SUBJECT: Maximum consideration for repairs on damaged premises during Blackout

- 1. Maximum consideration to repair without need for a permit.
- 2. Where a permit is needed, expedite.
- 3. Inspector should give priority to file when assisting store owners.
- 4. Owners or lessee are permitted to authorize and file their own applications to maximum extent possible.
- 5. Liberal interest of zoning and building code is to be followed to permit continuance of usage which might be otherwise non-conforment.
- 6. Certificate of Occupancy not to be required except in extreme cases when not possible to do otherwise.
- 7. Unsafe Building (vacate and abandoned) only where no effort is made, be it Owner/Lessee to secure premises after notified.
- 8. Structural conditions and problems to be processed in usual manner.
