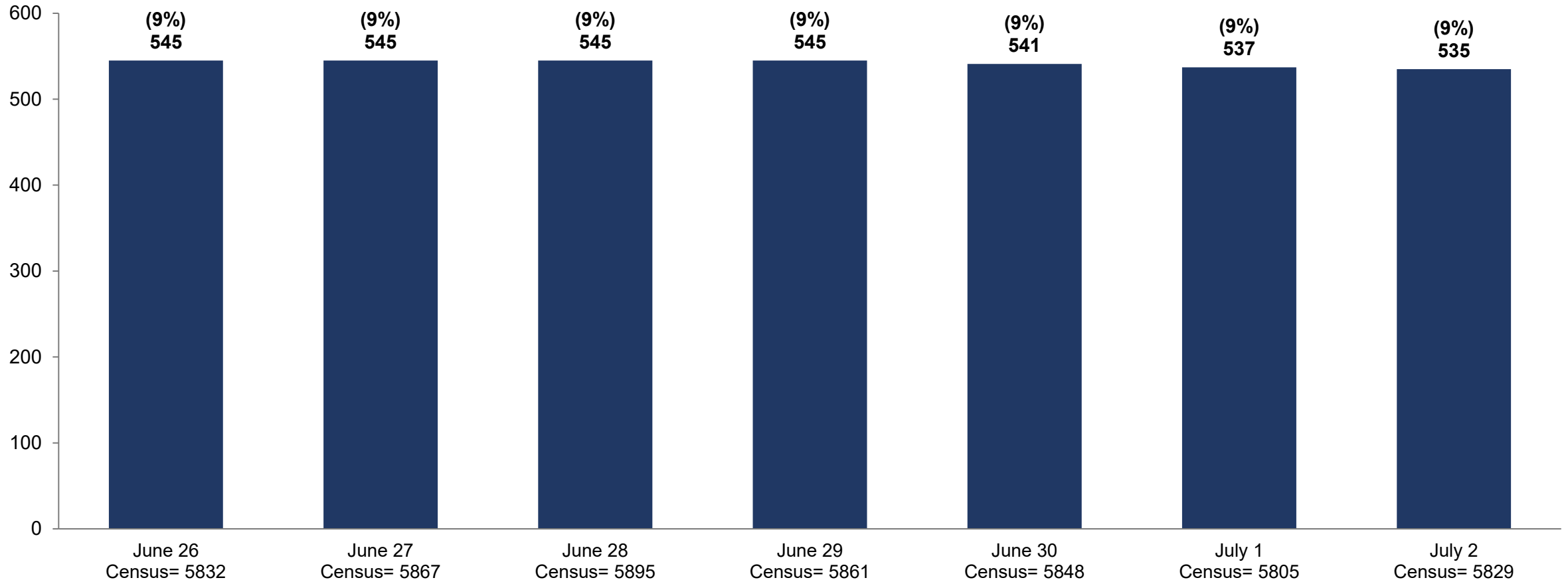

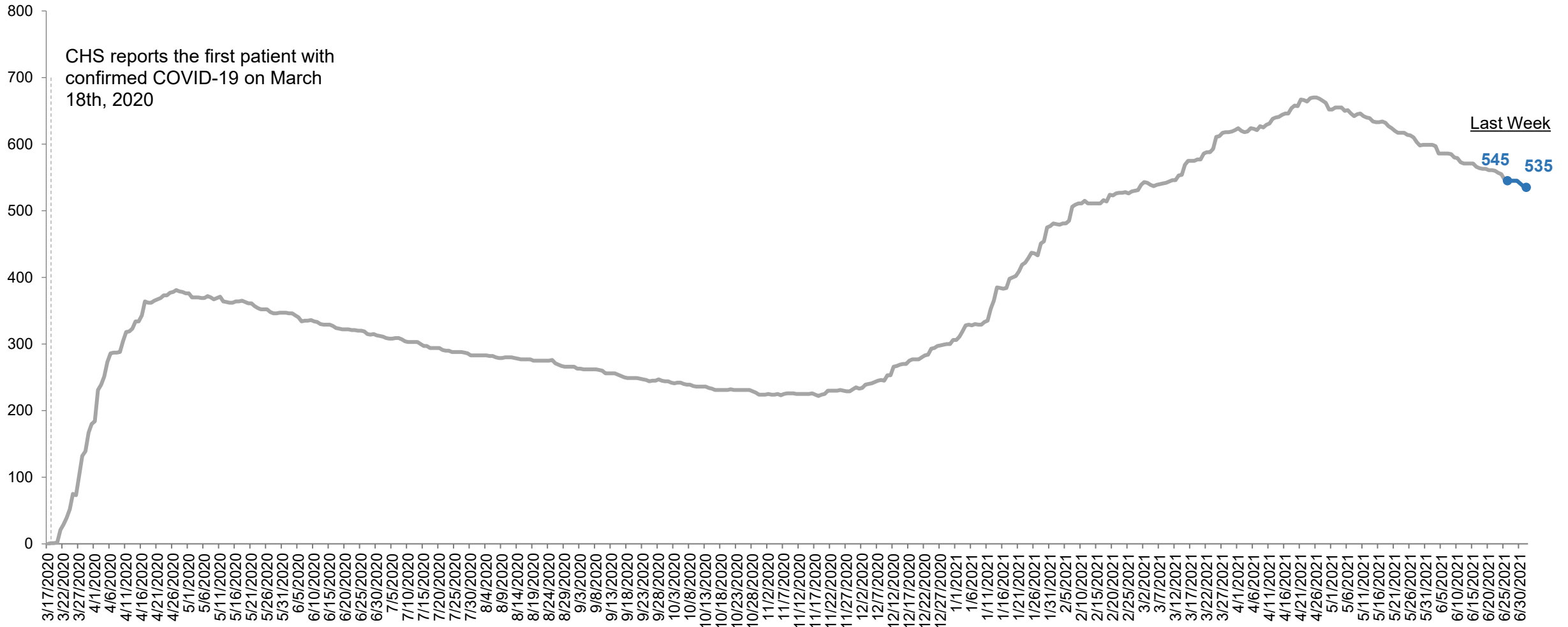
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

