	I have an 18 month on-the-job training program working on major buildings* under the direct and continuing supervision of a certified site safety manager. Such on-the-job training program shall conform to rules promulgated by the department. The supervising site safety manager shall certify the trainee's satisfactory completion of the training program; or
	I have equivalent Education/Construction Experience as outlined in 1 RCNY 104-08(a) and have satisfactorily completed a 30-hour OSHA Safety Course within two (2) years prior to the application date along with one (1) of the following:
