Construction of East Side Coastal Resiliency from Montgomery Street to East 15th Street

The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) has submitted an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) for a State Pollution Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit and a Water Withdrawal (WW) permit for the Construction of East Side Coastal Resiliency between Montgomery Street and East 15th Street in the Borough of Manhattan, New York (Project ID SANDRESM1). A Public Participation Plan has been developed in accordance with NYSDEC Commissioner Policy 29, Environmental Justice and Permitting (CP-29). The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public about the project and to involve the community during the SPDES permit application review process.