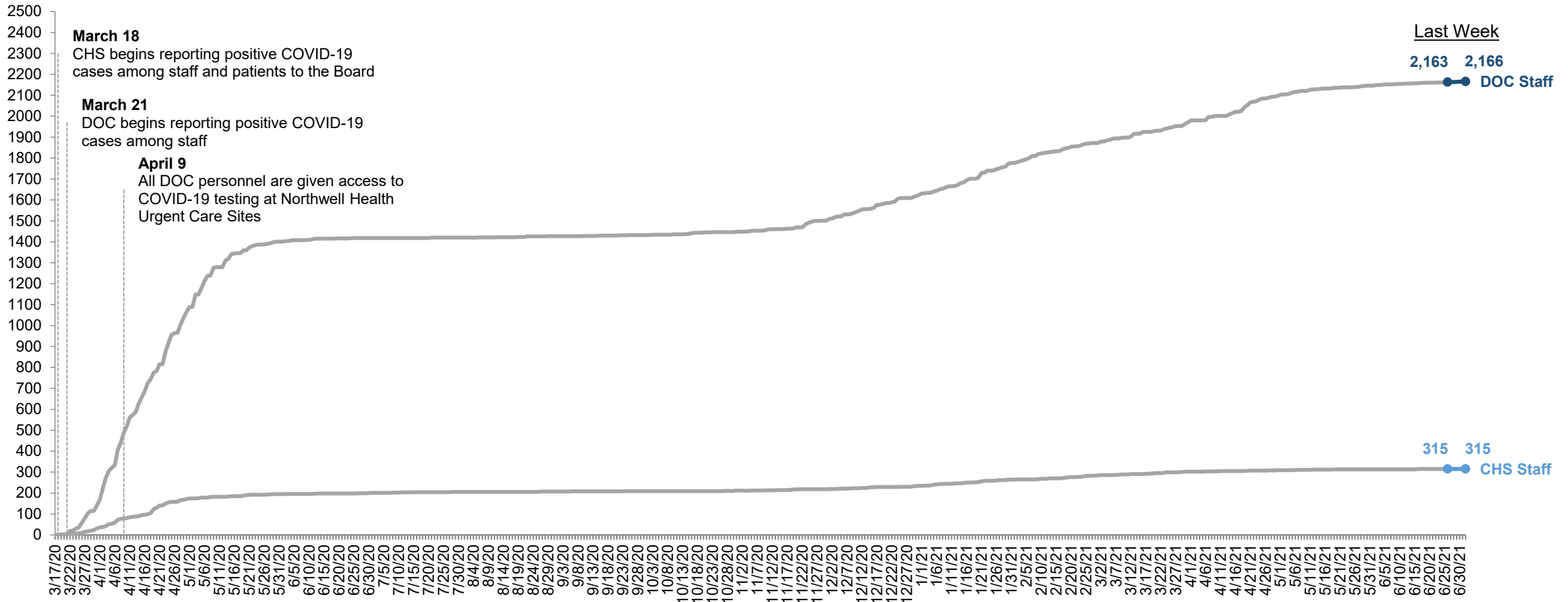
**Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

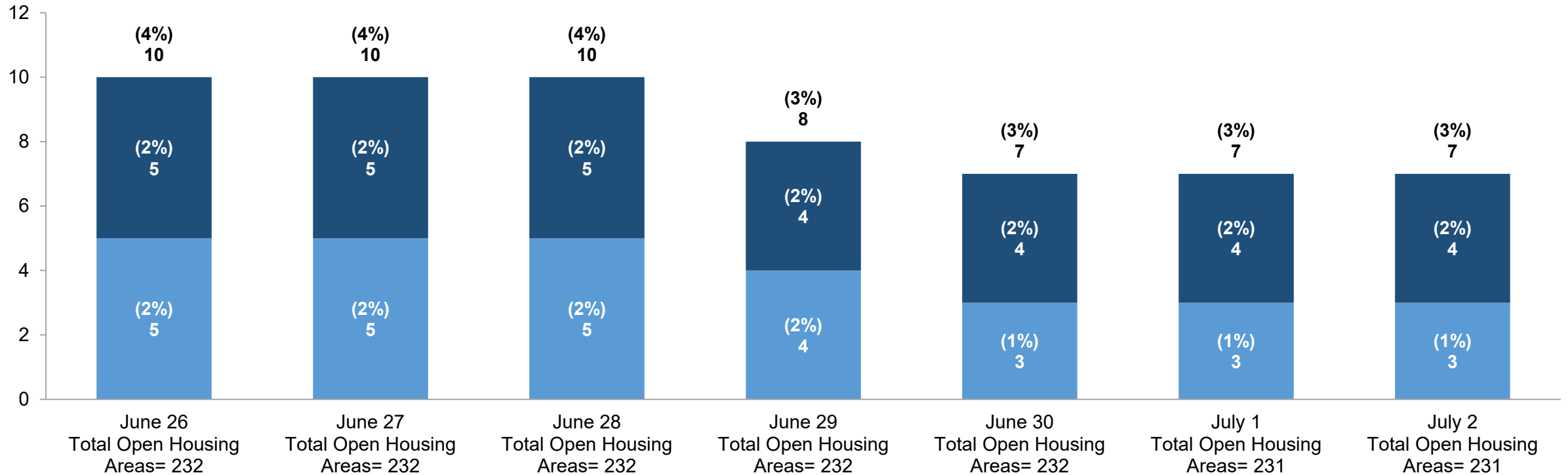

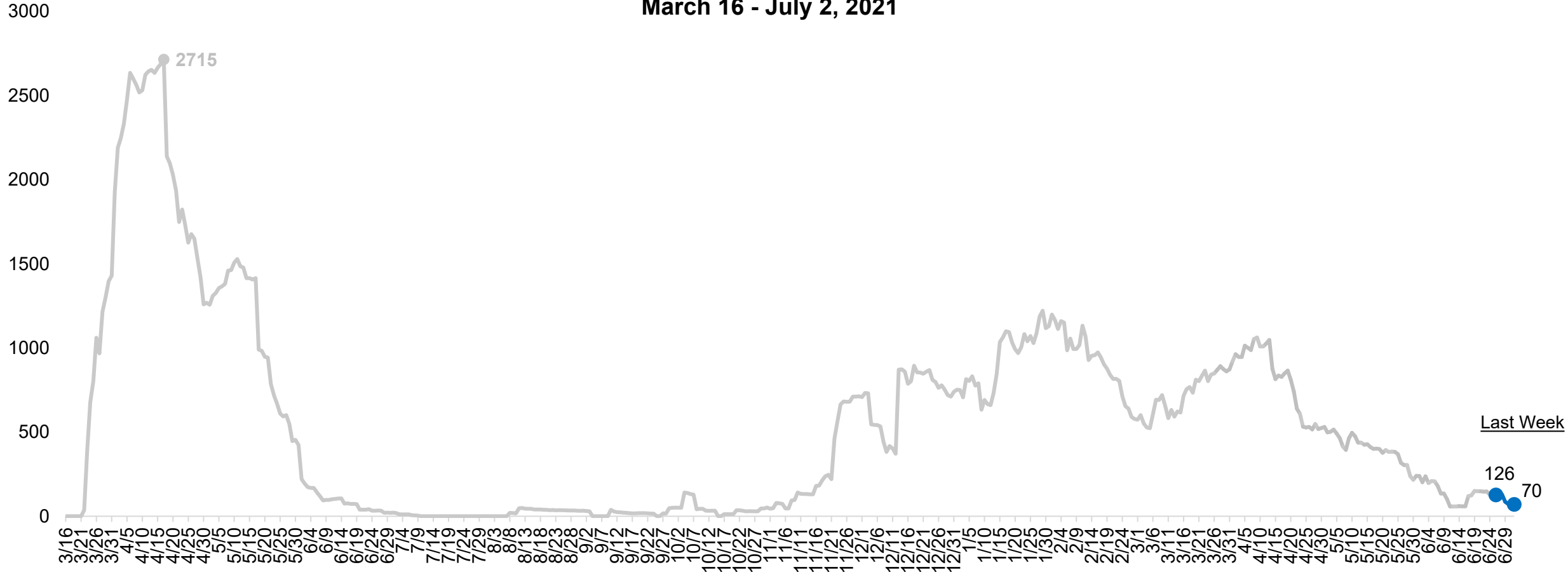

