

## UPDATE: New Requirements for Category Testing of Elevators

Beginning January 1, 2022, category testing of elevators must comply with the following new requirements in [Local Law 126 of 2021](#):

- The agency performing the category test must notify the Department of Buildings at least five (not seven) days prior to the Category 1 testing of escalators, Category 3 testing of water hydraulic elevators, and Category 5 testing of elevators.
- If a witnessing agency is required in Table N1 of ASME A17.1, as modified by Chapter K1 of Appendix K of the New York City Building Code, the category test report is no longer required to include the signature of the witnessing agency inspector.

*NOTE: The report must still include the signature of the witnessing agency director.*

### New Filing Deadlines

Deadline for Submitting Category Test Report to DOB	Deadline for Correcting Defects Identified in the Periodic Elevator Inspection Report	Deadline for Submitting Affirmation of Correction to DOB
Within 21 (not 60) days after the date of the category test	Within 90 (not 120) days after the date of the category test (owners may request up to two 45-day extensions)	Within 14 (not 60) days after the date the corrections were made
