NOW, THEREFORE, the conditions of the foregoing obligations are that if the Principal(s) complies with NYC Administrative Code Sections 20-539 *et seq.* and Rules of the City of New York Sections 2-431 *et seq.* as are now in force or which may hereafter be amended relating to the business of Car Washes; pays to the City any fine, penalty, or other obligation the City imposes within thirty (30) days of the imposition of such fine, penalty, or obligation; satisfies any final judgment recovered by any person who received car wash services and was damaged thereby within thirty (30) days of such judgment; satisfies any final judgment recovered by an employee for non-payment or underpayment of wages within thirty (30) days of such judgment; and indemnifies and saves harmless the Obligee or any aggrieved person

from all loss and damage that they shall suffer by reason of said Principal's failure to comply with said laws and regulations, then this obligation is to be void: otherwise, it is to remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, this bond is issued subject to the following express conditions:

- 1. This bond shall be deemed continuous in form and shall remain in full force and effect for the term of the initial bond and all subsequent terms, for all liabilities, acts, omissions, or causes arising after this bond becomes effective until terminated as hereinafter provided.
- 2. This bond may be canceled by the Surety by giving sixty (60) days' notice in writing to the City of New York Department of Consumer and Worker Protection and Principal(s) at the address last known to the Surety by certified mail at least sixty (60) days prior to the termination date specified in such notice and, upon giving such notice, the Surety shall be discharged from all liability under this bond for any act or omission of the Principal occurring after such termination date.
- 3. The City of New York, as Obligee, may proceed against the Principal or Surety herein, or both, to recover damages for breach of conditions of this bond. Successive actions may be brought against this bond for successive breaches of its conditions.
- 4. Regardless of the number of years the bond remains in effect, the number of premiums paid, the number of renewals of the license, the number of claimants, or the number of claims made, the aggregate liability under the bond shall not exceed the penal sum of the bond.