March 16 - July 2, 2021**

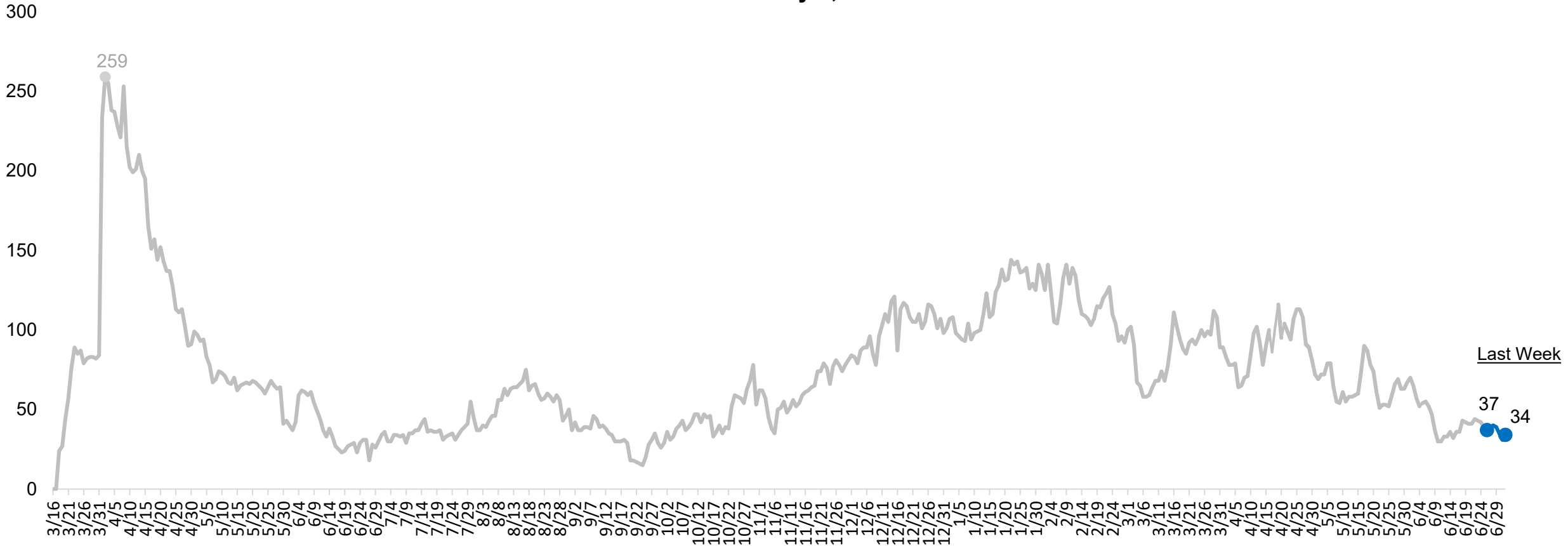

March 16 - July 2, 2021**

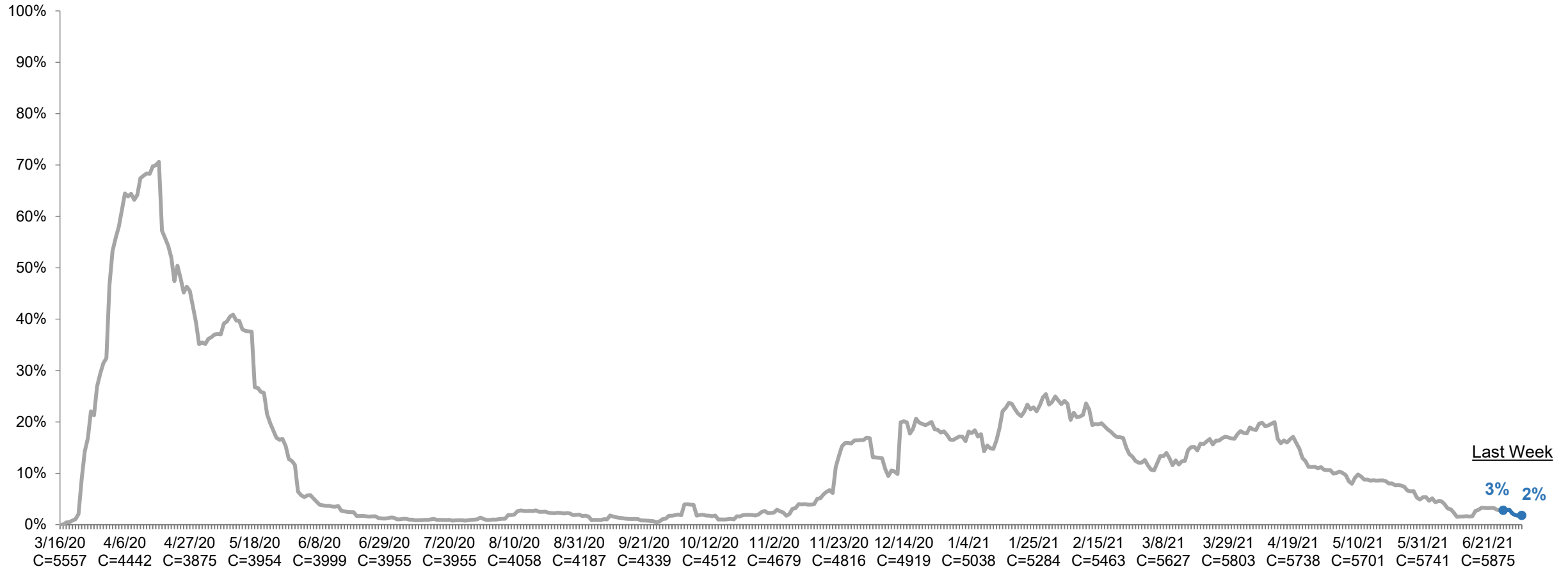

