



Dear Human Services Provider,

Your organization has been identified to receive a City Council Discretionary award in connection with the Pandemic Support for Human Services Providers Initiative. The funding is for a one-time increase in operating expenses, including personnel, related to COVID-19 and returning to work.

The City Council Discretionary award process requires providers to submit a Discretionary Application before an award can be made. City Council records indicate that your organization does not have a Fiscal Year 2022 Discretionary Application on file. Accordingly, you must complete [the Council Finance Discretionary Application](#) to receive this funding.

Please submit your application as soon as possible to be eligible for the next Transparency Resolution, which occurs monthly.
