GUIDELINES FOR FRANCHISE OF REVOCABLE CONSENT SUBMITTALS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

- 1. Transmittal letter from the Department of Transportation (DOT), Division of Franchises, Concessions and Revocable Consents.
- 2. Submission has to be by a Professional Engineer or Registered Architect in the State of New York (original of license stamp/seal and signature to appear on letter as well as on the plans).
- 3. Existing sewer and water mains should be labeled as to the size and type should be shown on the site plans.
- 4. Sewer and Water Main Elevations and Profile should be shown.
- 5. Exact vertical and horizontal clearances should be shown between the proposed conduit or structure and the existing water main and/or sewer lines.
- 6. Existing sewer information should include manhole locations and rim/invert elevations.
- 7. Water mains must be supported if necessary.
- 8. As-Built Plans of sewers and/or water mains should be enclosed.

FOR FORCE MAINS IN ADDITION TO 1 & 2, THE FOLLOWING:

- 3. A copy of the Adopted City Drainage Plan for the project area.
- 4. Survey of the property and route of the proposed force main.
- 5. A copy of the Final Map of the streets in the vicinity of the project site.
- 6. A copy of a letter from the Borough President's office indicating the legal status and ownership of the street wherein the proposed force main will be installed.
- 7. A copy of the Tax Map(s) showing lots fronting the force main.
- 8. Hydraulic computations for the proposed sanitary sewage discharge and proof of adequacy of the existing outlet sewer to accommodate the proposed flow.
- 9. A copy of the As-Built records of the existing outlet sewer.
- 10. Evidence of compliance with Local Law 103/89 relating to the discharge of storm water at the project site.