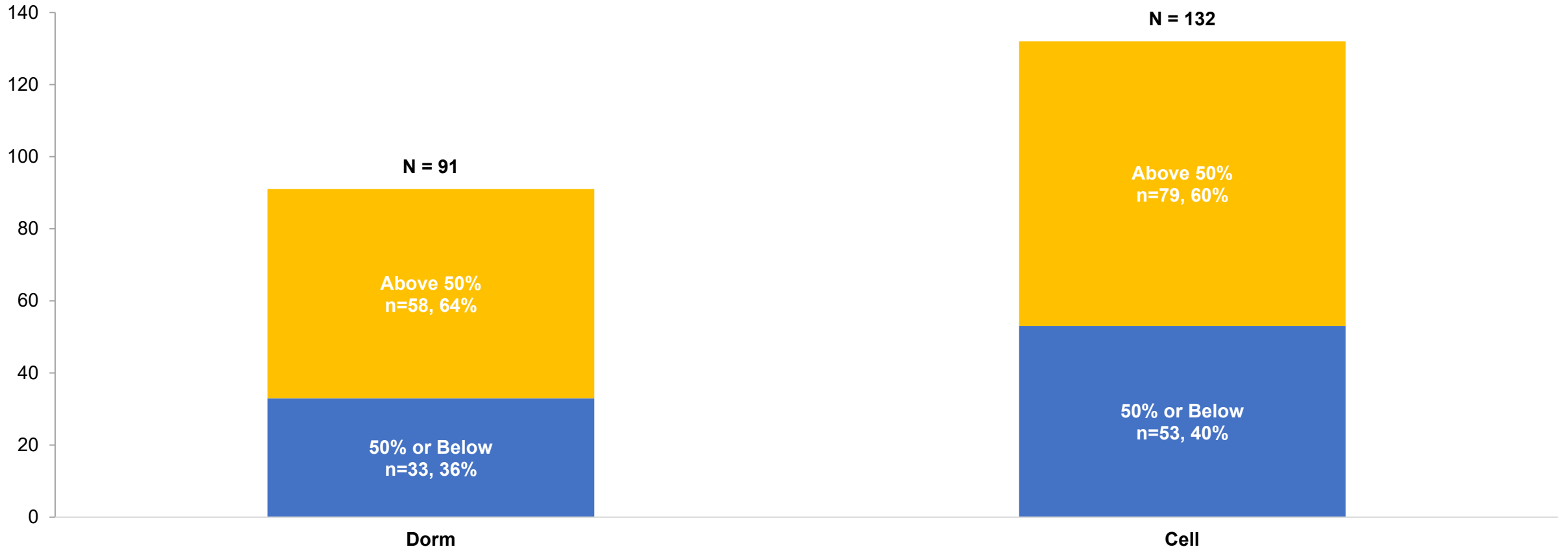

July 1, 2021



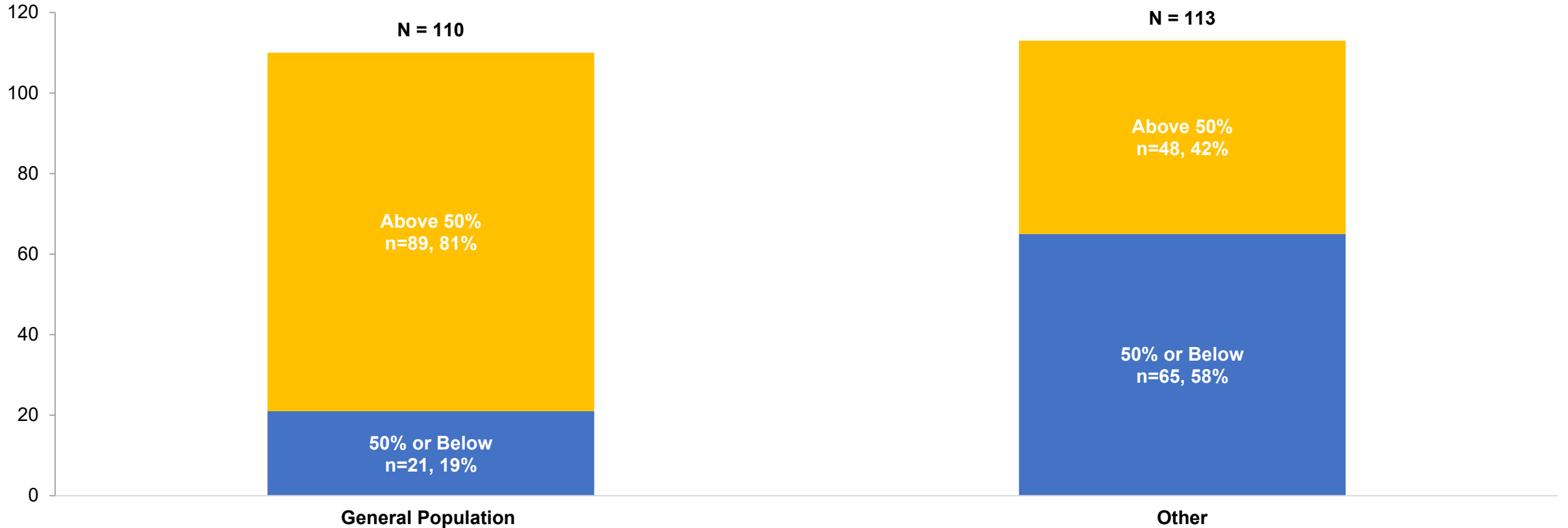

