THE TEST DATE: The multiple-choice test is expected to be held on Saturday, January 13, 2007.

WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES: Steam Fitter's Helpers, under direct supervision, assist in doing work relating to piping and equipment for heating, air conditioning, compressed air, and processing systems; assist in the installation, maintenance and repair of piping and equipment in air, steam and hot water heating, air conditioning and processing systems; assist in the installation of boilers, and feedwater, vacuum and condensate equipment; assist in the installation of fuel oil piping and related equipment; assist in taking on-the-job measurements and lay out work from plans, specifications and/or sketches; and perform related work.

Some of the physical activities performed by Steam Fitter's Helpers and environmental conditions experienced are: communicating orally in a noisy environment; climbing stairs, ladders, and over equipment; standing upright for extended periods of time; walking over wet and slippery surfaces; carrying heavy objects such as tool boxes, pipe, and bags of pipe fittings; working on surfaces at substantial height.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$30.62 per hour. This rate is subject to change.

HOW TO APPLY: If you believe that you meet the requirements in the "How to Qualify" section, refer to the "Required Forms" section below for the forms that you must fill out. Return all completed forms and the application fee to DCAS Applications Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, New York, NY 10007 **by mail only**. DCAS will not accept applications in person from candidates.

HOW TO QUALIFY:

Education and Experience Requirements: By the last day of the Application Period you must have:

- 1. Three years of full-time satisfactory mechanical experience as a Steam Fitter's Helper acquired within the last 10 years; or
- 2. At least one and one-half years of full-time satisfactory mechanical experience as a Steam Fitter's Helper acquired within the last 10 years plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade, vocational or technical high school to make up the equivalent of three years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade, vocational or technical school.

You may be given the multiple-choice test before we review your qualifications. You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the qualification requirements for this examination prior to submitting your application. If you are marked "Not Qualified," your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

Medical Requirement: In accordance with applicable Federal, State and local laws and regulations, the NYC Health and Hospitals Corporation has established medical standards for this position. Accordingly, all eligibles will be required to undergo and pass a medical examination prior to the date of appointment to ensure that those medical standards have been met. Additionally, eligibles will be subject to a drug screening test prior to the date of appointment.

English Requirement: You must be able to understand and be understood in English.

Proof of Identity: Under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, you must be able to prove your identity and your right to obtain employment in the United States prior to employment with the City of New York.

REQUIRED FORMS:

- **1. Application for Examination**: Make sure that you follow all instructions included with your application form, including payment of fee. Save a copy of the instructions for future reference.
- **2. Education and Experience Test Paper**: Write your social security number in the box at the top right side of the cover page, and the examination title and number in the box provided. Fill out Sections A, B, and C. This form must be filled out completely and in detail for you to receive your proper rating. Keep a copy of your completed Education and Experience Test Paper for your records.
 - Education and experience will not be found acceptable unless it is verifiable.
- 3. **Foreign Education Fact Sheet (required only if you need credit for your foreign education to meet education and experience requirements):** If you were educated outside the United States, you must have your foreign education evaluated to determine its equivalence to education obtained in the United States. The services that are approved to make this evaluation are listed on the Foreign Education Fact Sheet included with your application packet. When you contact the evaluation service, ask for a "course-by-course" (general) evaluation of your foreign education. You must have one of these services submit its evaluation of your foreign education directly to the Department of Citywide Administration Services no later than eight weeks from the last date for applying for this examination.
- **THE TEST**: You will be given a multiple-choice test. Your score on this test will be used to determine your place on an eligible list. You must achieve a score of at least 70% to pass this test. The multiple-choice test may include questions on heating, air conditioning, and processing systems including pneumatics, hydraulics, piping, fittings, and auxiliary equipment; inspection, maintenance and installation of heating, air conditioning, processing systems and their components; measurement, selection, assembly and installation of piping, fittings, equipment and system components; tools, safety, good housekeeping and shop arithmetic; understanding instructions, manuals and other related areas.
- **ADMISSION CARD**: You should receive an Admission Card in the mail about 10 days before the date of the written test. If you do not receive an Admission Card at least 4 days before the test date, you must go to the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, Manhattan, to obtain a duplicate card.
- **THE TEST RESULTS:** If you meet the education and experience requirements and pass a multiple-choice test, your name will be placed in final score order on an eligible list and you will be given a list number. You will be notified by mail of your test results. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for appointment when your name is reached on the eligible list.
- **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This examination is for positions with the Health and Hospitals Corporation (HHC) only. If you would like to apply for Steam Fitter's Helper in agencies under the jurisdiction of DCAS you must submit a separate application and fee for Examination No. 6043 from October 4, 2006 to October 24, 2006.

HHC has promulgated rules regarding the reemployment of persons who have already retired from public service. These rules generally prohibit reemployment of retirees. Any such retired person is advised to consult with HHC Human Resources Management, Office of Certification and Examinations at (212) 788-3568 to determine whether he or she would be eligible for appointment from an eligible list established for this examination.

List Termination: The eligible list resulting from this examination will be terminated one year from the date it is established, unless extended by the NYC Health and Hospitals Corporation.

SPECIAL TEST ACCOMMODATIONS: If you plan to request special testing accommodations due to disability or an alternate test date due to your religious belief, follow the instructions included with the "Application for Examination."

The General Examination Regulations of the Department of Citywide Administrative Services apply to this examination and are part of this Notice of Examination. They are posted and copies are available in the Applications Center of the Division of Citywide Personnel Services, 18 Washington Street, NY, NY.