July 1, 2021



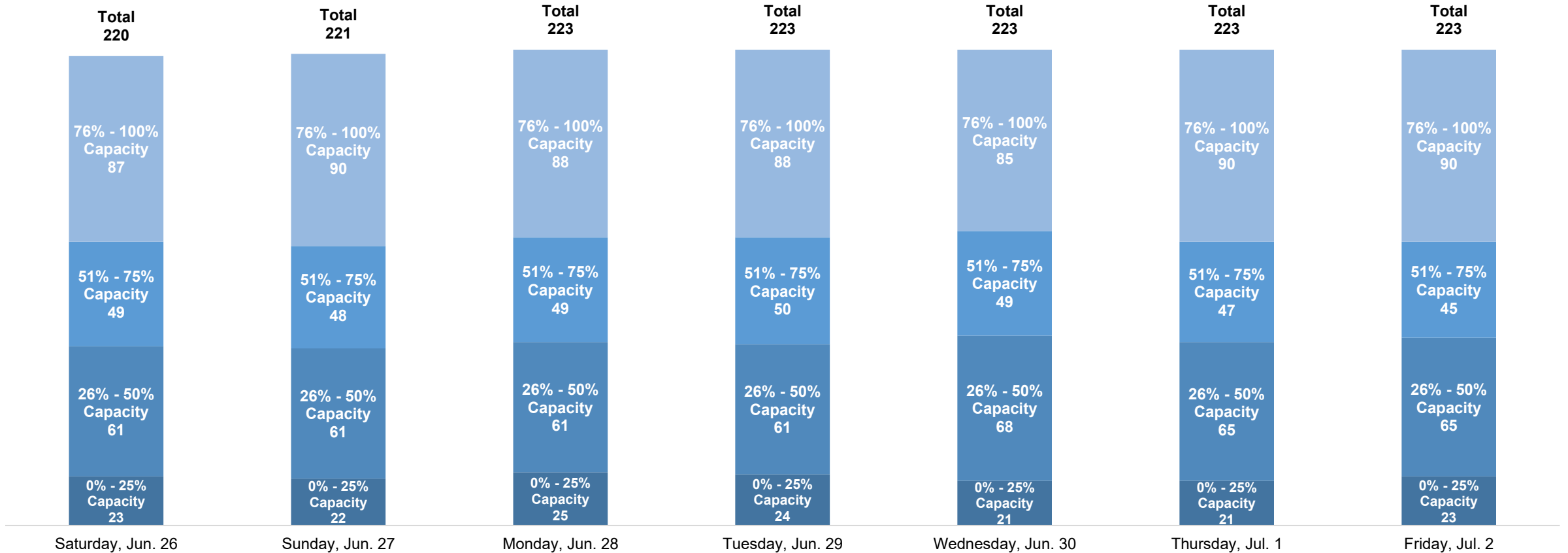
